Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR) Second Quarter 2022

The number of trips made by residents in Spain increased 30.2% in the second quarter of 2020, up to 44.6 million

Total expenditure increases by 115.7% and exceeds 11,657 million euros

Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana are the main destinations

Spanish residents made 44.6 million trips in the second quarter of 2022, 30.2% more than that registered in the same period of 2021.

91.8% of the trips had the national territory as main destination, with an annual increase of 22.1%. On the other hand, trips abroad increased by 398.1%, representing 8.2% of the total.

Given that in 2022 Easter is celebrated in April, and that in 2021 it took place between March and April, it is convenient to analyse data the data from the first quarter together.. Thus, during the **first six months of 2022**, trips made by residents increased by 55.0% as compared with the same period of the previous year. Domestic trips increased by 46.5% and international trips by 396.8%.


If we look only at the trips made during the Easter holidays, there were 6.4 million trips in 2022, 167.2% more than in 2021.

If we analyse trips by weeks¹, increases are observed during April and May, except for the first week of April, which coincided with Holy Week in 2021. In June 2022, the levels were slightly lower than in 2021.

¹ In order to study trips by return date, trips to workplaces and centres of study were excluded (4.7% of the trips in the quarter) Also note that the last week of the third and fourth quarters of the graph have eight days, to complete the days in the quarter.

Trips according to purpose, accommodation and main transport

Leisure, recreation and holiday trips, which were the main reason for 51.9% of trips made in the second quarter, increased by 49.2%. In turn, *Visits to relatives or friends*, which represented 31.7% of the total, decreased by 13.5%.

Trips taken for *Business and other professional reasons* and those made for *Other reasons*² increased by 18.6% and 13.2%, respectively.

The main reason for trips during the second quarter was leisure, whether for domestic (51,4%) or foreign (58,1%) destinations.

² Other reasons include shopping tourism, travel to places of study, other trips for education and training, health,

religious reasons, company incentive trips and all other trips for personal reasons not included in another category.

In 39.1% of domestic trips, residents stayed in family or friends' dwellings. More than 16 million trips used this type of accommodation, with an annual increase of 11.5%.

For trips abroad, hotel accommodation was the preferred option (52.5% of trips). This type of accommodation registered an increase of 470.8% as compared with the second quarter of 2021.

During the first quarter, domestic trips made by residents who stayed with family or friends increased by 34.8%. On the other hand, trips abroad in hotel accommodation increased by 497.5%.

As for the main type of transport used, own vehicles accounted for 82.2% of domestic trips, 15.9% more than in the same quarter of 2021. In 66.1% of the trips abroad, air transport was used, with an increase of 599.1%.

In the first six months of 2022, trips in private vehicles increased by 38.7% in domestic travel, and by 179.2% for trips abroad.

Main destinations

The main destination Autonomous Communities for trips by residents in the second quarter of 2022 were Andalucía (with 16.3% of the total), Cataluña (15.9%) and Comunitat Valenciana (11.0%).

If domestic trips of residents are related with the population of the destination, the phenomenon of trips was more intense in Cantabria (with 1,639 trips per 1,000 inhabitants³), Castilla y León (with 1,622) and Aragón (1,355).

Trips by destination (abroad and Autonomous Communities)



Autonomous Communities of origin

Trips made by residents in Cataluña accounted for 19.0% of the total in the second quarter. This was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (18.9%) and Andalucía (13.4%).



Press Release

Removing the effect caused by each Autonomous Community's size, those travelling the most were from Comunidad de Madrid (1,261 trips per 1,000 inhabitants⁴), Aragón (1,223) and La Rioja (1,162).

In turn, Canarias (585 trips per one thousand inhabitants), Región de Murcia (686) and Andalucia (693) were the Autonomous Communities with the lowest ratio of trips by inhabitants.

Travel expenses

Total travel expenses in the second quarter were 11,657.1 million euros, representing an increase of 115.7% compared to the same period in 2021.

In trips to domestic destinations, total expenditure rose by 75.4% and in those made grew by 478.0%.

The average daily expenditure was 69 euros for domestic trips and 118 euros for trips abroad.

During the first quarter of 2022, the total resident travel expenditure rose by 144.0%. The increase was 102.3% for domestic trips and 461.9% for trips abroad.

For domestic trips, *expenditure in lodging*, which represented the highest percentage of total expenditure (26.2%), increased by 84.8% as compared with the second quarter of 2021.

On trips abroad, *expenditure on transport* represented largest percentage of the total (31.7%), with an annual increase of 413.8%.

During the first six months of the year, the *accommodation expenditures* for domestic trips increased by 105.2% compared with the same period in 2021. In turn, *expenditure on transport* for trips abroad increased by 408.5%.



According to the main destination Autonomous Community, the highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips made to Canarias (98 euros), Comunidad de Madrid (95) and Illes Balears (94).

In turn, the lowest values were found in Castilla-La Mancha (51 euros), Extremadura (53) and Castilla y León (54).


Average daily expenditure per person according to destination Second quarter of 2022



By autonomous community of origin, the highest average daily expenditure was made by residents in Cataluña (86 euros), Illes Balears (83) and Comunidad de Madrid (82).

On the contrary, the lowest levels were registered in Andalucia (68 euros), Aragón and Extremadura (both with 71).

Monthly data

In April there were 16.2 million trips, in May 14.5 million and in June 13.9 million. Trips made in April had an average duration of 3.8 overnight stays, higher than trips in May and June, of 2.9 and 3.3 overnight stays, respectively.

April was the month with the lowest percentage of trips within the Autonomous Community of residence (43.7% compared to 51.8% in May). This was due to the higher percentage of trips to other Autonomous Community (45.8% of the total) and abroad (10.5%).

The main reason for traveling every in all months was leisure, recreation and holidays, representing 56.2% of trips in June. Trips for professional reasons reached a peak in May, with 10.3% of the total.

May was the month with the greatest importance for non-market accommodation (60.2%). Hotel accommodations and other market accommodations recorded their highest weight in June, with 29.3% and 16.5%, respectively.

Excursions

The resident population aged 15 years or older went on 52.5 million excursions (day-trips)⁵ in the second quarter of 2022, with an annual decrease of 11,0%. 95.6% of excursions were made for personal reasons and 4.4% for professional reasons.

87.7% of the excursions were made within the Autonomous Community of residence, with an annual decrease of 16.5%.

11.3% of excursions were to another Autonomous Community and 1.0% to foreign countries. The number of excursions rose by 63.5% in the former and by 153.7% in those with destinations abroad.

Data Review and Update

The data published today is final and is not subject to further revision. All results are available on INEBase.

⁵ An excursion is considered any visit without an overnight stay outside the person's usual environment. Trips that are part of someone's normal routine are excluded, as are those made from second homes, from a cruise ship, or from any other accommodation other than the usual one.

Methodological note

The main objective of the Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR) is to provide information on the trips and excursions carried out each month by the population resident in Spain, both within the country and abroad, and their main characteristics (duration, expenditure, reason, accommodation, etc.).

In addition, the survey provides annual information on the percentage of the population travelling for personal reasons and investigates the reasons given by those who do not travel.

Type of operation: quarterly continuous survey.

Population scope: Resident population aged 15 and over in family dwellings (indirect information regarding trips taken by children under 15 is also provided).

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Reference period of the results: month, quarter, year (depending on the variable and the degree of disaggregation).

Sample size: the effective monthly sample is around 8,200 persons, who provide information on the trips completed in the two months prior to the interview. Thus, the results of a reference month are obtained from around 16,400 questionnaires.

Type of sampling: stratified three-stage random sampling is used. The framework is the MDG Georeferenced Address Framework. The first stage units are the census sections, the second stage units are the dwellings, and a person aged 15 or over has been selected within each dwelling. The stratification criterion in the first stage was the size of the municipality to which the section belongs. In both cases, a variable is used as a substratification criterion to define the household's propensity to travel.

The selected persons collaborate three times in alternate months over six months, leave the sample one semester, and are interviewed another three times during the following semester.

Collection method: computer-assisted telephone or personal interviews, online questionnaire (since 2018).
