# Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI). Base 2015 December 2018 and year 2018. Provisional data

The monthly variation of the Total Industrial New Orders Receives Index¹ stands at −13.8%, after seasonal and calendar adjustment


The annual rate stands at −1.7% in the seasonal and calendar adjusted series and at 0.0% in the original series

Throughout the year 2018, the new orders received increases by 5.7% in the adjusted series and 6.4% in the original series

#### **Monthly trend of Industrial New Orders Received**

The monthly variation of the seasonally and calendar adjusted Industrial New Orders Received Index between December and November stood at -13.8%. This rate was 26.6 points lower than the previous month.

Industrial New Orders Received Index, Total. Seasonally and calendar adjusted Monthly rate. Percentage



By Main Industrial Groupings (MIGs), all sectors showed negative monthly rates. It is worth highlighting the decrease in *Capital goods* (-35.4%).



#### **Annual trend of Industrial New Orders Received**

The Total Industrial New Orders Received Index, once adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, showed a variation of -1.7% in December, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 23.8 points lower than the one registered in November.

The INORI original series showed no variation as compared with December 2017. This rate was 25.3 points lower than the one in November.

By MIGs, the seasonally and calendar adjusted indices registered negative annual rates in three of five of the analysed sectors. *Durable consumer goods* showed the highest decrease (-10.9%) and *Capital Goods* the highest increase (5.1%).

**Throughout the year 2018**, the New Orders Received Index, once adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, increased by 5.7% as compared with 2017, and by 6.4% in the original series.

In the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects were observed positive annual rates in four of five of the analysed sectors, highlighting the increase in *Energy*<sup>2</sup> (23.0%).

#### Annual trend of the Industrial New Orders Received by market. Original series

By markets, the only one showing negative annual rates in December was the euro area in the non-domestic market (-3.2%). On the other hand, the domestic market showed the only increase (0.5%).

**Throughout the year 2018**, all markets presented positive variations as compared with 2017. The largest increase of 5.9% was registered in the domestic market.



# Results by Autonomous Community. Annual rate of the Industrial New Orders Received. Original series

New orders received increased as compared to December 2017 in eight Autonomous Communities and decreased in the other nine. The largest increases were recorded in Castilla - La Mancha (34.8%), País Vasco (22.6%) and Illes Balears (13.6%). The largest decreases were recorded in Región de Murcia (-17.4%), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (-14.0%) and Comunitat Valenciana (-13.1%).

**Throughout the year 2018**, the new orders received increased in 13 Autonomous Communities and decreased in the other four. The largest increases were recorded in Región de Murcia (68.3%), Castilla - La Mancha (9.3%) and Principado de Asturias (9.1%). The largest decreases were recorded in Illes Balears (-3.2%), Comunidad de Madrid (-1.6%) and Castilla y León (-1.0%).

#### Revisions and data update

On the press release day, INE has updated INORI data series corresponding to the last 13 months. In the case of calendar adjusted and seasonally and calendar adjusted series, according to INE standard, series are revised since its beginning. Results are available at INEBase.

### Methodological note

Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI) are short-term indicators aiming at measuring the monthly evolution of the industrial sector, excluding the construction.

The required information is collected since January 2002, together with the Industrial Turnover Indices (ITI) through a survey addressed to more than 12.000 industrial establishments throughout the country.

**Survey Type**: ongoing monthly.

Base year: 2015.

**Population scope:** units of economic activity whose main activity is included in Sections B: Extractive industries (with the exception, due to their not being relevant to Spanish industry, of division 09) or C: Manufacturing industry of CNAE-2009.

**Geographical scope:** the whole country, excluding Ceuta and Melilla.

Sample size: Approx. 12,000 establishments.

Data collection: monthly, value of total business turnover broken down by market.

**Collection method:** fill in a questionnaire by the respondent using one of the following methods: internet (IRIA system), email, fax, telephone or post.
