**Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR)**  
Fourth quarter 2018 and year 2018. Provisional data

**The number of trips made by residents in Spain increases by 0.5%  
in the fourth quarter of 2018 and stands at 40.2 million**

**Total expenditure increases by 5.0% and exceeds 9,000 million  
euros**

**In 2018, the number of trips increased by 2.0% while expenditure  
grew by 6.5%**

Residents in Spain made 40.2 million trips in the fourth quarter of 2018, 0.5% more than that registered in the same period of 2017.

The main destination of 89.6% of the trips was within the national territory, with a decrease of 0.9% as compared to the fourth quarter of last year. On the other hand, trips abroad increased by 14.4%, representing 10.4% of the total.

**Trips according to purpose, accommodation and main transport**

During the fourth quarter of 2018, *Leisure, recreation and holiday* trips, which were the main reason for 42.7% of trips, increased by 1.7%. *Visits to relatives or friends*, which represented 42.0% of the total, registered an annual increase of 0.7%.

Trips for *Business and other professional reasons* increased by 1.6%, while those made by *Other reasons*<sup>1</sup> fell by 12.0%.

<sup>1</sup> *Other reasons* include shopping tourism, travelling to the study centre, other trips for education and training, health, religious reasons, company incentive trips and all other trips for personal reasons not included in another category.

The main reason for travelling within Spain during the fourth quarter of 2018 was visiting relatives or friends (44.2%). On the other hand, most trips abroad were made for leisure purposes (58.9%).

In 46.2% of domestic trips, residents stayed in family or friends' dwellings. That is 16.6 million trips, 0.6% less than in the fourth quarter of 2017.

For trips abroad, hotel accommodation was the preferred option (57.4% of trips). This type of accommodation registered an annual increase of 22.6%.

As for the main type of transport used, own vehicles accounted for 80.8% of domestic trips, 2.2% less than in the same quarter of 2017.

In 68.1% of the trips abroad, air transport was used, with an increase of 18.7%.

### **Main destinations**

The main Autonomous Communities of destination for trips by residents in the fourth quarter of 2018 were Andalucía (with 15.5% of the total), Cataluña (11.2%) and Comunidad de Madrid (9.8%).

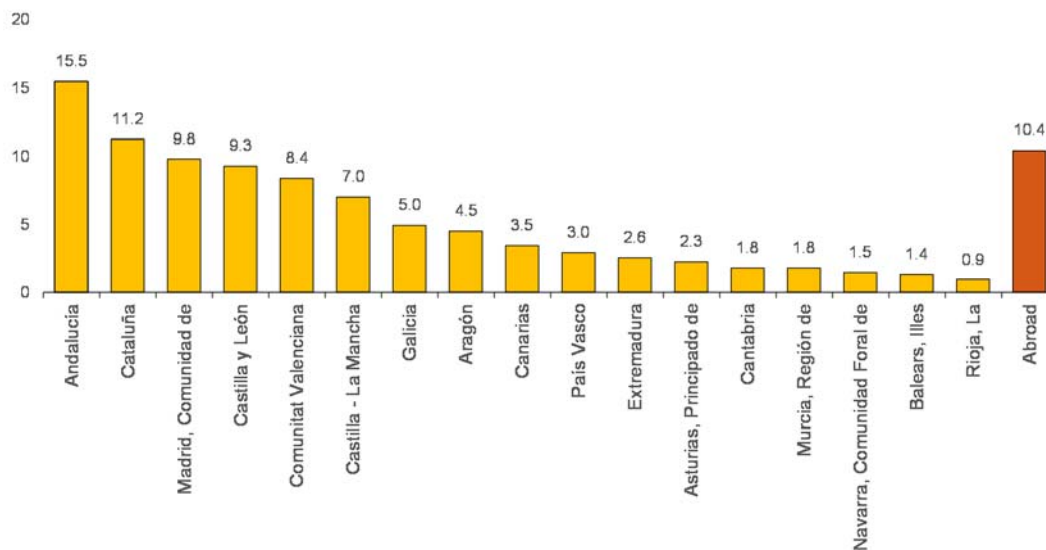
If domestic trips by residents are related to the destination, the phenomenon of travel was more intense in Castilla y León (with 1529 trips per 1,000 inhabitants<sup>2</sup>), Castilla-La Mancha (1,387) and Aragón (1,334).

<sup>2</sup> For the calculation of this indicator, we have used both the trips of the population aged 15 and over as well as the population aged 15 and over residing in the destination (calculated as an average of the population for each of the months of the quarter).

## Autonomous Communities of origin

Trips made by residents in Comunidad de Madrid represented 17.7% of the total in the fourth quarter. This was followed by Cataluña (15.5%) and Andalucía (15.0%).

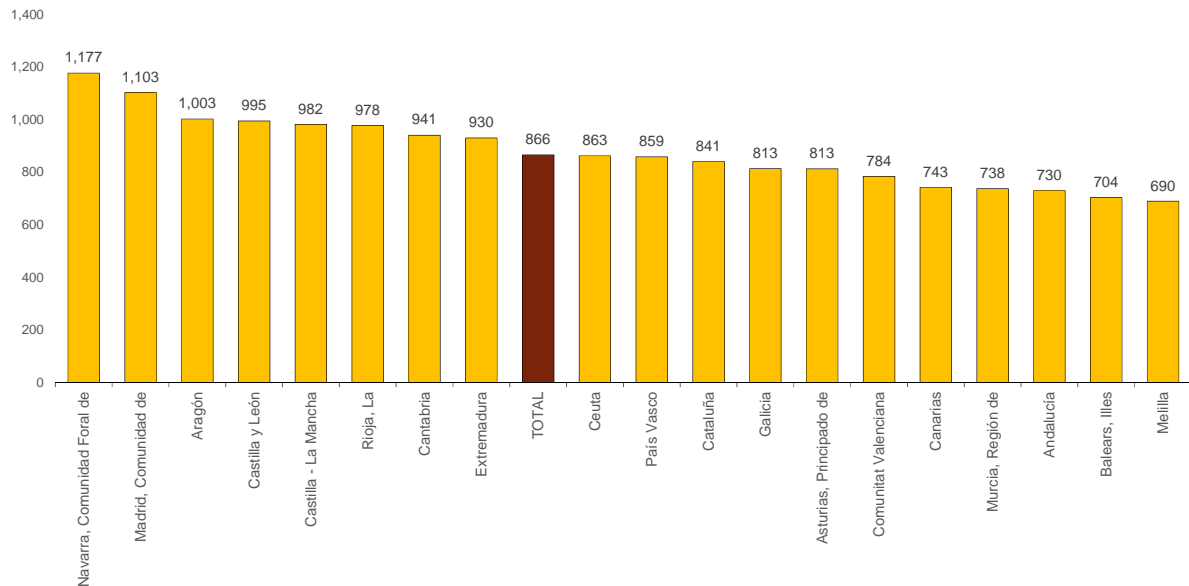
\* This indicator considers both the trips of the population of 15 years and over and the population aged 15 and over resident in origin (calculated as the mean of the three months of the quarter).

Removing the effect caused by the size of each Autonomous Community, those who travel the most were residents in Comunidad Foral de Navarra (1,177 trips per 1,000 inhabitants<sup>3</sup>), Comunidad de Madrid (1,103) and Aragón (1,003).

In turn, residents who travel the least were those residing in Illes Balears (704 trips per 1,000 inhabitants), Andalucía (730) and Región de Murcia (738).

<sup>3</sup> This considers the resident population aged 15 years old or over (calculated as the average of the population of each of the months of the quarter).

## Travel expenses

The total travel expenditure in the fourth quarter reached 9.028 million euros, indicating a 5.0% increase as compared with the same period of 2017.

In trips to domestic destinations, total expenditure rose by 0.6% and in those made abroad by 13.6%.

The average daily expenditure was 56 euros for domestic trips and 119 euros for trips abroad.

In domestic trips, *expenditure on bar and restaurants* represented the largest percentage of the total expenditure (26.1%), followed by *expenditure on transport* (24.7%). The former increased by 1.8% compared to the fourth quarter of 2017 and the latter by 2.5%.

On trips abroad, *expenditure on transport* represented 30.4% of the total, with an annual increase of 9.8%.

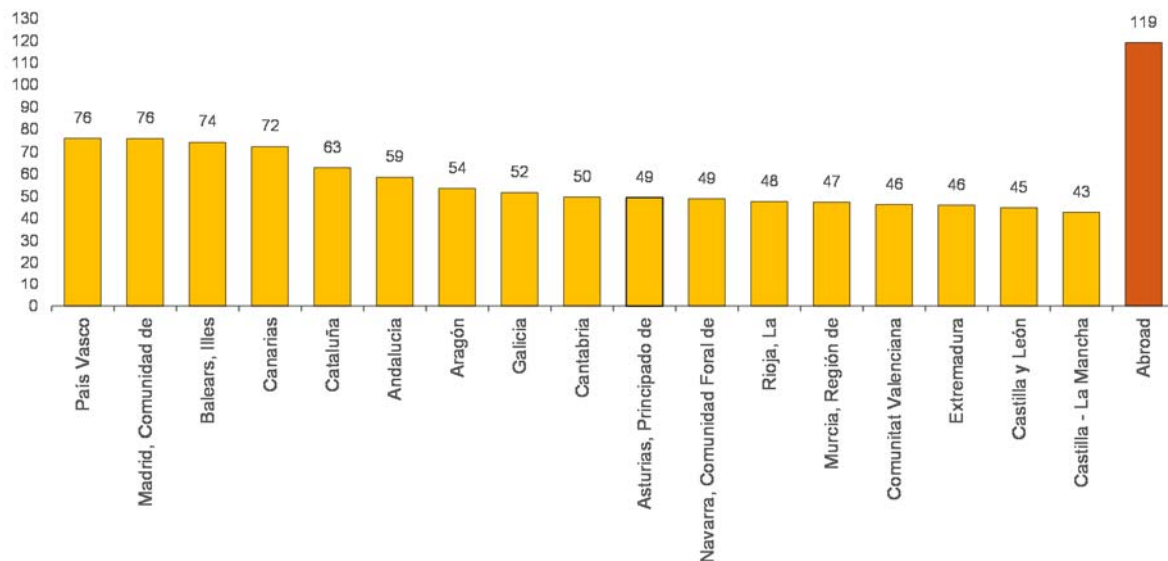

According to the main Autonomous Community of destination, the highest average daily expenditure were registered in trips to País Vasco and Comunidad de Madrid (76 euros in both cases), and Illes Balears (74 euros).

In turn, the lowest average daily expenditure were in Castilla-La Mancha (43 euros), Castilla y León (45) and Extremadura and Comunitat Valenciana (46 euros).

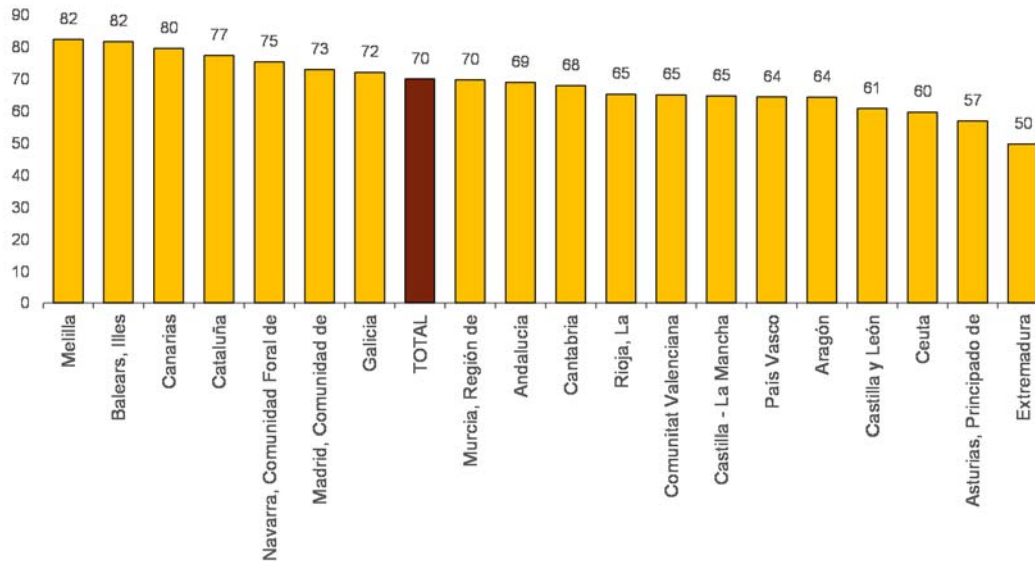
## Average daily expenditure per person according to destination



By Autonomous Community of origin, the highest average daily expenditure was made by residents of Illes Balears (82 euros), Canarias (80) and Cataluña (77).

In turn, the lowest were registered in Extremadura (50 euros), Principado de Asturias (57) and Castilla y León (61).

## Monthly data

In October there were 14.5 million trips, in November 12.1 million and in December 13.5 million. The average duration of trips varies from 2.9 overnight stays for trips ended in November to 3.4 overnight stays for trips ended in December.

December is the month with the lowest percentage of trips within the Autonomous Community of residence (45.3%, compared to 47.4% in October and 49.5% in November). However, it is the month with the highest percentage of trips abroad (11.6%).

*Leisure, recreation and holiday* trips were the main reason for trips in October (44.5% of the total) and November (43.0%). In December, the main reason was *Visits to family or friends* (47.7%). This month recorded the lowest level of business trips for this quarter (7.2%).

Non-market accommodation represented 65.8% of the total trips in December, compared to 60.8% in October and 62.2% in November.

## Excursions

The resident population aged 15 years or older made 71.4 million excursions<sup>4</sup> in the fourth quarter of 2018, with an annual increase of 2.4%. 96.7% of excursions were made for personal reasons and 3.3% for professional reasons.

87.8% of the excursions were made within the Autonomous Community of residence, with an annual increase of 2.0%.

10.9% of excursions were to another Autonomous Community and 1.3% to foreign countries. The number of excursions increased by 4.3% in the former and by 13.2% in those with destination abroad.

<sup>4</sup> An excursion is considered to be any visit without overnight stay outside the usual environment of the person. These exclude those which are part of the routine of the individual, as well as those made from second homes, from a cruise or any accommodation other than the usual.

## Results for the whole year 2018

Spanish residents made **197.5** million trips for the whole year 2018, **2.0%** more than in 2017. Overnight stays for these trips exceeded **801.9** million, a figure similar to that of 2017 (801.9 million). In turn, the total associated expenditure increased by 6.4%, reaching **47,081.9** million euros.

90.2% of trips had Spain as main destination and 9.8% abroad. Domestic trips accounted for 81.0% of overnight stays and 65.8% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 48 euros.

In turn, trips abroad accounted for 19.0% of overnight stays and 34.2% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 106 euros.

The main reason for the trip was leisure (51.0% of the total) and visits to relatives or friends (**35.7%**).

Leisure trips accounted for 60.0% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 64 euros. The highest average daily expenditure was registered in business trips (116 euros).

Residents chose non-market accommodation in 62.1% of the total number of trips. Those trips, which accounted for **60.8%** of overnight stays, registered the lowest average daily expenditure (30 euros). The highest average daily expenditure (134 euros) was registered on trips with hotel accommodation.

In domestic trips, expenditure on bar and restaurants represented the largest percentage of the total expenditure (26.8%), followed by expenditure on accommodation (24.5%) and expenditure on transport (22.9%).

In trips abroad, the item with the greatest weight was transport (29.2% of the total), followed by expenditure on accommodation (20.3%) and tourist package (18.8%).

By quarter, the highest average daily expenditure was recorded in the second and fourth quarters for domestic trips (57 euros) and in the second quarter for trips abroad (132 euros).

On the other hand, the lowest average daily expenditures were registered during the third quarter (40 euros for domestic trips and 90 euros for those made abroad).

Andalucía was the most visited destination in 2018 with 16.6% of total trips, followed by Cataluña (12.8%) and Comunitat Valenciana (9.9%).

The least visited destinations were La Rioja (0.8% of the total), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (1.3%) and Illes Balears (1.8%).

The highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips to Illes Balears (75 euros), Comunidad de Madrid (74) and Canarias (68).

In turn, the lowest average values were registered in Castilla–La Mancha (35 euros) and in Castilla y León and Extremadura (37).

Residents in Comunidad de Madrid accounted for the highest percentage of trips in 2018 (18.1% of the total), followed by residents in Cataluña (17.0%) and Andalucía (15.4%).

The highest average daily expenditure corresponded to residents in Illes Balears (73 euros per day), Canarias (68) and Cataluña (66).

On the contrary, the lowest were among residents in Extremadura (50 euros), Región de Murcia (52) and Comunitat Valenciana (53).

### Review and update of data

Data for 2018 are provisional and will be reviewed when the data for the same period of the next year are published. In other words, when the data for the fourth quarter of 2019 are published, the final data for the fourth quarter of 2018 will be disseminated, in addition to the year as a whole.

## Methodological note

The main objective of the Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR) is to provide information on the trips and excursions carried out each month by the population resident in Spain, both within the country and abroad, and their main characteristics (duration, expenditure, reason, accommodation, etc.).

In addition, the survey provides annual information on the percentage of the population travelling for personal reasons and investigates the reasons given by those who do not travel.

**Type of operation:** quarterly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** population aged 15 and over resident in family dwellings (they also provide indirect information on the trips of children under 15).

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory.

**Reference period of the results:** month, quarter, year (depending on the variable and the degree of disaggregation).

**Sample size:** the effective monthly sample is around 8,200 persons, who provide information on the trips completed in the two months prior to the interview. Thus, the results of a reference month are obtained from around 16,400 questionnaires.

**Type of sampling:** two-stage stratified random sampling. The framework is the set of main dwellings that have collaborated in the Continuous Household Survey (CHS). In each stratum of the CHS, the first stage units are the main family dwellings and the second stage units are the persons aged 15 and over residing in these dwellings. A variable defining the household's propensity to travel is used as a stratification criterion.

The selected persons collaborate three times in alternate months over six months, leave the sample one semester, and are interviewed another three times during the following semester.

**Collection method:** computer-assisted telephone or personal interviews, online questionnaire (since 2018).
