Services Sector Activity Indicators. Base 2005 March 2008. Provisional data


The Services Sector turnover decreases 5.0% in March as compared with the same month of 2007

The interannual rate of employed persons increases 1.0%

The market Services Sector turnover decreased 5.0% in March as compared with the same month of 2007.

All sectors, with the exception of Tourism, experienced a decrease in turnover. Trade registered the greatest decrease, with an interannual rate of –6.6%. It was followed by the Transport (–4.7%), Services to companies (–1.9%) and Information technologies (–0.5%) sectors. **Tourism recorded a 3.6% increase** as compared with the same month last year, evolution in keeping with the fact that Easter Week was held in the month of March this year, whilst last year it was held in April.

During the first quarter of the year, market Services Sector turnover increased 2.6%.



Principado de Asturias is the only Autonomous Community recording a positive evolution in turnover for the month of March

Principado de Asturias was the only Autonomous Community recording a positive interannual rate of turnover in the month of March (1.1%).

On the other hand, Comunidad Foral de Navarra (-10.1%), Comunitat Valenciana (-8.1) and Cataluña (-7.7%) registered the greatest decreases.

The interannual employment rate increases 1.0%

Employment in the Services Sector experienced an interannual growth of 1.0% in March.

Information Technologies was the sector that registered the largest increases in employed personnel, with a rate of 2.6%, and with growth in employment in Information technology services being of particular note.

In the other sectors, employed personnel reached growth rates of 1.2% in Transport, 1.0% in Trade, 0.8% in Tourism and 0.5% in Company services. On analysis of the latter sector, performance of Research and development services is of note, on the one hand. Staff employed in that sector registered a growth rate of 5.9%. On the other hand, the Labour recruitment and provision of personnel services sector experienced a decrease in employment of 9.1%.

Principado de Asturias registers the greatest increases in employed personnel

Principado de Asturias was the Autonomous Communities that registered the greatest increases in employed personnel in the Services Sector during the month of March, with a rate of 2.8%. It was followed by Aragón and Galicia, both with a rate of 2.1%.

Canarias recorded the lowest increase (0.2%), while Comunitat Valenciana registered a 1.0% decrease.
