Services Sector Activity Indicators. Base 2005 January 2008. Provisional data

The Services Sector turnover grows 6.0% in January as compared with the same month of 2007

The interannual rate of employed persons increases 1.9%

The market Services Sector turnover increased 6.0% in January as compared with the same month of 2007.

All sectors contributed to this growth. Services Rendered to Companies was the sector that experienced the largest growth, with an interannual rate of 9.3%. It was followed by the Transport (6.2%), Trade and Information Technologies (both with 5.9%), and Tourism (3.2%) sectors.

In the area of Services Rendered to Companies, the most dynamic activities were Advertising (16.7%), Technical Services (11.8%) and Legal and Economic Advice (8.4%). Of the remaining activities, it was worth noting the interannual growth experienced by the turnover rates for Information Technologies Services (10.5%).



Aragón, País Vasco and Castilla y León register the highest interannual turnover growth rates

Aragón was the Autonomous Community that registered the highest interannual turnover growth during the month of January, with an interannual rate of 10.2%. It was followed by País Vasco, with an increase of 8.4% and Castilla y León, with an increase of 8.3%.

Conversely, Cantabria (0.9%), La Rioja and Illes Balears (both with 3.6%) presented the least growth in turnover.

The interannual employment rate increases 1.9%

Employment in the Services Sector experienced an interannual growth of 1.9% in January.

Information Technologies and Services Rendered to Companies were the sectors that registered the largest increases in employed personnel, both with a rate of 2.9%. Within the Information Technologies sector, it is worth noting the growth of employment in IT Services (5.0%). The most dynamic activities in the creation of jobs within Services Rendered to Companies were Investigation and Security Services (7.1%) and Industrial Cleaning (3.6%).

In the other sectors, employed personnel reached rates of 2.4% in Transport, 1.4% in Tourism and 1.3% in Trade.

Principado de Asturias, Aragón and País Vasco register the highest increases in employed personnel

Principado de Asturias, Aragón and País Vasco were the Autonomous Communities that registered the highest increases in employed personnel in the Services Sector during the month of January, with rates of 3.8%, 3.0% and 2.8%, respectively.

In contrast, the lowest growth rates in employment were observed in Comunitat Valenciana and Cantabria, with increases of 0.4% and 0.5%, respectively.
