**Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR)  
Fourth quarter year 2022 and year 2022**

**The number of trips made by residents in Spain increased 4.2% in the fourth quarter of 2022 and stands at 37.9 million**

**Total expenditure increased by 29.8% reaching 10,563.2 million euros**

**In 2022, the number of trips increased by 19.9% and expenditure by 54.6%**

Residents in Spain made 37.9 million trips in the fourth quarter of 2022, 4.2% more than that registered in the same period of 2021.

The main destination of 89.3% of the trips was within the national territory, with an increase of 0.9% as compared to the fourth quarter of the previous year. On the other hand, trips abroad increased by 44.5%, representing 10.7% of the total.

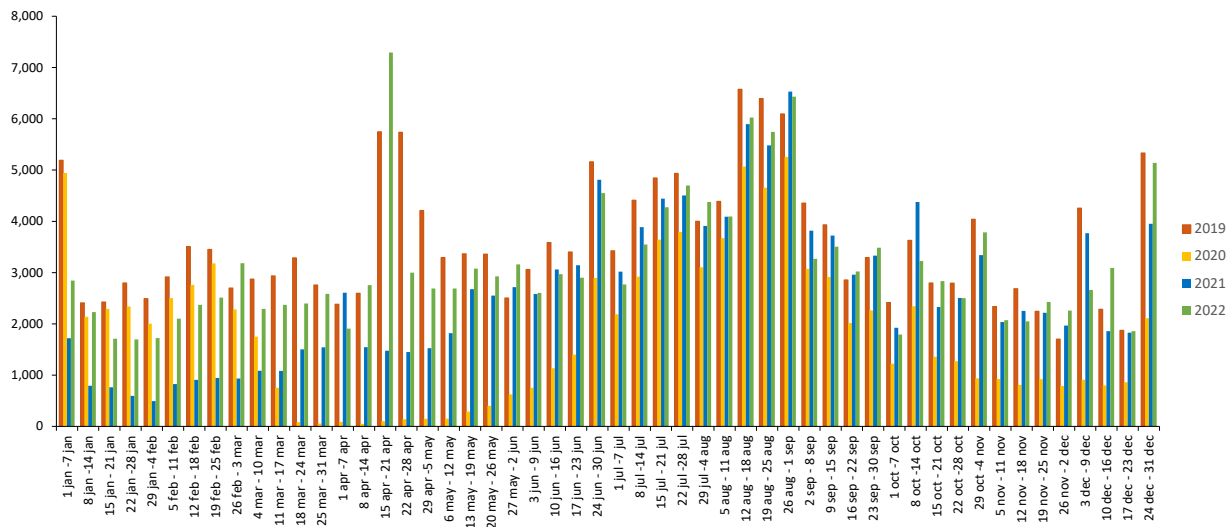

Looking at travel by week<sup>1</sup>, there is an increase in all weeks in the fourth quarter of 2022 compared to the previous year, except for the weeks with national holidays in October and December, which had a stronger calendar impact in 2021.

<sup>1</sup> In order to be able to study trips by date of return, trips for the purpose of commuting to work and school have been excluded (5.8% of trips in the fourth quarter and 4.6% of the total in 2022). Also note that the last week of the third and fourth quarters of the graph have eight days, to complete the days in the quarter.

## Trips according to purpose, accommodation and main transport

During the fourth quarter of 2022, *Leisure, recreation and holiday* trips, which were the main reason for 43.5% of trips, increased by 6.5%. Trips for *Visits to relatives or friends*, which represented 40.4% of the total, registered an annual increase of 4.5%.

Trips for *Business and other professional reasons* increased by 9.7%, while those made by *Other reasons*<sup>2</sup> fell by 18.9%.

The main reason for travelling within Spain during the fourth quarter was visiting relatives or friends (42.6%). On the other hand, most trips abroad were made for leisure purposes (58.3%).

In 44.3% of domestic trips, residents stayed in family or friends' dwellings. That is 15 million trips, 4.5% more than in the fourth quarter of 2021.

For trips abroad, market accommodation was the preferred option (73.5% of trips). This type of accommodation registered an annual increase of 42.4%.

As for the main type of transport used, own vehicles accounted for 79.2% of domestic trips, 1.6% less than in the same quarter of 2021.

In 69.6% of the trips abroad, air transport was used, with an increase of 60.2%.

**Main destinations**

The main Autonomous Communities of destination for trips by residents in the fourth quarter of 2022 were Andalucía (with 15.6% of the total), Cataluña (12.8%) and Castilla y León (9.6%).

If domestic trips by residents are related to the destination, the phenomenon of travel was more intense in Castilla y León (with 1,489 trips per 1,000 inhabitants<sup>3</sup>), Aragón (with 1,375) and Castilla-La Mancha (1,302).

<sup>3</sup> For the calculation of this indicator, we have used both the trips of the population aged 15 and over as well as the population aged 15 and over residing in the destination (calculated as an average of the population for each of the months of the quarter).

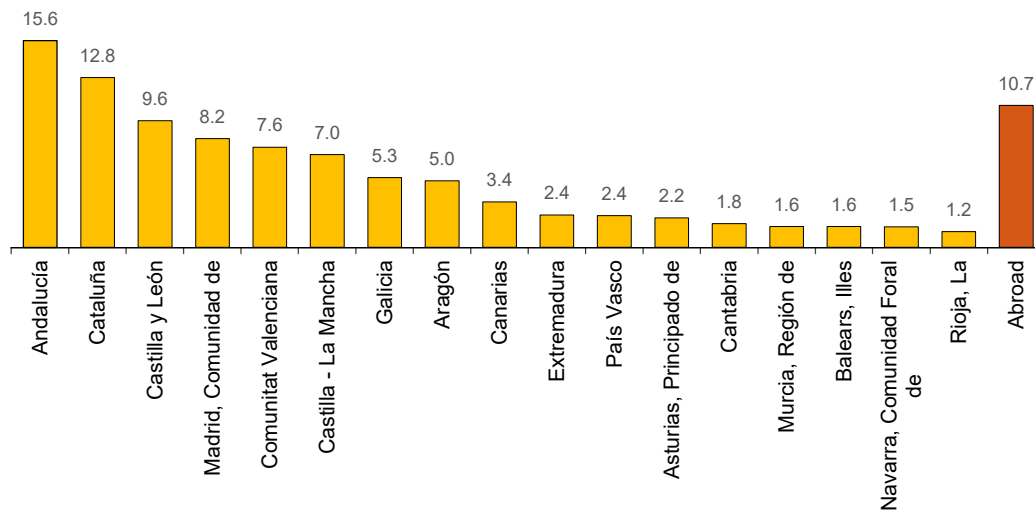

## Autonomous Communities of origin

Trips made by residents in Comunidad de Madrid represented 16.5% of the total in the fourth quarter. This was followed by Cataluña (16.3%) and Andalucía (15.2%).

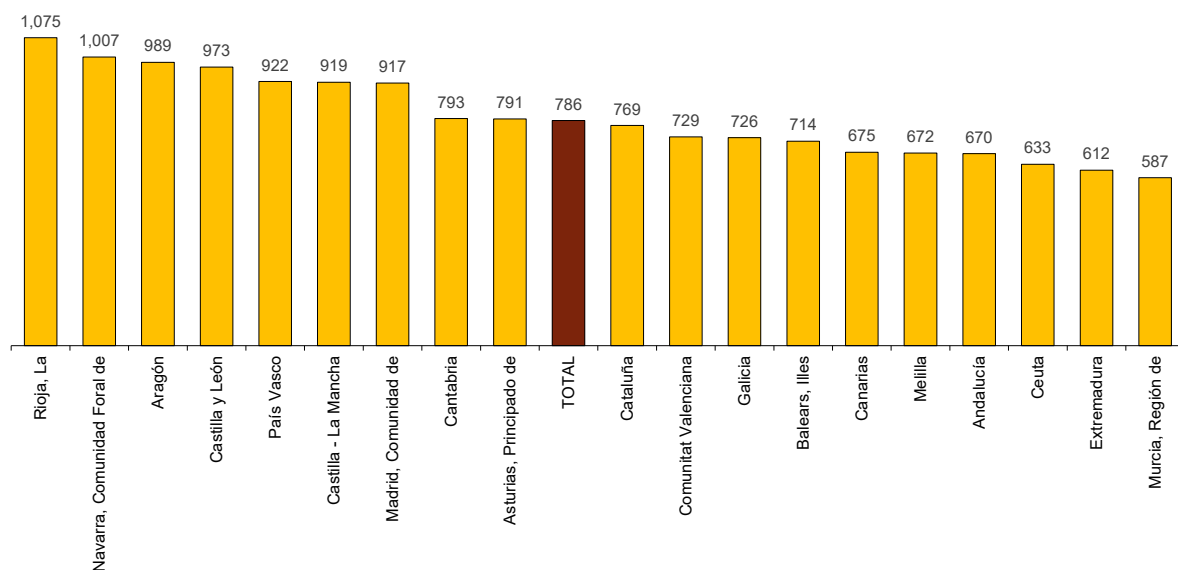

Removing the effect caused by the size of each Autonomous Community, those who travelled the most were residents of La Rioja (1,075 trips per 1,000 inhabitants<sup>4</sup>), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (1,007) and Aragón (989).

In turn, Region de Murcia (587 trips per one thousand inhabitants), Extremadura (612) and Andalucía (670) were the Autonomous Communities with the lowest ratio of trips by inhabitants.

## Travel expenses

The total travel expenditure in the fourth quarter reached 10.563.2 million euros, indicating a 29.8% increase as compared with the same period of 2021.

Total expenses on domestic trips increased by 12.2% and on trips abroad by 83.1%.

The average daily expenditure stood at 69 euros for domestic trips and 141 euros for trips abroad.

In domestic trips, *expenditure on bar and restaurants* represented the largest percentage of the total expenditure (25.5%), followed by *expenditure on transport* (24.4%). The former increased by 15.2% compared to the fourth quarter of 2021 and the latter by 15.3%.

On trips abroad, *expenditure on transport* represented 31.6% of the total, with an annual increase of 86.5%.

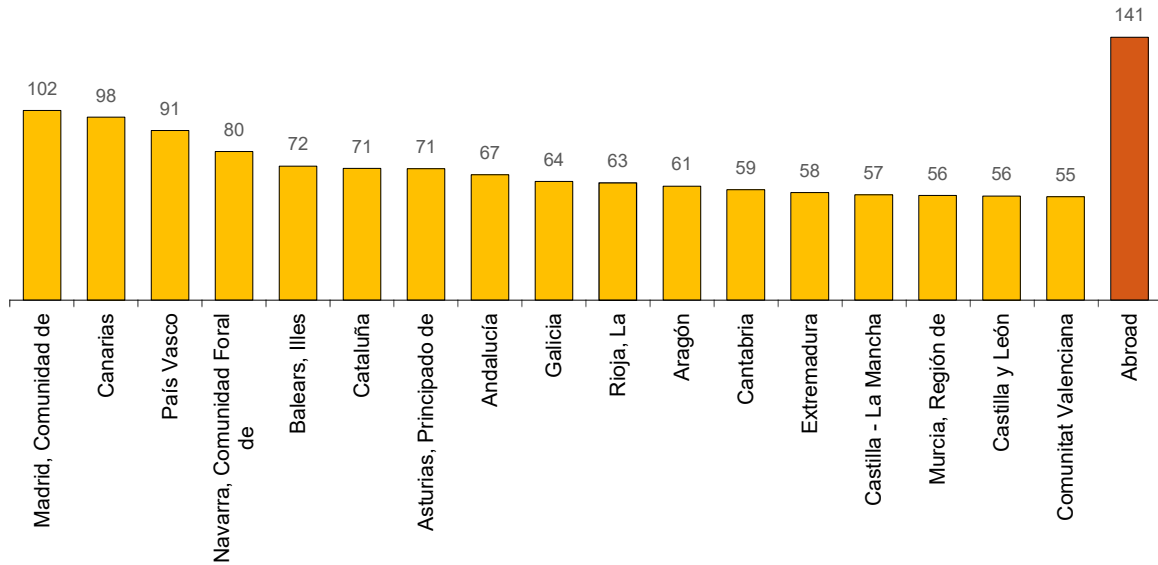

With regard to the main Autonomous Community of destination, the highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips to Comunidad de Madrid (102 euros), Canarias (98) and País Vasco (91).

In turn, the lowest average expenditure values were registered in Comunitat Valenciana (55 euros) and in Castilla y León and Región de Murcia (56 euros each).

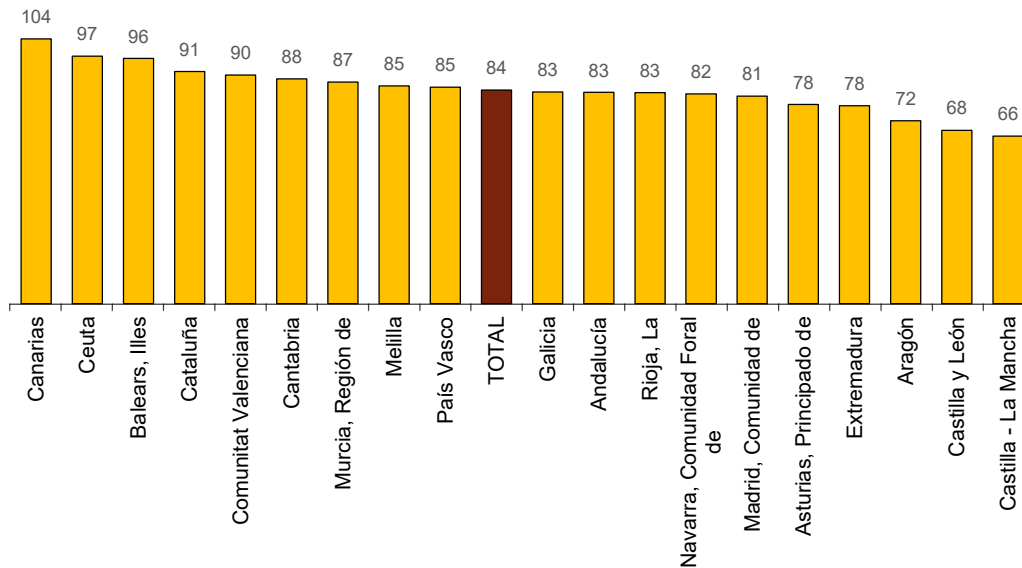
**Average daily expenditure per person according to destination Fourth quarter 2022**



By Autonomous Community of origin, the highest average daily expenditure was made by residents in Canarias (104 euros), Balears Illes Canarias (96) and Cataluña (91).

On the other hand, the lowest were in Castilla-La Mancha (66 euros), Castilla y León (68) and Extremadura (72 euros).

## Monthly data

In October there were 13.3 million trips, in November 11.0 million and in December 13.5 million. The trips taken had an average duration of 3.4 overnight stays in October, 3.0 in November and 3.5 in December.

December is the month with the lowest percentage of trips within the Autonomous Community of residence (42.0%, compared to 42.9% in October and 45.4% in November). However, it is the month with the highest percentage of trips abroad (12.3%).

*Leisure, recreation and holiday* trips were the main reason for the trip in October (46.6% of the total for that month) and November (43.7%). In December, the main reason was *Visits to family or friends* (47.6%). In December, the lowest level of business trips for this quarter was recorded.

Non-market accommodation represented 61.3% of the total trips in December, compared to 57.4% in October and 54.6% in November.

## Excursions

The resident population aged 15 years or older took 48.9 million excursions<sup>5</sup> in the fourth quarter of 2022, which resulted in an annual decrease of 8.0%. 97.9% of excursions were made for personal reasons and 2.1% for professional reasons.

86.8% of the excursions were made within the Autonomous Community of residence, with an annual decrease of 10.0%.

11.9% of excursions were to another Autonomous Community and 1.3% to foreign countries. The number of excursions to another autonomous community increased by 9.2%.

<sup>5</sup> An excursion is considered any visit without an overnight stay outside the person's usual environment. Trips that are part of someone's normal routine are excluded, as are those made from second homes, from a cruise ship, or from any other accommodation other than the usual one.

## Results for the whole year 2022

Spanish residents made 171.4 million trips for the whole year 2022, 19.9% more than in 2021. Overnight stays corresponding to those trips exceeded 745.8 million, with an increase of 19.1%. In turn, the total associated expenditure rose by 54.6%, to 50,292.0 million euros.

90.6% of trips had Spain as main destination and 9.4% abroad. Domestic trips accounted for 81.6% of overnight stays and 70.5% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 58 euros.

In turn, trips abroad accounted for 18.4% of overnight stays and 29.5% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 108 euros.

The main reason for travel in 2022 were leisure (51.6% of the total) and visits to relatives or friends (34.2%).

Leisure trips accounted for 59.8% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 75 euros. The highest average daily expenditure was registered in business trips (121 euros).

Residents chose non-market accommodation in 58.4% of the total number of trips. Those trips, which accounted for 59.3% of overnight stays, registered the lowest average daily expenditure (35 euros). The highest average daily expenditure (145 euros) was registered on trips with hotel accommodation.

In domestic trips, expenditure on lodgings represented the largest share of total expenditure (26.7%), followed by expenditure on bars and restaurants (25.6%) and on transport (21.5%).

In trips abroad, the item with the greatest weight on the total was expenditure on transport (30.4%), followed by expenditure on accommodation (21.9%) and expenditure on bar or restaurants (17.3%).

By quarters, the highest average daily expenditure was recorded for internal trips in the second and fourth quarters (69 euros in both) and for trips abroad in the fourth quarter (141 euros).

On the other hand, the lowest average daily expenditures were registered during the third quarter (49 euros for domestic trips and 93 euros for those made abroad).

Andalucía was the destination of 16.4% of all trips made in 2022, followed by Cataluña (14.1%) and Comunitat Valenciana (10.5%).

The least visited destinations were La Rioja (1.0% of the total), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (1.2%) and Región de Murcia (2.0%).

The highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips to Canarias (87 euros), Comunidad de Madrid (84) and País Vasco (82).

On the other hand, the lowest average values were for Castilla y León (43 euros), and for Región de Murcia and Castilla-La Mancha (both with 45).

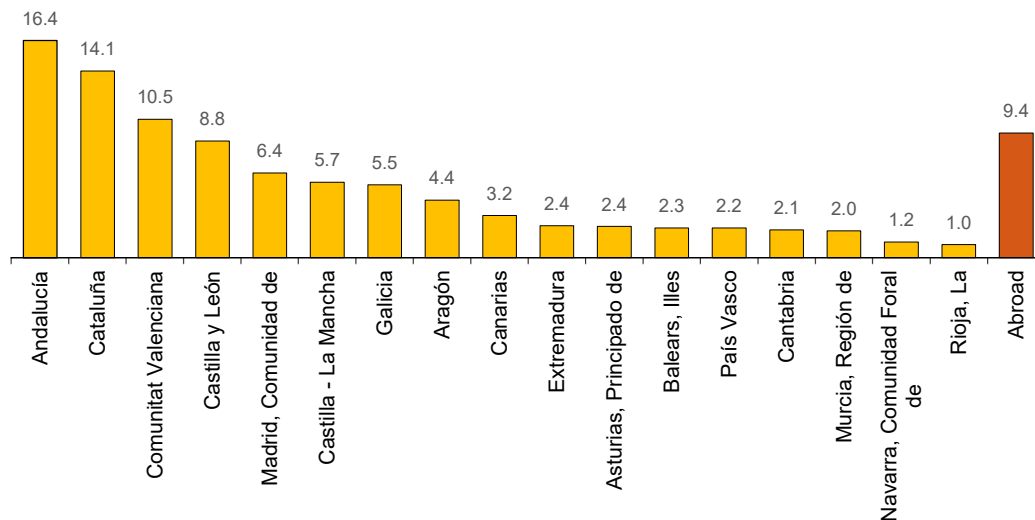

Residents in Comunidad de Madrid accounted for the highest percentage of trips in 2022 (18.4% of the total), followed by residents in Cataluña (17.6%) and Andalucía (14.6%).

The highest average daily expenditures corresponded to residents in Canarias (80 euros per day), Cataluña (75) and Galicia (72).

In turn, the lowest were registered in Región de Murcia (59 euros), La Rioja (60) and Aragón (62).

### Data Review and Update

The data published today is final and is not subject to further revision. All results are available on INEBase.

## Methodological note

The main objective of the Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR) is to provide information on the trips and excursions carried out each month by the population resident in Spain, both within the country and abroad, and their main characteristics (duration, expenditure, reason, accommodation, etc.).

In addition, the survey provides annual information on the percentage of the population travelling for personal reasons and investigates the reasons given by those who do not travel.

**Type of operation:** quarterly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** Resident population aged 15 and over in family dwellings (indirect information regarding trips taken by children under 15 is also provided).

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory.

**Reference period of the results:** month, quarter, year (depending on the variable and the degree of disaggregation).

**Sample size:** the effective monthly sample is around 8,200 persons, who provide information on the trips completed in the two months prior to the interview. Thus, the results of a reference month are obtained from around 16,400 questionnaires.

**Type of sampling:** stratified three-stage random sampling is used. The framework is the MDG Georeferenced Address Framework. The first stage units are the census sections, the second stage units are the dwellings, and a person aged 15 or over has been selected within each dwelling. The stratification criterion in the first stage was the size of the municipality to which the section belongs. In both cases, a variable is used as a substratification criterion to define the household's propensity to travel.

The selected persons collaborate three times in alternate months over six months, leave the sample one semester, and are interviewed another three times during the following semester.

**Collection method:** computer-assisted telephone or personal interviews, online questionnaire (since 2018).
