### Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR)

First quarter year 2023

The number of trips made by residents in Spain increased by 9.8% in the first quarter and stands at 35.3 million

Total expenditure increased by 32.2%, reaching 9,311 million euros

## Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations

Residents in Spain made 35.3 million trips in the first quarter of 2023, 9.8% more than that registered in the same period of 2022.

The main destination of 89.3% of the trips was within the national territory, with an increase of 5.8% as compared to the first quarter of the previous year. On the other hand, trips abroad increased by 62.1%, accounting for 10.7% of the total.



By weeks<sup>1</sup>, an increase in trips was observed in all weeks of January and there was more similarity in general in the rest of the quarter.

#### Trips according to purpose, accommodation and main transport

*Leisure, recreation and holiday* trips, which were the main reason for 42.0% of trips in the first quarter, increased by 12.3%. On the other hand, *Visits to relatives or friends*, which accounted for 39.8% of the total, registered an increase of 9.4%.

Trips for *Business and other professional reasons* increased by 21.1%, while those made for *Other reasons* <sup>2</sup>fell by 19.8%.

The main reasons for domestic travel are *Visits to relatives or friends* (41.1% of the total) and *Leisure* (40.9%).

The main reason to travel to foreign destinations is *Leisure, recreation and holiday trips*, with 51.6% of the total.

In 44.8% of domestic trips, residents stayed in family or friends' homes. More than 14.1 million trips use this type of accommodation, an annual increase of 6.0%.

For trips abroad, hotel accommodation was the preferred option (45.9% of trips). This type of accommodation recorded an increase of 42.2% compared to the first quarter of 2022.

As for the main type of transport used, own vehicles accounted for 78.2% of domestic trips, 2.2% more than in the same quarter of 2022. In 70.0% of the trips abroad, air transport was used, with an increase of 83.2%.

#### **Main destinations**

The main Autonomous Communities of destination for trips by residents in the first quarter were Andalucía (16.6% of the total), Cataluña (12.8%) and Comunitat Valenciana (9.1%).

If domestic trips by residents are related to the destination, the phenomenon of travel was more intense in Aragón (with 1,349 trips per 1,000 inhabitants<sup>3</sup>), Castilla y León (with 1,280) and Castilla – La Mancha (1,019).



#### **Autonomous Communities of origin**

Trips made by residents in Comunidad de Madrid accounted 17.2% of the total in the first quarter. This was followed by Andalucía (17.1%) and Cataluña (16.2%).


Removing the effect caused by the size of each Autonomous Community, those who travelled the most were residents of Aragón (1,046 trips per 1,000 inhabitants<sup>4</sup>), Comunidad de Madrid (855) and Castilla y León (825).

In turn, Región de Murcia (502 trips per 1,000 inhabitants), La Rioja and Galicia (both 600) were the Autonomous Communities with the lowest ratio of trips by inhabitants.

#### Travel expenditure

The total travel expenditure in the first quarter reached 9,311.5 million euros, indicating a 32.2% increase as compared with the same period of 2022.

Total expenses on domestic trips increased by 16.2% and on trips abroad by 76.3%.

The average daily expenditure stood at 68 euros for domestic trips and 114 euros for trips abroad.

In domestic travel, *expenditure on bars and restaurants*, which accounted for the largest share of total expenditure (26.7%), increased by 22.5% compared to the first quarter of 2022.

On trips abroad, *expenditure on transport* represented 34.7% of the total, with an annual increase of 70.0%.





With regard to the main Autonomous Community of destination, the highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips to Comunidad de Madrid (102 euros), Canarias (94) and País Vasco (85).

On the other hand, the lowest average expenditure values were registered in Castilla – La Mancha (51 euros), Castilla y León (55) and Extremadura (56 euros).


#### Average daily expenditure per person according to destination. First quarter 2023 Euros



By Autonomous Community of origin, the highest average daily expenditure was made by residents in Canarias (90 euros), País Vasco (89) and Cataluña (88).

On the other hand, the lowest average daily expenditure was made by residents in Extremadura (58 euros), Aragón (67) and Castilla – La Mancha (71).

#### Monthly data

In January there were 12.6 million trips, in February 11.1 million and in March 11.5 million. Trips made in January had an average duration of 4.2 nights, higher than the duration of trips made in February and March, of 2.9 in both cases.

January was the month with the lowest percentage of trips within the Autonomous Community of residence (45.6%, compared to 46.8% in February). This is due to the higher percentage of trips abroad (12.0% of the total).

Leisure was the main reason for travelling in February and March, (with 44.8% and 44.5% of the total, respectively), and Visits to relatives or friends was the main reason for travelling in January (46.4%). Work-related travel peaked in March (15.1% of the total).

January is the month with the highest proportion of non-market accommodation (65.2%). Hotel accommodation recorded its largest share in February (28.1%) and the rest of market accommodation in March (14.7%).

#### **Excursions**

The resident population aged 15 years or older went on 52.3 million excursions<sup>5</sup> in the first quarter of 2023, which resulted in an annual increase of 1.6%. 96.8% of excursions were made for personal reasons and 3.2% for professional reasons.

88.4% of the excursions were made within the Autonomous Community of residence, with an annual increase of 0.4%.

10.5% of excursions were to another Autonomous Community and 1.1% to foreign countries. The number of excursions went up by 11.3% in the former and by 11.9% in the latter.

#### Data review and updates

The data published today is final and is not subject to further revision. All results are available on INEBase.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> An excursion is considered any visit without an overnight stay outside the person's usual environment. Trips that are part of someone's normal routine are excluded, as are those made from second homes, from a cruise ship, or from any other accommodation other than the usual one.

#### Methodological note

The main objective of the Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR) is to provide information on the trips and excursions carried out each month by the population resident in Spain, both within the country and abroad, and their main characteristics (duration, expenditure, reason, accommodation, etc.).

In addition, the survey provides annual information on the percentage of the population travelling for personal reasons and investigates the reasons given by those who do not travel.

**Type of operation**: quarterly continuous survey.

Population scope: Resident population aged 15 and over in family dwellings (indirect information regarding trips taken by children under 15 is also provided).

**Geographical scope**: the entire national territory.

**Reference period of the results:** month, quarter, year (depending on the variable and the degree of disaggregation).

**Sample size:** the effective monthly sample is around 8,200 persons, who provide information on the trips completed in the two months prior to the interview. Thus, the results of a reference month are obtained from around 16,400 questionnaires.

**Type of sampling:** stratified three-stage random sampling is used. The framework is the MDG Georeferenced Address Framework. The first stage units are the census sections, the second stage units are the dwellings, and a person aged 15 or over has been selected within each dwelling. The stratification criterion in the first stage was the size of the municipality to which the section belongs. In both cases, a variable is used as a substratification criterion to define the household's propensity to travel.

The selected persons collaborate three times in alternate months over six months, leave the sample one semester, and are interviewed another three times during the following semester.

**Collection method:** computer-assisted telephone or personal interviews, online questionnaire (since 2018).
