Industrial Turnover Indices (ITI). Base 2015 December 2018 and year 2018. Provisional data

The monthly variation of the Total Industrial Turnover Index¹ stands at −2.5%, after seasonal and calendar adjustment

The annual rate stands at −5.0% in the seasonal and calendar adjusted series and at −2.4% in the original series

Throughout the year 2018, the business turnover increases by 3.9% in the adjusted series and 4.5% in the original series

Monthly trend of the Industrial Turnover

The monthly variation of the seasonally and calendar adjusted Total Industrial Turnover Index between the months of December and November, stood at -2.5%. This rate was five tenths lower than the previous month.

Industrial Turnover Index, Total. Seasonally and calendar adjusted Monthly rate. Percentage



By Main Industrial Groupings (MIGs), all sectors showed negative monthly rates. It is worth highlighting the decrease in *Energy*² (-6.1%) followed by *Durable consumer goods* (-6.0%).

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

Annual trend of the Industrial Turnover Indices

The Total Industrial Turnover Index, once adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, showed a variation of -5.0% in December, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 5.5 points lower than the one registered in November.

The ITI original series registered an annual variation of -2.4%. This rate was almost three points lower than the one in November.

By MIGs, the seasonally and calendar adjusted indices registered negative annual rates in four of five of the analysed sectors, highlighting the decrease in *Durable consumer goods* (-10.4%).

Throughout the year 2018, the industrial Turnover Index, once adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, increased by 3.9% as compared with 2017, and by 4.5% in the original series.

In the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects were observed positive annual rates in three of five of the analysed sectors, highlighting the increase in *Energy*² (23.2%).

Annual trend of the Industrial Turnover Indices by market. Original series

In December all markets showed negative annual rates. It is worth noting the decrease registered in the euro area in the non-domestic market (-3.9%)

Throughout the year 2018, all markets presented positive variations as compared with 2017. The largest increase of 5.1% was registered in the domestic market.



Results by Autonomous Community. Annual rates of the Industrial Turnover. Original series

Turnover increased as compared to December 2017 in seven Autonomous Communities and decreased in the other 10. The largest decreases were recorded in País Vasco (-11.7%), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (-8.0%) and La Rioja (-6.5%). The largest increases were recorded in Extremadura (9.8%), Illes Balears (7.7%) and Aragón (6.8%).

Industrial Turnover Index, Total and by Autonomous Community December 2018. Annual rate and annual average. Percentage



Throughout the year 2018, the turnover increased in 13 Autonomous Communities and decreased in the other four. The largest increases were recorded in Comunidad Foral de Navarra (10.8%), Región de Murcia (8.3%) and Galicia (7.1%). The largest decreases were recorded in Illes Balears (-2.5%), Canarias (-1.6%) and La Rioja (-0.7%).

Revisions and data update

On the press release day, INE has updated ITI data series corresponding to the last 13 months. In the case of calendar adjusted and seasonally and calendar adjusted series, according to INE standard, series are revised since its beginning. Results are available at INEBase.

Methodological note

Industrial Turnover Indices (ITI) are short-term indicators aiming at measuring the monthly evolution of the industrial sector, excluding the construction.

The required information is collected since January 2002, together with the Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI) through a survey addressed to more than 12.000 industrial establishments throughout the country.

Survey Type: ongoing monthly.

Base year: 2015.

Population scope: units of economic activity whose main activity is included in Sections B: Extractive industries (with the exception, due to their not being relevant to Spanish industry, of division 09) or C: Manufacturing industry of CNAE-2009.

Geographical scope: the whole country, excluding Ceuta and Melilla.

Sample size: Approx. 12,000 establishments.

Data collection: monthly, value of total business turnover broken down by market.

Collection method: fill in a questionnaire by the respondent using one of the following methods: internet (IRIA system), email, fax, telephone or post.
