### Industrial Turnover Indices (ITI). Base 2015 September 2019. Provisional data


The monthly variation of the Total Industrial Turnover Index¹ stands at −1.4%, after seasonal and calendar adjustment

The annual rate stands at −1.6% in the seasonal and calendar adjusted series and at 1.1% in the original series

#### Monthly trend of the Industrial Turnover

The monthly variation of the seasonally and calendar adjusted Total Industrial Turnover Index between the months of September and August, stood at -1.4%. This rate was 1.7 points lower than the previous month.


### Industrial Turnover Index, Total. Seasonally and calendar adjusted Monthly rate. Percentage

By Main Industrial Groupings (MIGs), *Energy*<sup>2</sup> (7.7%) and *Non-durable consumer goods* (0.1%) showed positive monthly rates. On the other hand *Capital goods* (-7.8%), *Durable consumer goods* (-1.7%) and *Intermediate goods* (-1.1%) showed negative monthly rates.

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

#### **Annual trend of the Industrial Turnover Indices**

The Total Industrial Turnover Index, once adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, showed a variation of -1.6% in September, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was eight tenths lower than the one registered in August.

The ITI original series registered an annual variation of 1.1%. This rate was 4.8 points higher than the one in August.

By MIGs, the seasonally and calendar adjusted indices registered negative annual rates in four of five of the analysed sectors, highlighting the decrease in *Energy*<sup>2</sup> (-15.0%).



### Annual trend of the Industrial Turnover Indices by market. Original series

In September positive annual rates were observed in two of the analysed markets. It is worth noting the increase registered in the euro area in the non-domestic market (2.9%).


## Industrial Turnover Index, Total and by market September 2019. Annual rate. Percentage



# Results by Autonomous Community. Annual rates of the Industrial Turnover. Original series

Turnover increased as compared to September 2018 in 11 Autonomous Communities and decreased in the other six. The largest increases were recorded in Comunidad Foral de Navarra (17.1%), Comunidad de Madrid (9.2%) and Galicia (6.3%). The largest decreases were recorded in Andalucía (-9.1%), Comunitat Valenciana (-6.2%) and Cantabria (-4.4%).

#### Revisions and data update

On the press release day, INE has updated ITI data series corresponding to the last 13 months. In the case of calendar adjusted and seasonally and calendar adjusted series, according to INE standard, series are revised since its beginning. Results are available at INEBase.

### Methodological note

Industrial Turnover Indices (ITI) are short-term indicators aiming at measuring the monthly evolution of the industrial sector, excluding the construction.

The required information is collected since January 2002, together with the Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI) through a survey addressed to more than 12.000 industrial establishments throughout the country.

Survey Type: ongoing monthly.

Base year: 2015.

**Population scope:** units of economic activity whose main activity is included in Sections B: Extractive industries (with the exception, due to their not being relevant to Spanish industry, of division 09) or C: Manufacturing industry of CNAE-2009.

**Geographical scope:** the whole country, excluding Ceuta and Melilla.

**Sample size:** Approx. 12,000 establishments.

Data collection: monthly, value of total business turnover broken down by market.

**Collection method:** fill in a questionnaire by the respondent using one of the following methods: internet (IRIA system), email, fax, telephone or post.
