
Harmonised Labour Cost Index (HLCI). Base 2020 Second quarter 2023. Provisional data

The quarterly variation in the cost per hour worked, after eliminating calendar and seasonal effects, is 1.5%

The cost per hour worked increased by 5.6% in the annual rate in the series adjusted for calendar and seasonal effects, and 6.5% in the original series

Quarterly variation of the Index

The quarterly variation of the HLCI –which measures the labour cost per hour worked while keeping constant the structure by branch of activity– stood at 1.5% between the second and first quarter of 2023, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects.



Labour Cost Index adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects

By cost components, in seasonally and calendar adjusted data, wage costs showed a variation of 1.2%, and other costs of 2.5%.

Excluding seasonal and calendar adjustment, the quarterly rate was 9.0%, mainly due to the higher weight of extraordinary payments in the second quarter of 2023 compared to the first one.



Annual variation of the Index

The cost per hour worked increased by 6.5% in the second quarter of 2023 compared to the same period of the previous year.

The annual variation of the cost per hour was 5.6%, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects.

By cost component, wage costs showed an annual variation of 4.8% in corrected data, while other costs increased by 7.9%.

Results by activity sections

The sections registering the highest annual increments in the second quarter are the Mining and quarrying industries (11.3%), Professional, scientific and technical activities (8.6%) and Transport and storage (8.1%).

On the other hand, the cost descends in Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (-4.9%), and it registers the lowest increases in Real state activities (1.3%) and Water supply, waste management and remediation activities (1.5%).



After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the activities that presented the highest annual rates were Mining and quarrying industries (11.7%), Professional, scientific and technical activities (8.2%) and Transport and storage (7.1%).

On the other hand, the labour cost presents negative rates in Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (-5.2%), and it registers the lowest increases in Water supply, waste management and remediation activities (0.8%) and Real state activities (1.1%).

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the ICLA provisional data of the first quarter of 2023 have been updated. The final index stands at 98.8 points.

The quarterly variation of the original series for that quarter stood at -9.6%, and that of the adjusted index was at 1.7%. In turn, the annual rate of the original series is 4.4% and that of the index corrected for calendar and seasonal effects is 4.3%. The results are available at INEBase.

Methodological note

The Harmonised Labour Cost Index (HLCI) is a quarterly continuous statistical operation whose objective is to provide a common and comparable measure of labour cost per hour worked for the whole of the European Union, allowing the monitoring of the evolution of said labour costs.

Indices with base 2020 are provided for total labour costs, wages and salaries and other costs net of subsidies received for the use of labour factor (includes social contributions payable by employers and non-wage payments). The index for total labour cost is also provided excluding extraordinary payments and delayed payments.

Type of operation: Statistics presented mainly in the form of indices.

Base year: 2020.

Population scope: Employees in local units.

Sources of information: The Quarterly Labour Cost Survey which is conducted on the basis of the Social Security contribution accounts. General Scheme: Sections B to S of CNAE-09 and Special Scheme for Seafarers: Sea Transport (Division 50 of CNAE-09). In order to cover all employees of the general government, information from the DARETRI file is used.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Reference period of the results: the calendar quarter.

Calculation method: Chained Laspeyres.
