Industrial Turnover Indices (ITI).. Base 2010 August 2017. Provisional data


The monthly variation of the General Industrial Turnover Index¹ stands at 2.2%, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate stands at 7.6% in the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, and at 7.7% in the original series

Monthly evolution of the Industry Turnover

The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Index between the months of August and July, eliminating seasonal and calendar effects, is 2.2%. This rate was 2.3 points higher than that registered in the previous month.


Turnover General Index Adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects. Monthly rate



By economic destination of the goods, all sectors had positive monthly rates. Worth noting were the increases in *Capital goods* (5.4%) and *Energy* (3.5%).

¹ As reflected in the methodology of this value index, the information is presented in current terms (nominal terms), this is, without adjusting the effects in the price variation thereof.



Annual evolution of the Industrial Turnover Indices

The General Industrial Turnover Index (ITI), after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, registered a variation of 7.6% in August, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 1.6 points higher than that registered in July.

The original series of the ITI registered an annual variation of 7.7%. This rate was 1.7 points higher than that registered in July.

General Industrial Turnover Index Annual rates



By economic destination of the goods, the indices adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects recorded positive annual rates in all the sectors analysed. The greatest increase was registered in *Energy* (15.9%).



By geographical destination of the sales, in August, all the markets recorded positive annual rates. Worth noting was the 8.2% increase in the domestic market.


Industrial turnover indices: General and by market Annual rate



Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates of the Industrial turnover. Original series

Turnover increased in 16 Autonomous Communities, as compared to August 2016, and only one decreased. The highest increase occurred in Principado de Asturias (20.9%) and the only decrease was in Comunidad Foral de Navarra (-19.9%).
