
Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI). Base 2015 July 2018. Provisional data

The monthly variation of the Total Industrial New Orders Receives Index¹¹ stands at –0.8%, after seasonal and calendar adjustment

The annual rate stands at 2.7% in the seasonal and calendar adjusted series and at 5.6% in the original series

Monthly trend of Industrial New Orders Received

The monthly variation of the seasonally and calendar adjusted Industrial New Orders Received Index between July and June stood at -0.8%. This rate was almost a point higher than the previous month.




Industrial New Orders Received Index, Total Seasonally and calendar adjusted. July 2018. Monthly rate

¹ As reflected in the methodology of this value index, the information is presented in current terms (nominal terms), this is, without adjusting the price variation effects.



By Main Industrial Groupings (MIGs), four of the five sectors showed negative monthly rates. It is worth highlighting the decrease in *Durable consumer goods* (–2.9). The only sector that increased was *Capital goods* (0.7%).



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Annual trend of Industrial New Orders Received

The Total Industrial New Orders Received Index, once adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, showed a variation of 2.7% in July, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 2.6 points lower than the one registered in June.

The INORI original series of the registered an annual variation of 5.6%. This rate was three points higher than the one in June.



Industrial New Orders Received General Index, Total July 2018. Annual rates

By MIGs, the seasonally and calendar adjusted indices registered positive annual rates in four of five of the analysed sectors, highlighting the increase in $Energy^2$ (33.6%).

Annual trend of the Industrial New Orders Received by market. Original series


In July positive annual rates were observed in dos of the analysed markets. It is worth noting the increase registered in the domestic market (9.8%) and the only decrease in the euro area in the non-domestic market (-4.0%).

Results by Autonomous Community. Annual rate of the Industrial New Orders Received. Original series

New orders received increased as compared to July 2017 in 13 Autonomous Communities and decreased in the other four. The largest increases were recorded in Principado de Asturias (18.2%), Región de Murcia (14.1%) and Galicia (14.1%), The largest decreases were recorded in Comunidad de Madrid (-4.5%), Andalucía (-2.6%) and Illes Balears (-2.1%).
