Services Sector Activity Indicators (SSAI). Base 2005
October 2011. *Provisional data*

Main results

- The **interannual rate of turnover** for the Market **Services sector** stands at **-2.7%** in **October**, almost two points below that registered in September.
- The **average variation** of Services sector turnover stands at **-0.8%** in the first ten months of the year.
- **Employed personnel decreases 1.1%**, as compared with October the previous year.
- **Canarias** was the only Autonomous Community **that registered a positive evolution of turnover**.

Evolution of turnover in the Services sector

The interannual rate of turnover in the Market Services sector registered an interannual variation of **-2.7%** in October, almost two points below that registered in September.

Trade registered an annual rate of **-4.1%** and an effect of **-2.735**. In turn, the annual variation of Other Services was **0.0%**, with an effect of **0.017** in the general index.

The sectors presenting a negative contribution to the general index were :

- **Wholesale trade and intermediaries**, with an annual variation of **-5.2%** and an effect of **-1.972** on the general index, due to the decreases of the turnover in most of the activities comprising this sector, worth noting among them the increase registered in *Wholesale of food, beverages and tobacco*.
- **Retail trade**, with an annual variation of **-3.1%** and an effect of **-0.706**.
- **Administrative and support service activities**, with an annual variation of **-1.3%** and an effect of **-0.060** on the general index due to the decrease in *Travel agencies and tour operator services*. Turnover increased in the four remaining activities.
- **Sale and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles**, with an annual rate of **-1.0%** and an effect of **-0.057**, as a result of the negative evolution of the two activities comprising this sector.
- **Information and communications**, with an annual variation of **-0.2%** and an effect of **-0.019** on the general index. Turnover increased in the most activities comprising this sector, highlighting the rise of the *Computer programming, consultancy and related activities*.

Nevertheless, the greatest influence on the sector was the decreased registered in *Telecommunications and Publishing activities*.

In turn, the sectors presenting a positive contribution to the general index were:

- **Professional, scientific and technical activities**, with an annual variation of **0.9%** and an effect of **0.061** on the general index, mainly caused by the positive evolution observed in *Legal, accounting and management consulting activities*
- **Accommodation**, with an annual variation of **0.4%** and an effect of **0.020** on the general index, the positive evolution of *Accommodation services* tempered by the decrease in *food and beverage services activities*.
- **Transport and storage**, with an annual rate of **0.2%** and an effect of **0.015** on the general index, due to the increases observed in half of activities comprising this sector. Worth noting among them was that registered for *Storage and activities connected to transport*. Nevertheless, worth noting the decrease in *Freight transport by road and removal services*.

Turnover by activity

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that had the greatest contribution to the annual rate of the Services Sector Turnover General Index for the month of October:



Year-to-date average rates

The average of the Services Sector Turnover General Index registered a variation of -0.8% in the first ten months of 2011, as compared with the same period the previous year. This rate was -1.9% in Trade, and 1.1% in Other Services.

By sector, average turnover experienced a negative variation rate in *Sale and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles*, *Retail trade*, *Information and communications* and *Wholesale trade and intermediaries*.


**Annual and average turnover rates

Variation rates adjusted for the calendar effect

After eliminating the calendar effect, that is, the difference between the number of working days in a given month in different years, the interannual variation of the Services Sector Turnover General Index stood at **-2.7%** in October, more than one-and-a-half point below the rate registered the previous month.

Evolution of employed personnel

Employment in the Services sector registered an interannual variation of **-1.1%** in October, six tenths below that registered in September.


Trade registered a variation of **-0.9%** and an effect of **-0.395**. Other Services registered a rate of **-1.3%** and an effect of **-0.723**.

All sectors presented a negative effect on the general index. Those with the greatest influence were:

- **Professional, scientific and technical activities**, with an annual variation of **-2.1%** and an effect of **-0.243**, motivated by the decreases in all activities in this sector, highlighting *Architectural and engineering activities; technical testing and analyses*.
- **Administrative and support service activities**, with an annual rate of **-1.7%** and an effect of **-0.241**, caused by the negative evolution recorded for all activities comprising this sector. Worth noting among them *Cleaning activities*.
- **Transport and storage**, with an annual variation of **-1.6%** and an effect of **-0.191**, as a result of the decrease in employment in half of the activities comprising the sector, among which highlight *Freight transport by road and removal services*.
- **Sale and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles**, with an annual rate of **-4.4%** and an effect of **-0.182** in the general index.

During the first ten months of the year, the average rate of the General Index of employed personnel stood at **-0.4%**. This rate was **-0.7%** for Trade and **-0.3%** for Other Services.

Annual and average rates of employed personnel General index and by sector




Autonomous Communities. Turnover variation rates

Canarias was the only Autonomous Community that registered a positive evolution of turnover in the Service sector in October, with an interannual rate of 2.9%.

The smaller decreases were in Illes Balears (-0.1%) and La Rioja (-1.0%). The greatest annual decreases were registered in Extremadura (-9.7%), Región de Murcia (-8.0%) and Principado de Asturias (-5.8%).

General index by Autonomous Community




Autonomous Communities. Variation rates of employed personnel

Illes Balears was the only Autonomous Community that registered a positive evolution of turnover in the Service sector in October, with an interannual rate of 1.5%.

The smaller decreases were in La Rioja (-0.1%) and Canarias (-0.2%). In turn, the greatest decreases were registered in Castilla-La Mancha (-2.9%) and Aragón (-1.8%).
