
Harmonised Labour Cost Index (HLCI). Base 2016 Third quarter 2021. Provisional data

The quarterly variation of the cost per hour worked is -0.1%, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects

The cost per hour worked increases 0.9% in the annual rate in the series adjusted for calendar and seasonal effects, and 0.2% in the original series

Quarterly variation of the Index

The quarterly variation of the HLCI—which measures the labour cost per hour worked maintaining the structure by branches of activity—between the third and the second quarter of 2021, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, was -0.1%.

By cost component, in seasonally and calendar adjusted data, wage costs showed a positive variation of 0.3%, while other costs fell 1.2%.

After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the quarterly rate was 2.5%, mainly due to the lower number of hours worked during the holiday period in the third quarter as compared to the second.



Annual variation of the Index

The cost per hour worked increased by 0.2% in the third quarter of 2021, as compared with the same period of the previous year.

The annual variation of the cost per hour was 0.9%, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects.

By cost component, wage costs recorded an annual variation of 0.8% in adjusted data and other costs increased by 1.1%.

Results by activity sections

The sections registering the highest annual increases in the third quarter of 2021 were *Information and communications* (3.8%), *Construction* (3.1%) and *Financial and insurance activities* (2.2%).

On the other hand, the greatest decreases were in *Real estate activities* (-8.7%), *Other services* (-6.5%) and *Education* (-4.0%).

After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the activities that presented the highest annual rates were Information and communications (4.7%), Construction (3.7%) and Financial and insurance activities (2.8%).


In turn, Real estate activities (–8.1%), Extractive industries (–6.2) and Other services (–5.5%) registered the lowest corrected annual rates.

Results by activity sections and cost components. Original series

The sections that registered the largest annual increases for *salary cost* in the third quarter were *Information and communications* (3.9%), *Financial and insurance activities* (3.0%) and *Hotel, restaurants and catering* (2.5%).

On the other hand, the greatest declines were in *Real estate activities* (-6.8%), *Other services* (-4.8%) and *Education* (-4.2%).

As for other costs, the sections that registered the highest annual increases were Construction (4.9%), Information and communications (3.2%) and Wholesale and retail trade; motor vehicle and motorcycle repair (2.6%).

On the other hand, the lowest rates were found in *Mining and quarrying* (-15.3%), *Real Estate Activities* (-13.9%) and *Other service activities* (-10.8%).

COVID-19's Influence on HLCI Results

The evolution of the various activity sections reflected the degree of impact resulting from the pandemic and from the measures put in place to contain it. During the third quarter of 2021 there has generally been a lower incidence of ERTE in all economic activities. This gave rise to an increase in salary costs in the majority of activities and, to a lesser extent, other costs, as a consequence of the exemptions in social contributions. On the other hand, in those activities where the hours actually worked increased more than the costs, the cost per hour worked decreased.

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, HLCI provisional data for the second quarter of 2021 have been updated. The final index stands at 108.5 points.

The quarterly variation of the original series for that quarter stood at 6.3%, while that of the adjusted index was -0.2%. On the other hand, the annual rate of the original series was -3.7% and that for the index adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, -3.7%. The results are available at INEBase.

Methodological note

The Harmonised Labour Cost Index (HLCI) is a quarterly continuous statistical operation whose objective is to provide a common and comparable measure of labour cost per hour worked for the whole of the European Union, allowing the monitoring of the evolution of said labour costs.

Indices with base 2016 are provided for total labour costs, wages and salaries and other costs net of subsidies received for the use of labour factor (includes social contributions payable by employers and non-wage payments). The index for total labour cost is also provided excluding extraordinary payments and delayed payments.

Type of operation: Statistics presented mainly in the form of indices.

Base year: 2016.

Population scope: Employees in local units.

Sources of information: The Quarterly Labour Cost Survey which is conducted on the basis of the Social Security contribution accounts. General Scheme: Sections B to S of CNAE-09 and Special Scheme for Seafarers: Sea Transport (Division 50 of CNAE-09). In order to cover all employees of the general government, information from the DARETRI file is used.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Reference period of the results: the calendar quarter.

Calculation method: Chained Laspeyres.
