Services Sector Activity Indicators. Base 2005
March 2010. *Provisional data*

Main results

- The interannual rate of the **Services Sector Turnover General Index** is **5.6% in March**, more than six points above that registered in February. This is the first positive annual rate since April 2008.
- The **average variation rate** of the Services Sector Turnover General Index **increases 0.3%** in the first quarter of the year 2010.
- **Employed personnel decreases 2.0%**, as compared with March the previous year.
- Turnover in the services sector registers **positive interannual rates in all of the Autonomous Communities**, except in Canarias.

Evolution of turnover in the Services sector

Turnover in the market Services sector registered an increase of 5.6% in March 2010, as compared with the previous year, more than six points above that registered in February.

By sector, the interannual variation of *Trade* was 8.9%, whereas *Other Services* presented a rate of -0.9%.

Within *Trade*, all of the sectors presented increase interannual rates. *Sale and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles* presented the most pronounced rate (26.0%), followed by *Wholesale trade and intermediaries* (7.8%) and *Retail trade* (5.7%).

Within *Other Services*, *Transport and storage* and *Administrative and support service activities* were the only sectors with positive interannual rates (4.1% and 0.9%, respectively). The rest presented negative rates. *Information and communications* registered the most pronounced decrease (-4.6%). It was followed by *Professional, scientific and technical activities* (-3.8%) and *Accommodation* (-1.4%).

Turnover by activity


Most of the activities in the Services sector experienced an increase in turnover in March, in the interannual rate.

- **Trade.** The greatest increases were registered in *Sale of motor vehicles, motorcycles and spare parts* (29.8%), *Wholesale trade of food, beverages and tobacco* (13.0%) and *Other wholesale trade of items for household use not mentioned previously* (11.6%). Among the activities that presented decreases, the most pronounced drop was registered by *Non-specialised trade* (-10.4%).
- **Other Services.** The activities that presented the greatest increases were *Travel agency and tour operators* (12.4%) and *Employment-related activities* (12.3%). Conversely, those registering the greatest drops were *Technical architecture and engineering services; technical trials and analysis* (-15.3%) and *Office management activities* (-12.1%).

Year-to-date average rates

The average rate of the Services Sector Turnover General Index stood at 0.3% in the first quarter of the year. *Trade* registered an average rate of 2.1% in this period, whereas *Other services* presented a variation of -3.4%.


**Annual rate and average turnover rate

Variation rates adjusted for the calendar effect

After eliminating the calendar effect, that is, the difference in the number of working days in a given month in different years, the interannual variation of the general index of Services sector turnover registered a **4.5%** increase in March, more five points higher than that registered the previous month.

Evolution of employed personnel

Employment in the Services sector experienced an interannual decrease of 2.0% in the month of March. This indicated an increase of six tenths as compared with the rate registered in February.

All of the sectors experienced interannual decreases, except *Administrative and support service activities*, which presented an interannual increase of 0.6%. The greatest decrease was in *Information and communications* (-3.2%).

In the first quarter of the year, the average rate of the General Index of employed personnel stood at -2.7%.



Autonomous Communities. Turnover variation rates

In March 2010, all the Autonomous Communities registered positive interannual variation rates: apart from Canarias, which experienced a decrease of 0.1%.

La Rioja (10.3%) and Principado de Asturias (9.7%) presented the greatest increases.

■ Annual



Autonomous Communities. Employed personnel variation rates

Employment in the services sector decreased in all of the Autonomous Communities, except in Castilla y León (0.5%), Principado de Asturias and La Rioja (both with 0.1%).

Castilla-La Mancha (-3.0%), Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana (both with -2.9%) were the Communities with the greatest decreases.
