Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI). Base 2010 August 2013. Provisional data

The annual rate of the General Industrial New Orders Received Index stands at –3.1% in the series adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects and at –5.4% in the original series

The monthly variation stands at 3.2%, adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects

The Industrial New Orders Received Index (INORI) registered an annual variation of -5.4% in August, almost seven points below that registered in July.

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the annual rate stood at -3.1%, almost four points and a half below that registered in July.

Annual evolution of the New Orders Received by economic destination of the goods

Capital goods is the only sector that registered a positive annual rate (18.4%) in August. In turn, among the other sectors it is worth noting the decrease in the new orders received in Energy (-19.4%).

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, Capital goods (20.5%) was again the only sector with a positive evolution, as compared with August of the previous year. Among the other sectors, the greatest decrease was registered in Energy (–18.8%).

Annual evolution of New Orders Received by destination market

Indices obtained according to the market of which the order was received decreased in Domestic market and increased in Foreign markets, as compared with the same month of the previous year.

The greatest increase was registered in New Orders Received from the euro zone (with an annual rate of 5.7%) and the non-euro zone (4.7%)

In turn, Domestic market registered a decrease of 13.0% in the New Orders Received, as compared with August 2012.

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Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rate of the New Orders Received.

All the Autonomous Communities registered decreases in their New Orders Received, as compared with August 2012, except Comunitat Valenciana (37.2%).

Illes Balears (-29.6%) and Extremadura (-26.7%) registered the greatest decreases.

Monthly evolution of the INORI adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects

The General Industrial New Orders Received Index variation between August and July, after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, was 3.2%. This rate was three points higher than that of July.

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Monthly evolution by destination of the goods adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, three out of the five industrial sectors registered positive monthly rates. Among them, it is worth noting the increase registered in Capital goods (15.0%).
