Services Sector Activity Indicators. Base 2005 June 2008. Provisional data


The Services Sector turnover decreases 4.8% in June as compared with the same month in 2007

The interannual rate of employed personnel decreases 0.1%

In June, the market Services Sector turnover recorded an interannual decrease of 4.8% as compared with the same month in 2007.

All sectors, except Information Technologies, decreased their turnover. Trade registered the greatest decrease, with an interannual rate of -6.2%. It was followed by the Transport (-3.9%), Tourism (-2.0%) and Services rendered to companies sectors (-0.9%). Information Technologies recorded a 0.2% increase as compared with the same month the previous year.

During the first half of the year, Market Services turnover recorded a 1.2% increase.



Services Sector turnover decreases in all Autonomous Communities

In June, Market Services Sector turnover decreased in all Autonomous Communities, as compared with the same month the previous year. The Communities registering the lowest decreases were Aragón (-0.2%), Principado de Asturias (-1.7%) and País Vasco (-1.9%). Conversely, Comunitat Valenciana (-8.4%) and Cantabria (-8.2%) registered the greatest decreases.

The interannual employment rate decreases 0.1%

Press Release

Employment in the Services Sector showed an interannual decrease of 0.1% in June.

The Tourism and Services rendered to companies sectors recorded decreases in employment, with interannual rates of -0.7% and -0.6%, respectively. Nevertheless, in the Information Technology, Transport and Trade sectors, employed personnel increased with rates of 2.5%, 0.5% and 0.1%, respectively.

Within Services rendered to companies, the performance of employed staff by activity was very diverse, ranging from interannual rates of -13.8% in Labour recruitment and provision of personnel to 5.0% in Investigation and security services.

Aragón is the Autonomous Community with the greatest increase in employed personnel

Aragón was the Autonomous Community with the greatest increase in employed personnel in the Services sector in the month of June, with a rate of 1.8%. It was followed by Principado de Asturias with rate of 1.2%.

The greatest decreases in employed personnel were recorded in Comunitat Valenciana (-2.0%) and La Rioja (-1.9%).
