### Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI). Base 2015 January 2019. Provisional data

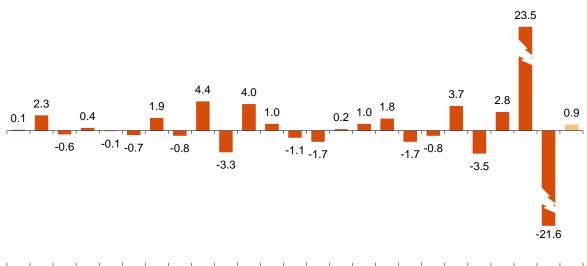
### The monthly variation of the Total Industrial New Orders Receives Index<sup>1</sup> stands at 0.9%, after seasonal and calendar adjustment

# The annual rate stands at −0.7% in the seasonal and calendar adjusted series and at −1.9% in the original series

### Monthly trend of Industrial New Orders Received

The monthly variation of the seasonally and calendar adjusted Industrial New Orders Received Index between January and December stood at 0.9%. This rate was 22.5 points higher than the previous month.

### Industrial New Orders Received Index, Total. Seasonally and calendar adjusted Monthly rate. Percentage



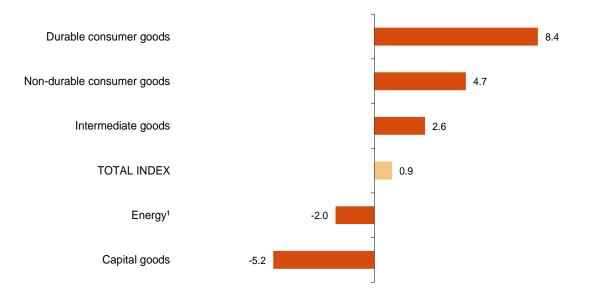

By Main Industrial Groupings (MIGs), three of the five sectors showed positive monthly rates. It is worth highlighting the increase in *Durable consumer goods* (8.4%). *Capital goods* (-5.2%) showed the greatest fall.

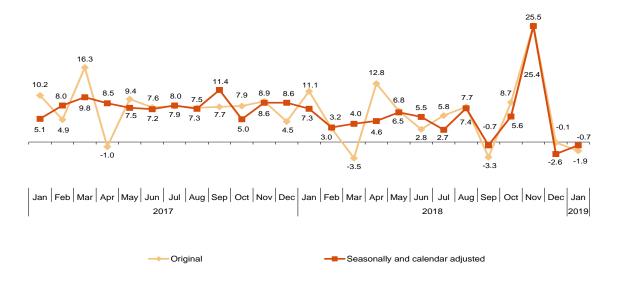

### Annual trend of Industrial New Orders Received

The Total Industrial New Orders Received Index, once adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, showed a variation of -0.7% in January, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was almost two points higher than the one registered in December.

The INORI original series of the registered an annual variation of -1.9%. This rate was 1.8 points lower than the one in December.

By MIGs, the seasonally and calendar adjusted indices registered positive annual rates in three of five of the analysed sectors, highlighting the decrease in *Capital goods* (-8.5%).

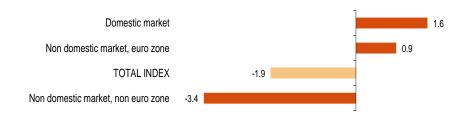

### Annual trend of the Industrial New Orders Received by market. Original series

In January positive annual rates were observed in two of the analysed markets. It is worth noting the decrease registered in the non euro area in the non domestic market (-3.4%).

Industrial New Orders Received Index, Total and by market

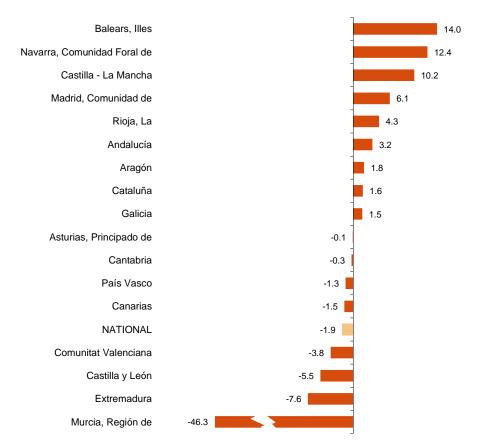
January 2019. Annual rate. Percentage



# Results by Autonomous Community. Annual rate of the Industrial New Orders Received. Original series

New orders received increased as compared to January 2018 in nine Autonomous Communities and decreased in the other eight. The largest decreases were recorded in Región de Murcia (-46.3%), Extremadura (-7.6%) and Castilla y León (-5.5%). The largest increases were recorded in Illes Balears (14.0%), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (12.4%) and Castilla - La Mancha (10.2%).

### **Revisions and data update**

Press Release

On the press release day, INE has updated INORI data series corresponding to the last 13 months. In the case of calendar adjusted and seasonally and calendar adjusted series, according to INE standard, series are revised since its beginning. Results are available at INEBase.

### Methodological note

Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI) are short-term indicators aiming at measuring the monthly evolution of the industrial sector, excluding the construction.

The required information is collected since January 2002, together with the Industrial Turnover Indices (ITI) through a survey addressed to more than 12.000 industrial establishments throughout the country.

Survey Type: ongoing monthly.

Base year: 2015.

**Population scope:** units of economic activity whose main activity is included in Sections B: Extractive industries (with the exception, due to their not being relevant to Spanish industry, of division 09) or C: Manufacturing industry of CNAE-2009.

**Geographical scope:** the whole country, excluding Ceuta and Melilla.

Sample size: Approx. 12,000 establishments.

Data collection: monthly, value of total business turnover broken down by market.

**Collection method:** fill in a questionnaire by the respondent using one of the following methods: internet (IRIA system), email, fax, telephone or post.
