Residents Travel Survey (RTS/FAMILITUR)
Fourth quarter year 2020 and year 2020.

The number of trips made by residents in Spain decreased 57.6% in the fourth quarter of 2020 and stands at 17.2 million

Total expenditure for this quarter decreased by 70.6% reaching 2,650 million euros

In the year 2020 as a whole, trips by residents decreased by 47.6% and spending fell by 56.0%

Effects of COVID-19 on RTE

- The health crisis caused by COVID-19 had an effect on the movement of residents during 2020; the freedom of circulation was limited. This was first due to the initial state of alarm and, after this came to an end, to the restrictions imposed by the autonomous communities. In turn, many countries have maintained restrictive measures for travellers entering their territories from Spain (such as quarantines, PCR tests or entry bans).

- For 2020 as a whole, this resulted in decreases of 47.6% in trips, 37.9% in overnight stays and 56.0% in spending. - Travel abroad was the most affected, with declines of 74.8% in trips, 70.4% in overnight stays and 77.7% in spending.

- As far as travel motivation, trips to the workplace, for nature tourism, and health treatments decreased the least in 2020, with rates of -14.1%, -33.1% and -33.5%, respectively.

- By primary accommodation, trips with hotel accommodations decreased the most (-63.2%). Among those who used market accommodations, trips with rural accommodations decreased the least (-38.8%), while in non-market accommodations, the smallest decrease was registered for those who stayed in the homes of family and friends (-39.4%).

- In terms of means of transport, the most affected trips were those that used air transport (-71.0%). Those least affected used land transport (-44.4%).

- National day-trips decreased by 37.8%, and those abroad, by 56.4%.

Residents in Spain made 17.2 million trips in the fourth quarter of 2020, 57.6% less than for the same period in 2019.

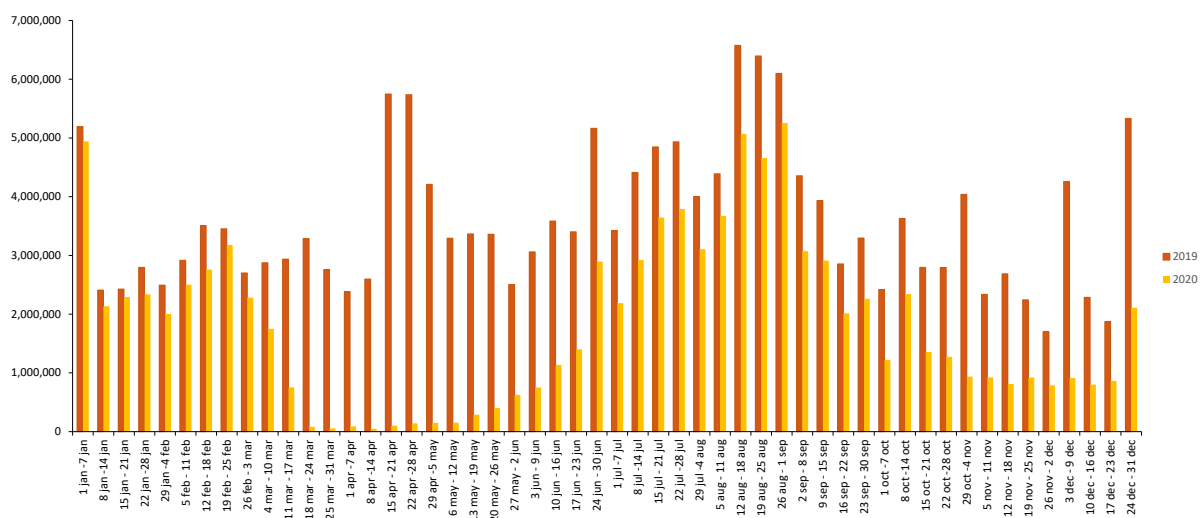
The main destination of 97.7% of the trips was the national territory, with a decrease of 54.2% as compared to the fourth quarter of 2019. On the other hand, trips abroad, which represent 2.3% of the total, decreased by 89.7%.

By weeks¹, a decrease in trips was observed throughout the year. This tendency was exacerbated by the confinement during the state of alarm. With the suspension of this exceptional regime, travel increased progressively throughout the summer, but it fell once again in the last quarter during the second wave of the pandemic.

Trips according to purpose, accommodation and main transport

Visits to family or friends were the main reason for 43.4% of domestic trips in the fourth quarter. They were down 54.4% compared to the same period in 2019.

In turn, trips for *Leisure, recreation and holidays*, which represented 32.7% of the total, decreased by 62.1%.

¹ In order to study trips by return date, trips to workplaces and centres of study were excluded (7.1% of the trips in 2020) Also note that the last week of the third and fourth quarters of the graph have eight days, to complete the days in the quarter.

Trips for *Business and other professional reasons* decreased by 28.4%, and those made for *Other reasons*² decreased by 44.1%.

The main reason for trips abroad was leisure, with 45.6% of the total and a decrease of 91.9% compared to the fourth quarter of 2019.

In 48.7% of domestic trips, residents stayed in family or friends' dwellings. That is 8.2 million trips, 51.1% less than in the fourth quarter of 2019.

For trips abroad, market accommodation was the preferred option (59.4% of trips). This type of accommodation registered an annual decrease of 91.7%.

As for the main type of transport used, own vehicles accounted for 86.5% of domestic trips, 49.9% less than in the same quarter of 2019.

Trips in a personal vehicle accounted for 59.1% of trips abroad (a decrease of 75.3%), and travel by air for 38.8% of trips (a decrease of 94.1%).

Main destinations

The main Autonomous Community destinations for trips by residents in the fourth quarter of 2020 were Andalucía (with 15.3% of the total), Comunitat Valenciana (14.5%) and Cataluña (13.5%).

If domestic trips of residents are related with the population of the destination, the phenomenon of trips was more intense in Castilla y León (with 647 trips per 1,000 inhabitants³), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (with 599) and Aragón (550).

³ For the calculation of this indicator, we have used both the trips of the population aged 15 and over as well as the population aged 15 and over residing in the destination (calculated as an average of the population for each of the months of the quarter).

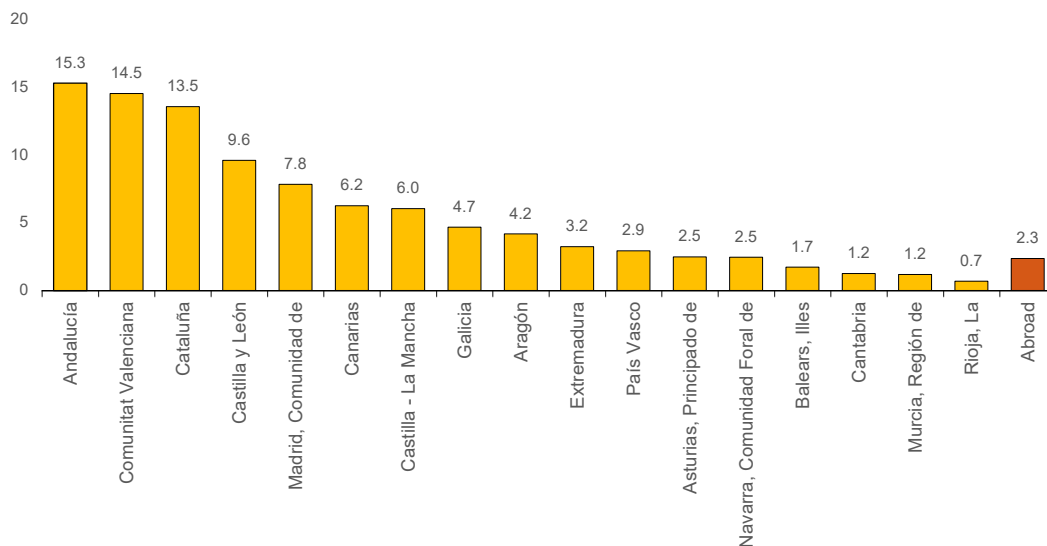

Autonomous Communities of origin

Trips made by residents in Andalucía accounted for 14.4% of the total in the fourth quarter. This was followed by Cataluña (14.2%) and Comunitat Valenciana (14.1%).

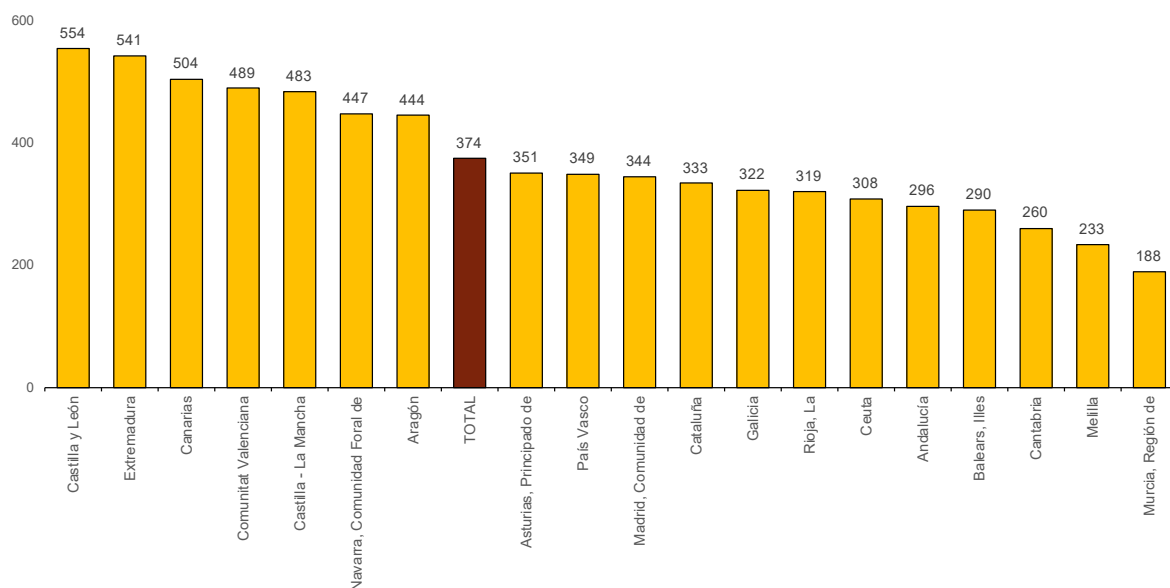

Removing the effect caused by each Autonomous Community's size, those travelling the most were from Castilla y León (554 trips per 1,000 inhabitants⁴), Extremadura (541) and Canarias (504).

In turn, those who travelled the least were residents of Región de Murcia (188 trips per 1,000 inhabitants), Cantabria (260) and Illes Balears (290).

Travel expenses

The total travel expenditure in the fourth quarter reached 2.650 million euros, indicating a 70.6% decrease as compared with the same period of 2019.

In trips to domestic destinations, total expenditure fell by 60.2% and in those made abroad by 91.8%.

The average daily expenditure was 41 euros for domestic trips and 61 euros for trips abroad.

In domestic trips, other *expenses* represented the largest percentage of the total expenditure (30.8%), followed by *expenditure on transport* (24.3%). The former decreased by 50.5% compared to the fourth quarter of 2019 and the latter by 58.6%.

On trips abroad, *Expenditure on transport* represented 32.4% of the total, with an annual increase of 91.3%.

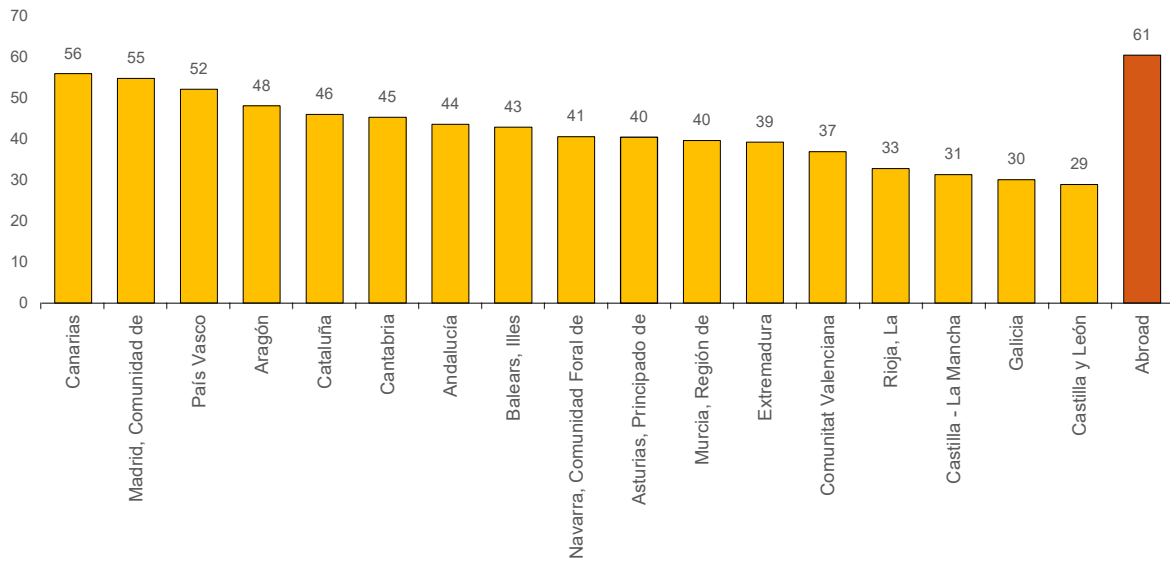

According to the main destination Autonomous Community, the highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips made to Canarias (56 euros), Comunidad de Madrid (55) and País Vasco (52).

In turn, the lowest average daily expenditure were in Castilla y León (29 euros), Galicia (30) and Castilla-La Mancha (31 euros).

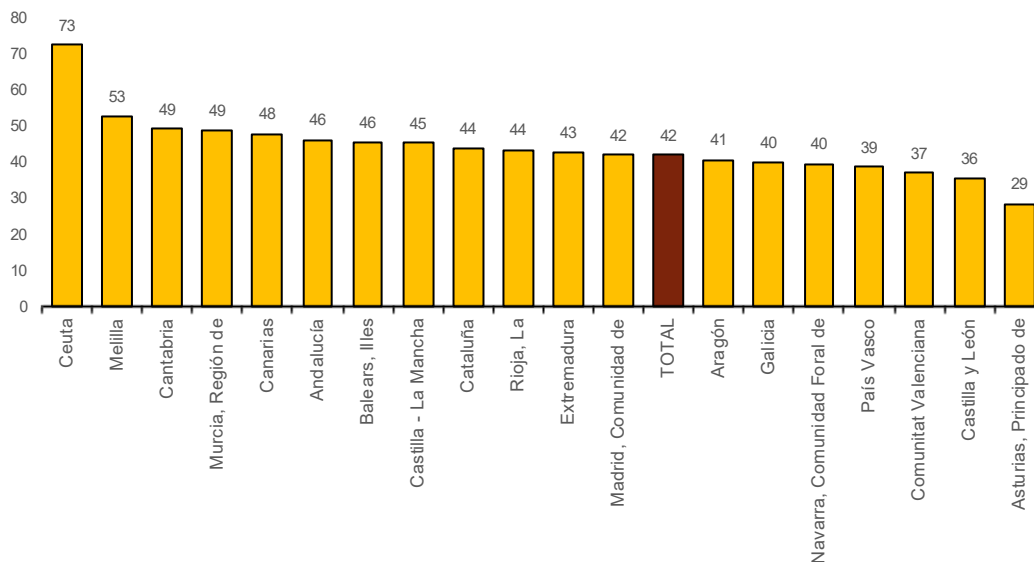
Average daily expenditure per person according to destination Fourth quarter 2020



By Autonomous Community of origin, the highest average daily expenditure was made by residents of Cantabria and Región de Murcia (49 euros in both), and Canarias (48).

On the other hand, the lowest were in Principado de Asturias (29 euros), Castilla y León (36) and Comunitat Valenciana (37 euros).

Monthly data

In October there were 7.1 million trips, in November 4.7 million and in December 5.4 million. The trips taken had an average duration of 3.7 overnight stays in October, 3.2 in November and 4.0 in December.

October is the month with the lowest percentage of trips within the Autonomous Community of residence (63.0%, compared to 78.1% in November and 71.5% in December). However, it is the month with the highest percentage of trips abroad (4.0%).

Leisure, recreation and holiday trips were the main reason for the trip in October (44.0% of the total for that month). In November, the main reason was *Visits to family or friends* (40.8% and 54.6%, respectively). In December, the lowest level of business trips for this quarter was recorded.

Non-market accommodation represented 77.3% of the total trips in December, compared to 77.0% in November and 66.1% in October.

Excursions

The resident population aged 15 years or older took 35.2 million excursions⁵ in the fourth quarter of 2020, with an annual decrease of 41.8%. 96.0% of excursions were made for personal reasons and 4.0% for professional reasons.

95.2% of the excursions were made within the Autonomous Community of residence, with an annual decrease of 37.2%.

4.4% of excursions were to another Autonomous Community and 0.4% to foreign countries. The number of excursions decreased by 76.0% in the former and by 78.7% in those with destinations abroad.

⁵ An excursion is considered any visit without an overnight stay outside the person's usual environment. Trips that are part of someone's normal routine are excluded, as are those made from second homes, from a cruise ship, or from any other accommodation other than the usual one.

Results for the whole year 2020

Spanish residents made 101.5 million trips for the whole year 2020, 47.6% less than in 2019. Overnight stays corresponding to those trips exceeded 493.4 million, with a decrease of 37.9%. In turn, the total associated expenditure fell by 56.0%, to 21,135 million euros.

95.0% of trips had Spain as main destination and 5.0% abroad. Domestic trips accounted for 91.3% of overnight stays and 83.1% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 39 euros.

In turn, trips abroad accounted for 8.7% of overnight stays and 16.9% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 84 euros.

The main reasons for trips during the year 2020 was leisure (47.0% of the total) and visits to relatives or friends (38.1%).

Leisure trips accounted for 55.9% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 46 euros. The highest average daily expenditure was registered in business trips (79 euros).

Residents chose non-market accommodation in 66.2% of the total number of trips. Those trips, which accounted for 69.6% of overnight stays, registered the lowest average daily expenditure (25 euros). The highest average daily expenditure (118 euros) was registered on trips with hotel accommodation.

In domestic trips, expenditure on lodgings represented the largest share of total expenditure (25.2%), followed by expenditure on bars and restaurants (24.1%) and in other expenses (24.1%).

In trips abroad, the item with the greatest weight on the total in 2020 was expenditure on transport (34.7%), followed by expenditure on accommodation (21.1%) and expenditure on bar or restaurants (18.1%).

By quarter, the highest average daily expenditure was recorded in the first quarter, for both domestic trips (54 euros) and trips abroad (98 euros).

Additionally, the lowest average expenses occurred in the second quarter for domestic trips (31 euros) and in the fourth for those made abroad (61 euros).

Andalucía was the destination of 18.6% of all trips made in the year 2020, followed by Cataluña (13.3%) and Comunitat Valenciana (11.4%).

The least visited destinations were La Rioja (0.9% of the total), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (1.7%) and Illes Balears (2.0%).

The highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips to Illes Balears (59 euros), Canarias (58) and Comunidad de Madrid (50).

On the other hand, the lowest average values were for Castilla y León (28 euros), and for Castilla-La Mancha and Región de Murcia (both with 30).

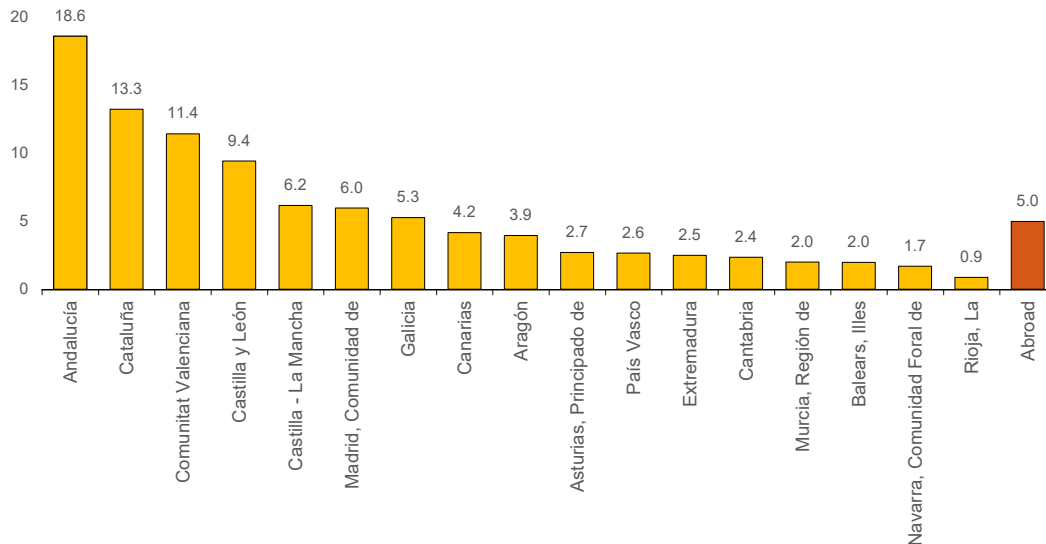

Residents in Comunidad de Madrid accounted for the highest percentage of trips in 2020 (17.2% of the total), followed by residents in Andalucía (16.4%) and Cataluña (16.1%).

The highest average daily expenditure corresponded to residents in Illes Balears (51 euros per day), Canarias (50) and Extremadura and Cataluña (48, in both cases).

In contrast, the lowest average daily expenses were in Comunitat Valenciana, Región de Murcia and the Principado de Asturias (38 euros, in all three cases).

Data Review and Update

The data published today is final and is not subject to further revision. All results are available on INEBase.

Methodological note

The main objective of the Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR) is to provide information on the trips and excursions carried out each month by the population resident in Spain, both within the country and abroad, and their main characteristics (duration, expenditure, reason, accommodation, etc.).

In addition, the survey provides annual information on the percentage of the population travelling for personal reasons and investigates the reasons given by those who do not travel.

Type of operation: quarterly continuous survey.

Population scope: Resident population aged 15 and over in family dwellings (indirect information regarding trips taken by children under 15 is also provided).

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Reference period of the results: month, quarter, year (depending on the variable and the degree of disaggregation).

Sample size: the effective monthly sample is around 8,200 persons, who provide information on the trips completed in the two months prior to the interview. Thus, the results of a reference month are obtained from around 16,400 questionnaires.

Type of sampling: stratified two-stage random sampling. The framework is the set of main dwellings that have collaborated in the Continuous Household Survey (CHS). In each stratum of the CHS, the first stage units are the main family dwellings and the second stage units are the persons aged 15 and over residing in these dwellings. A variable defining the household's propensity to travel is used as a stratification criterion.

The selected persons collaborate three times in alternate months over six months, leave the sample one semester, and are interviewed another three times during the following semester.

Collection method: computer-assisted telephone or personal interviews, online questionnaire (since 2018).
