Residents Travel Survey (RTS/FAMILITUR) Third quarter 2021.

The number of trips made by residents in Spain increases by 23.6% in the third quarter of 2021 and stands at 57 million

Total expenditure increased by 55% reaching 16,718 million euros

Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana are the main destinations

Residents in Spain made 57.0 million trips in the third quarter of 2021, 23.6% more than in the same period of 2020.

The main destination of 94.4% of the trips was within national territory, with an increase of 20.6% as compared to the third quarter of last year. On the other hand, trips abroad increased by 111.9%, representing 5.6% of the total.



36.5% of trips in the third quarter corresponded to summer holidays¹. Considering also the month of June, residents made 23.2 million summer vacation trips, 41.9% more than the previous year. These trips have an average duration of 12.3 overnight stays, 8.4% less than in the same period of 2020.

During the first nine months of 2021, trips made by residents increased by 26.3% as compared with the same period of the previous year. Domestic trips rose by 28.2%, while international trips fell by 5.9%.

¹ Summer holidays are considered to be trips of five or more nights, made between June and September, for any reason other than health, education, work or incentives.

If we analyse the trips by weeks², an increase was observed in all the weeks of the second and third quarters compared to 2021. As of June, trips began to recover levels close to 2019.

Trips according to purpose, accommodation and main transport

Leisure, recreation and holiday trips, which were the main reason for 59.7% of trips made in the third quarter, increased by 26.2%. In turn, *Visits to relatives or friends*, which represented 32.0% of the total, registered an annual increase of 19.6%.

Trips for *Business and other professional reasons* increased by 8.2%, and trops made for *Other reasons*³ increased by 38.6%.

The main reason for trips during the third quarter was leisure, whether for domestic (60,0%) or foreign (55,2%) destinations.

In the first nine months of 2021, leisure trips rose by 27.4%, visits to family or friends by 20.8%, business trips by 30.4% and those made for other reasons by 48.6%.

 $^{^{2}}$ In order to study trips by return date, trips to workplaces and centres of study were excluded (2.5% of the trips in the quarter) Also note that the last week of the third and fourth quarters of the graph have eight days, to complete the days in the quarter.

³ Other reasons include shopping tourism, travel to places of study, other trips for education and training, health, religious reasons, company incentive trips and all other trips for personal reasons not included in another category.

In 41.3% of domestic trips, residents stayed in family or friends' dwellings. There were 22.2 million trips that used this type of accommodation, with an annual increase of 11.2%.

For trips abroad, market accommodation was the preferred option (59.6% of trips). This type of accommodation registered an increase of 107.2% as compared with the third quarter of 2020.

During the first nine months of 2021, domestic trips made by residents staying with relatives or friends increased by 18.6%. Trips abroad in hotel accommodations decreased by 18.4%.

As for the main type of transport used, own vehicles accounted for 85.4% of domestic trips, 15.1% more than in the same quarter of 2020. In 50.6% of the trips abroad, air transport was used, with an increase of 222.0%.

During the first nine months of 2021, domestic trips by own vehicle increased by 28.6% and trips abroad by air transport decreased by 20.1%.

Main destinations

The main destination Autonomous Communities for trips by residents in the third quarter of 2021 were Andalucía (with 20.0% of the total), Cataluña (13.5%) and Comunitat Valenciana (12.4%).

If domestic trips of residents are related with the population of the destination, the phenomenon of trips was more intense in Cantabria (with 2,744 trips per 1,000 inhabitants⁴), Castilla y León (with 1,937) and Aragón (1,643).


⁴ For the calculation of this indicator, we have used both the trips of the population aged 15 and over as well as the population aged 15 and over residing in the destination (calculated as an average of the population for each of the months of the quarter).

Trips made by the residents in Comunidad de Madrid represented 19.7% of the total in the third quarter. This was followed by Cataluña (17.1%) and Andalucía (16.3%).



Removing the effect caused by the size of each Autonomous Community, those who travel the most were those from Comunidad de Madrid (1,646 trips per 1,000 inhabitants⁵), Aragón (1,544) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (1,538).

In turn, those who travelled the least were residents of Canarias (741 trips per 1,000 inhabitants), Comunitat Valenciana (946) and Galicia (957).





⁵ This considers the resident population aged 15 years old or over (calculated as the average of the population of each of the months of the quarter).

Travel expenses

The total travel expenditure in the second quarter reached 16,718 million euros, indicating an 55.0% increase as compared with the same period of 2020.

Total expenses on domestic trips increased by 43.5% and on trips abroad by 184.5%.

The average daily expenditure was 44 euros for domestic trips and 66 euros for trips abroad.

During the first nine months of 2021 the total travel expenditure of residents increased by 31.9%. The increase was 38.5% for domestic trips and 1.9% for trips abroad.

In domestic trips, *accommodation expenditures* represented the largest share of expenditures (29.3% of the total), followed by *bar and restaurant expenditures* (26.0%). The former increased by 56.0% compared to the third quarter of 2021 and the latter by 46.2%.

On trips abroad, *expenditure on transport* represented 28.1% of the total, with an annual increase of 168.2%.

During the first nine months of the year, the *accommodation expenditures* for domestic trips increased by 51.8% compared with the same period in 2021. In turn, *expenditure on transport* for trips abroad decreased by 11.2%.



According to the main destination Autonomous Community, the highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips made to Canarias (73 euros), Illes Balears (70) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (52).


In turn, the lowest values were in Región de Murcia (29), Castilla y León (30 euros) and Castilla-La Mancha (33).

By Autonomous Community of origin, the highest average daily expenditure was made by residents in Canarias (59 euros), Cantabria (56) and Galicia (53).

In turn, the lowest were registered in Región de Murcia (35 euros), Comunitat Valenciana (40) and País Vasco (41).

Monthly data

In July, 18.4 million trips were made, in August 24.1 million and in September 14.6 million. Trips made in August had the longest average duration (7,6 overnight stays).

August was the month with the lowest percentage of trips within the Autonomous Community of residence (42.5%). This was due both to the higher percentage of trips to other Autonomous Community (51.6% of the total) and abroad (6%).

Leisure was the main reason for travelling every month, representing 63.0% of trips. Trips for professional reasons reached their minimum in August (2.6% of the total).

September was the most important month for non-market (58.7%) and hotel (24.3%) accommodations. The rest of the market accommodations had the highest registry in August (22.7%).

Excursions

The resident population aged 15 years or older made 66.0 million excursions⁶ in the third quarter of 2021, with an annual increase of 9,8%. 98.1% of excursions were made for personal reasons and 1.9% for professional reasons.

88.3% of the excursions were made within the Autonomous Community of residence, with an annual increase of 9.1%.

10.7% of excursions were to another Autonomous Community and 1.0% to foreign countries. In the former the number of excursions increased 17.6% while those with destination abroad increased 2.1%.

Data Review and Update

The data published today is final and is not subject to further revision. All results are available on INEBase.

⁶ An excursion is considered any visit without an overnight stay outside the person's usual environment. Trips that are part of someone's normal routine are excluded, as are those made from second homes, from a cruise ship, or from any other accommodation other than the usual one.

Methodological note

The main objective of the Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR) is to provide information on the trips and excursions carried out each month by the population resident in Spain, both within the country and abroad, and their main characteristics (duration, expenditure, reason, accommodation, etc.).

In addition, the survey provides annual information on the percentage of the population travelling for personal reasons and investigates the reasons given by those who do not travel.

Type of operation: quarterly continuous survey.

Population scope: Resident population aged 15 and over in family dwellings (indirect information regarding trips taken by children under 15 is also provided).

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Reference period of the results: month, quarter, year (depending on the variable and the degree of disaggregation).

Sample size: the effective monthly sample is around 8,200 persons, who provide information on the trips completed in the two months prior to the interview. Thus, the results of a reference month are obtained from around 16,400 questionnaires.

Type of sampling: stratified two-stage random sampling. The framework is the set of main dwellings that have collaborated in the Continuous Household Survey (CHS). In each stratum of the CHS, the first stage units are the main family dwellings and the second stage units are the persons aged 15 and over residing in these dwellings. A variable defining the household's propensity to travel is used as a stratification criterion.

The selected persons collaborate three times in alternate months over six months, leave the sample one semester, and are interviewed another three times during the following semester.

Collection method: computer-assisted telephone or personal interviews, online questionnaire (since 2018).
