**Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR)
Third quarter year 2023**

**The number of trips made by residents in Spain increased by 6.7%
in the second quarter of 2023 and stands at 60.6 million**

Total spendings increased by 12.1% reaching 23,561 million euros

**Andalusia, Catalonia and the Valencian Community are the main
destinations**

Residents in Spain made 60.6 million trips in the third quarter of 2023, 6.7% more than in the same period of 2022.

The main destination of 89.0% of the trips was within the national territory, with an increase of 6.4% as compared to the third quarter of last year. On the other hand, trips abroad increased by 9.0%, accounting for 11.0% of the total.

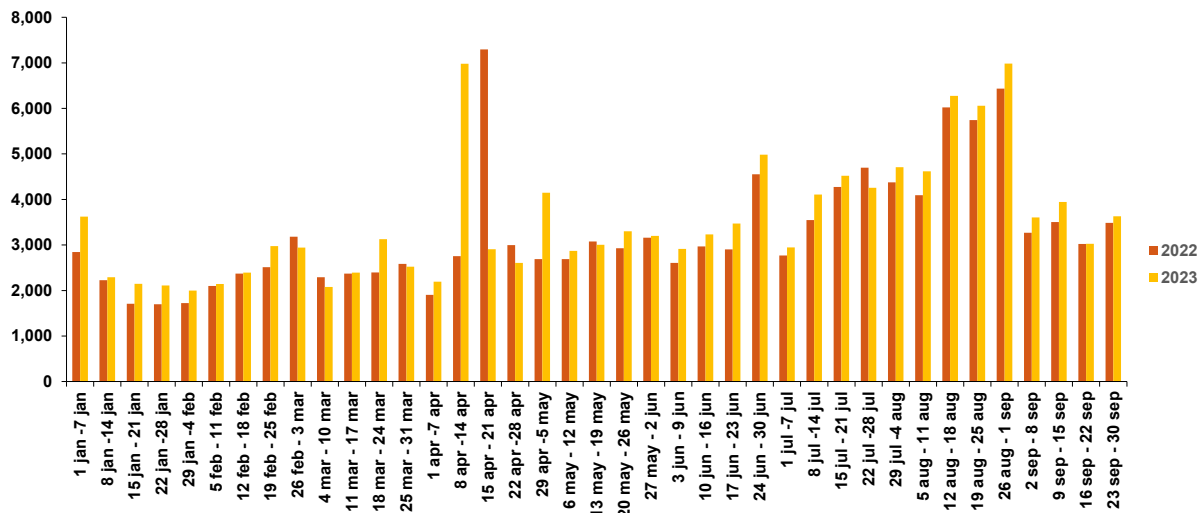
39.1% of the trips in the third quarter correspond to summer holidays.¹ Also considering the month of June, residents made 25.8 million summer vacation trips, 8.5% more than the previous year. These trips had an average duration of 11.9 overnight stays, 3.4% less than in the same period of 2022.

During the first nine months of 2023, trips made by residents increased by 8.0% as compared with the same period of the previous year. Domestic trips increased by 6.7%, while trips abroad increased by 22.0%.

¹ Summer holidays are deemed as trips of five or more nights, made between June and September, for any reason other than health, studies, work or incentives.

If we analyse trips by week², we generally see increases in most weeks of the third quarter compared to the same period of the previous year.

Trips according to purpose, accommodation and main transport

Leisure, recreation and holiday trips, which were the main reason for 62.8% of trips in the third quarter, increased by 6.9%. In turn, *Visits to relatives or friends*, which represented 27.2% of the total, registered an annual increase of 1.4%.

Trips for *Business and other professional reasons* decreased by 40.2%, and those made for *Other reasons*³ increased by 4.1%.

The main reason for trips during the second third was leisure, for both domestic (62.2% of the total) or foreign (67.0%) destinations.

In the first nine months of 2023, leisure trips rose by 8.6%, visits to family or friends by 6.0% and business trips by 26.4%. On the contrary, those made for other reasons decreased by 10.3%.

² In order to be able to study trips by return date, trips due to travel to the workplace and the study institution have been excluded (3.1% of trips in the quarter). Also note that the last week of the third quarter of the chart has eight days to complete the days of the quarter.

³ *Other reasons* include shopping tourism, travel to study places, other trips for education and training, health, religious reasons, company incentive trips and all other trips for personal reasons not included in another category.

In 41.7% of domestic trips, residents stay in family or friends' homes. 22.5 million trips use this type of accommodation, with an annual increase of 11.6%.

For trips abroad, market accommodation was the preferred option (70.8% of trips). This type of accommodation recorded an increase of 13.9% compared to the third quarter of 2022.

During the first nine months of 2023, domestic trips made by residents staying with relatives or friends increased by 9.9%. And trips abroad in hotel accommodations decreased by 17.4%.

As for the main type of transport used, own vehicles accounted for 83.1% of domestic trips, 7.0% more than in the same quarter of 2022. In 56.4% of the trips abroad, air transport was used, with an increase of 8.6%.

During the first nine months of 2023, domestic trips by means of own vehicles increased by 5.0% and trips abroad by air transport by 27.7%.

Main destinations

The main autonomous communities of destination for residents' trips in the third quarter of 2023 are Andalusia (17.9% of the total), Catalonia (12.8%) and the Valencian Community (11.3%).

If the internal travel of residents is related to the destination population, the travel phenomenon is more intense in Cantabria (with 2,881 trips per 1,000 inhabitants⁴), Castilla y León (2,141) and La Rioja (1,793).

⁴ For the calculation of this indicator, we have used both the trips of the population aged 15 and over, as well as the population aged 15 and over residing in the destination (calculated as an average of the population for each of the months of the quarter).

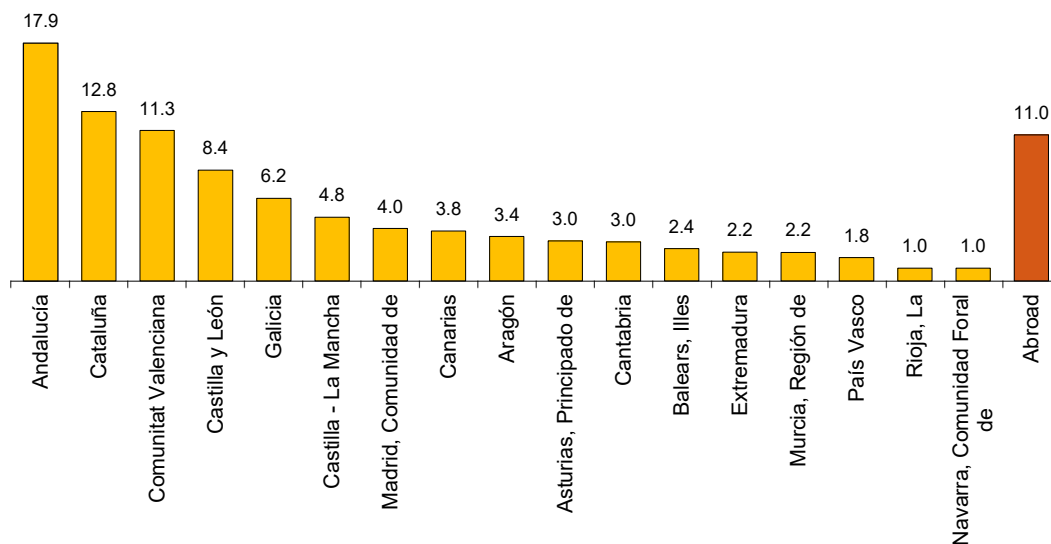

Autonomous communities of origin

Trips made by residents in Community of Madrid accounted for 18.8% of the total in the third quarter. This was followed by Cataluña (16.8%) and Andalucía (15.1%).

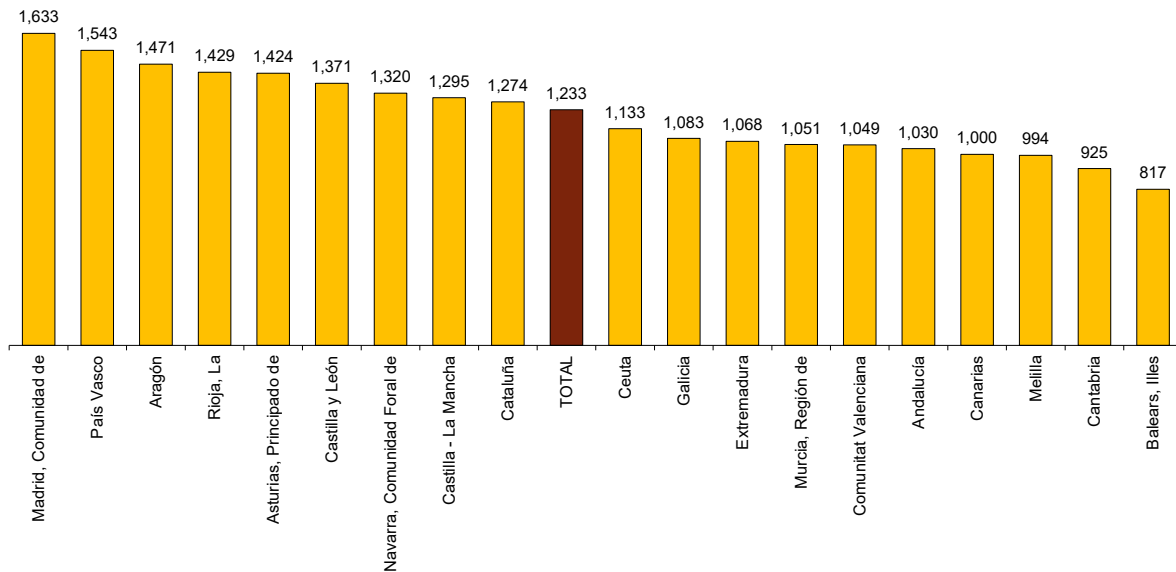

Eliminating the effect of the size of each community, the most travellers are residents of the Community of Madrid (1,633 trips per 1,000 inhabitants⁵), the Basque Country (1,543) and Aragon (1,471).

In contrast, the least travellers are residents of the Balearic Islands (817 trips per 1,000 inhabitants), Cantabria (925) and the Canary Islands (1000).

⁵ This considers the resident population aged 15 years old or over (calculated as the average of the population of each of the months of the quarter).

Trip expenditure

The total trip expenditure in the third quarter reached 23,561 million euros, indicating a 12.1% increase as compared with the same period of 2022.

Total spendings on domestic trips increased by 10.2% and on trips abroad by 16.5%.

The average daily expenditure is 52 euros for domestic trips and 104 euros for trips abroad.

During the first nine months of 2023 the total travel expenditure of residents increased by 16.3%. The increase was 11.1% for domestic trips and 29.5% for trips abroad.

In domestic trips, *expenditure on accommodation* represented the largest share of total expenditure (29.3%), followed by *expenditure on bars and restaurants* (27.1%). The former increased by 9.2% compared to the third quarter of 2022 and the latter by 14.4%.

On trips abroad, *expenditure on transport* represented 25.8% of the total, with an annual increase of 10.5%.

During the first nine months of the year, the *accommodation expenditure* for domestic trips increased by 10.9% compared to the same period in 2022. Meanwhile, *expenditure on transport* for trips abroad increased by 28.2%.

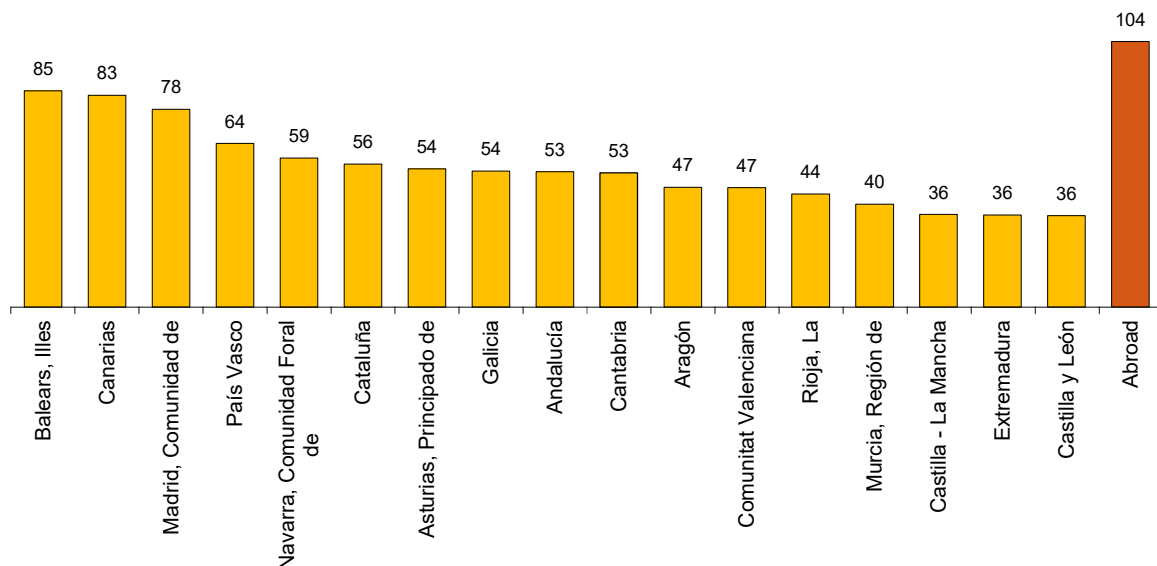

Taking into account the Autonomous Community of main destination, the highest average daily expenses are recorded in trips to the Balearic Islands (85 euros), the Canary Islands (83) and the Community of Madrid (78).

Meanwhile, the lowest values are in Castilla y León, Extremadura and Castilla-La Mancha (36 euros in all three).

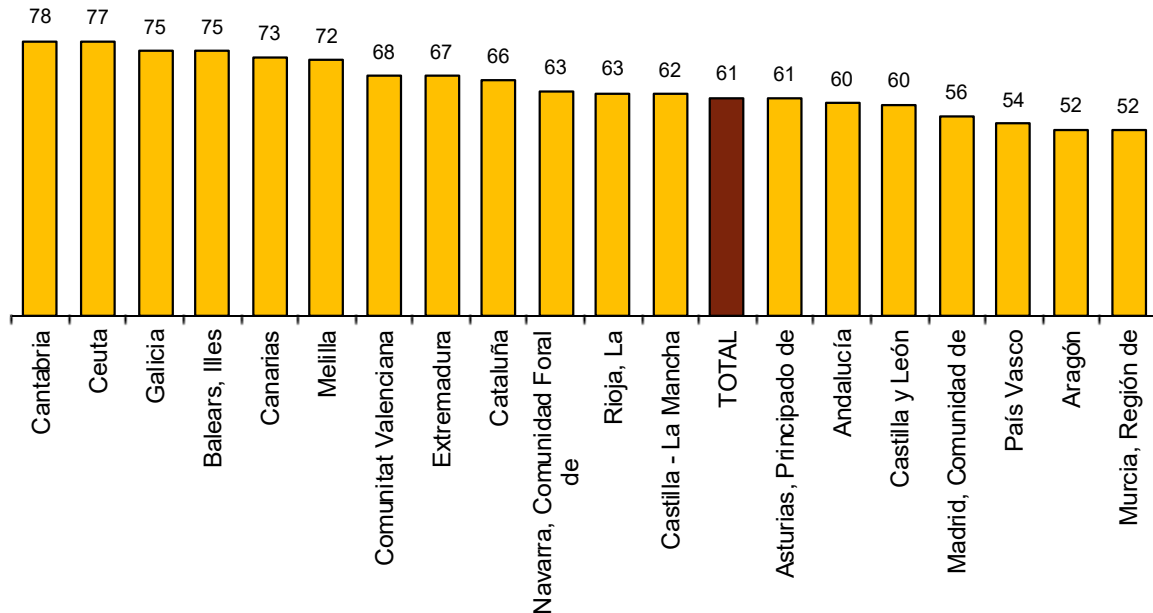
Average daily expenditure per person according to destination. Third quarter of 2023



By Autonomous Community of origin, the highest average daily expenditure is made by residents in Cantabria (78 euros) and in Galicia and the Balearic Islands (75 both).

On the contrary, the lowest are in the Region of Murcia and Aragon (52 euros in both) and the Basque Country (54).

Monthly data

20.3 million trips were made in July, 24.9 million in August and 15.3 million in September. Trips made in August had the longest average duration (7.8 overnight stays).

August was the month with the lowest percentage of trips within the Autonomous Community of residence (37.2%). This is due to the higher percentage of trips to both another community (50.8% of the total) and abroad (12.0%).

Leisure is the main reason to travel every month, accounting for 66.6% of trips in August. Work-related travel reached the minimum in August (2.9% of the total).

August is the month with the greatest prominence of non-market accommodation (56.4%) and the rest of the market (23.5%). Hotel accommodation registers its highest weight in September (25.4%).

Excursions

The resident population aged 15 years or older went on 63.4 million excursions⁶ in the third quarter of 2023, which resulted in an annual increase of 13.6%. 97.5% of excursions were made for personal reasons and 2.5% for professional reasons.

86.0% of the excursions were made within the Autonomous Community of residence, with an annual increase of 12.5%.

12.5% of excursions were to another Autonomous Community and 1.5% to foreign countries. The number of excursions rose by 21.7% in the former and by 19.5% in those with destinations abroad.

Data reviews and updates

The data published today is final and is not subject to further revision. All results are available on INEBase.

⁶ An excursion is considered any visit without an overnight stay outside the person's usual environment. Trips that are part of someone's normal routine are excluded, as are those made from second homes, from a cruise ship, or from any other accommodation other than the usual one.

Methodological note

The main objective of the Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR) is to provide information on the trips and excursions carried out each month by the population resident in Spain, both within the country and abroad, and their main characteristics (duration, expenditure, reason, accommodation, etc.).

In addition, the survey provides annual information on the percentage of the population travelling for personal reasons and investigates the reasons given by those who do not travel.

Type of operation: quarterly continuous survey.

Population scope: resident population aged 15 and over in family dwellings (indirect information regarding trips taken by children under 15 is also provided).

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Reference period of the results: month, quarter, year (depending on the variable and the degree of disaggregation).

Sample size: the effective monthly sample is around 8,200 persons, who provide information on the trips completed in the two months prior to the interview. Thus, the results of a reference month are obtained from around 16,400 questionnaires.

Sampling type: stratified three-stage random sampling is used. The framework is the MDG Georeferenced Address Framework. The first stage units are the census sections, the second stage units are the dwellings, and a person aged 15 or over has been selected within each dwelling. The stratification criterion in the first stage was the size of the municipality to which the section belongs. In both cases, a variable is used as a substratification criterion to define the household's propensity to travel.

The selected persons collaborate three times in alternate months over six months, leave the sample one semester, and are interviewed another three times during the following semester.

Collection method: computer-assisted telephone or personal interviews, online questionnaire (since 2018).
