Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR) Fourth quarter 2019 and year 2019. Provisional data

The number of trips made by residents in Spain increases by 0.9% in the fourth quarter of 2019 and stands at 40.5 million

Total expenditure increased by 0.9% reaching 9,022 million euros

In the whole of 2019, the number of trips decreased by 1.1% while expenditure grew by 2.4%

Residents in Spain made 40.5 million trips in the fourth quarter of 2019, 0.9% more than that registered in the same period of 2018.

The main destination of 90.4% of the trips was the national territory, with an increase of 1.7% as compared to the fourth quarter of 2018. On the other hand, trips abroad, which represent 9.6% of the total, decreased by 6.0%.

Trips according to purpose, accommodation and main transport

During the fourth quarter of 2019, *Visits to relatives or friends*, which are the main purpose of 41.8% of trips, decreased 0.2%. Trips for Leisure, recreation and holidays, which represented 41.5% of the total, registered an annual decrease of 2.1%.

In turn, trips taken for *Business and other professional reasons* and those made for *Other reasons*¹ increased by 6.6% and 20.2%, respectively.

The main reason for travelling within Spain during the fourth quarter of 2019 was visiting relatives or friends (43.7%). On the other hand, most trips abroad were made for leisure purposes (58.6%).

¹ Other reasons include shopping tourism, travelling to the study centre, other trips for education and training, health, religious reasons, company incentive trips and all other trips for personal reasons not included in another category.

In 65.9% of domestic trips, residents stayed in family or friends' dwellings. That is 24.1 million trips, 0.3% less than in the fourth quarter of 2018.

For trips abroad, hotel accommodation was the preferred option (53.7% of trips). This type of accommodation registered an annual decrease of 11.3%.

As for the main type of transport used, own vehicles accounted for 79.1% of domestic trips, 0.3% less than in the same quarter of 2018.

In 68.1% of the trips abroad, air transport was used, with a decrease of 5.3%.

Main destinations

The main Autonomous Communities of destination for trips by residents in the fourth quarter of 2019 were Andalucía (with 16.1% of the total), Cataluña (13.3%) and Castilla y León (9.8%).

If domestic trips by residents are related to the destination, the phenomenon of travel was more intense in Castilla y León (with 1689 trips per 1,000 inhabitants²), Aragón (with 1,269) and Cantabria (1,189).



Autonomous Communities of origin

Trips made by residents in Comunidad de Madrid represented 16.9% of the total in the fourth quarter. This was followed by Cataluña (16.7%) and Andalucía (16.1%).


Trips according to Autonomous Community of residence of the travellers



Removing the effect caused by each Autonomous Community's size, those travelling the most were from Aragón (1,092 trips per 1,000 inhabitants³), Castilla y León (1,066) and Comunidad de Madrid (1,057).

In turn, Comunitat Valenciana (655 trips per one thousand inhabitants), Región de Murcia (664) and Canarias (672) were the Autonomous Communities with the lowest number of trips by inhabitants.





³ This considers the resident population aged 15 years old or over (calculated as the average of the population of each of the months of the quarter).

Travel expenses

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The total travel expenditure in the fourth quarter reached 9.022 million euros, indicating a 0.9% increase as compared with the same period of 2018.

On trips to domestic destinations, spending increased 5.9%, while on trips abroad it decreased 7.9%.

The average daily expenditure was 58 euros for domestic trips and 126 euros for trips abroad.

In domestic trips, *Expenditure in bars and restaurants* represented the largest percentage of the total expenditure (25.3%), followed by *Expenditure on transport* (24.8%). The former increased by 2.9% compared to the fourth quarter of 2018 and the latter increased by 18.9%.

On trips abroad, *Expenditure on transport* represented 30.5% of the total, with an annual increase of 7.7%.



According to the main Autonomous Community of destination, the highest average daily expenditure were registered in trips to País Vasco and Comunidad de Madrid (79 euros in both cases), and Canarias (72 euros).

In turn, the lowest average expenditure values were registered in Castilla–La Mancha (40 euros) and in Castilla y León and Galicia (47 euros each).




Average daily expenditure per person according to destination

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By Autonomous Community of origin, the highest average daily expenditure was made by residents of Región de Murcia (81 euros), Cataluña, and Illes Balears (79 in both).

In turn, the lowest were registered in Castilla y León (60 euros), Castilla-La Mancha (62) and Aragón (63).

Monthly data

In October there were 12.9 million trips, in November 12.3 million and in December 15.2 million. The trips taken had an average duration of 3.4 overnight stays in October, 2.9 in November and 3.1 in December.

October and December are the months with the lowest percentage of trips within the Autonomous Community of residence (48.2% compared to 51.0% in November). The month with the highest percentage of trips abroad is December, with 10.5%.

Leisure, recreation and holiday trips were the main reason for the trip in October (44.2% of the total for that month) and November (41.2%). In December, the main reason was *Visits to family or friends* (48.6%). This month recorded the lowest level of business trips for this quarter.

Non-market accommodation represented 65.6% of the total trips in December, compared to 59.4% in October and 60.4% in November.

Trips by month and main characteristics

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Excursions

The resident population aged 15 years or older took 60.4 million excursions⁴ in the fourth quarter of 2019, with an annual decrease of 11,7%. 95.9% of excursions were made for personal reasons and 4.1% for professional reasons.

88.2% of the excursions were made within the Autonomous Community of residence, with an annual decrease of 11.2%.

10.6% of excursions were to another Autonomous Community and 1.1% to foreign countries. The number of excursions decreased by 14.4% in the former and by 20.4% in those with destinations abroad.

⁴ An excursion is considered to be any visit without overnight stay outside the usual environment of the person. These exclude those which are part of the routine of the individual, as well as those made from second homes, from a cruise or any accommodation other than the usual.

Results for the whole year 2019

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Spanish residents made 193.9 million trips for the whole year 2019, 1.1% less than in 2018. Overnight stays corresponding to those trips exceeded 793.9 million, with a decrease of 0.3%. In turn, the related total expenditure increased by 2.4% reaching 48,066 million euros.

89.6% of trips had Spain as main destination and 10.4% abroad. Domestic trips accounted for 81.8% of overnight stays and 66.6% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 49 euros.

In turn, trips abroad accounted for 18.2% of overnight stays and 33.4% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 111 euros.

The main reason for the trip was leisure (51.7% of the total) and visits to relatives or friends (34.5%).

Leisure trips accounted for 60.1% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 66 euros. The highest average daily expenditure was registered in business trips (117 euros).

Residents chose non-market accommodation in 59.7% of the total number of trips. Those trips, which accounted for 59.6% of overnight stays, registered the lowest average daily expenditure (31 euros). On the other hand, the highest average daily expenditure was for trips with hotel accommodation (133 euros).

In domestic trips, *expenditure on bar and restaurants* represented the largest percentage of the total expenditure (26.5%), followed by expenditure on *accommodation* (24.9%) and on *transportation* (21.8%).

As for trips abroad, the item with the greatest weight on the total was *expenditure on transportation* (29.0%), followed by *expenditure on accommodation* (21.1%) and on package holidays (17.4%).

By quarter, the highest average daily expenditure was recorded in the second quarter, for both domestic trips (59 euros) and trips abroad (137 euros).

On the other hand, the lowest average daily expenditures were registered during the third quarter (41 euros for domestic trips and 97 euros for those made abroad).

Andalucía was the destination of 16.9% of all trips made in 2019, followed by Cataluña (13.0%) and Comunitat Valenciana (10.2%).

The least visited destinations were La Rioja (0.8% of the total), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (1.5%) and Illes Balears (1.7%).

The highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips to Comunidad de Madrid (75 euros), Canarias (72) and Illes Balears (69).

On the other hand, the lowest average values were for Castilla-La Mancha and Castilla y León (37 euros each community) and Extremadura (41).

Residents in Comunidad de Madrid accounted for the highest percentage of trips in 2019 (18.2% of the total), followed by residents in Cataluña (17.3%) and Andalucía (15.3%).

The highest average daily expenditure corresponded to residents in Illes Balears (74 euros per day), Canarias (73) and Cataluña (68).

In contrast, the lowest average daily expenses were in Aragon (54 euros), Extremadura (55) and País Vasco and the Región de Murcia (both with 56).

Data Review and Updates

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data from the Resident Tourism Survey for the fourth quarter of 2018, which is now definitive, and with that the data for the year as a whole. The results are available at INEBase.

Methodological note

The main objective of the Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR) is to provide information on the trips and excursions carried out each month by the population resident in Spain, both within the country and abroad, and their main characteristics (duration, expenditure, reason, accommodation, etc.).

In addition, the survey provides annual information on the percentage of the population travelling for personal reasons and investigates the reasons given by those who do not travel.

Type of operation: quarterly continuous survey.

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Population scope: Resident population aged 15 and over in family dwellings (indirect information regarding trips taken by children under 15 is also provided).

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Reference period of the results: month, quarter, year (depending on the variable and the degree of disaggregation).

Sample size: the effective monthly sample is around 8,200 persons, who provide information on the trips completed in the two months prior to the interview. Thus, the results of a reference month are obtained from around 16,400 questionnaires.

Type of sampling: stratified two-stage random sampling. The framework is the set of main dwellings that have collaborated in the Continuous Household Survey (CHS). In each stratum of the CHS, the first stage units are the main family dwellings and the second stage units are the persons aged 15 and over residing in these dwellings. A variable defining the household's propensity to travel is used as a stratification criterion.

The selected persons collaborate three times in alternate months over six months, leave the sample one semester, and are interviewed another three times during the following semester.

Collection method: computer-assisted telephone or personal interviews, online questionnaire (since 2018).
