Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI). Base 2005
January 2012. *Provisional data*

Main results

- The annual rate of the **Industrial Turnover Index** stands at **1.6%** in the month of January, five-and-a-half points above the registered in December.
- By economic destination of the goods, Energy and Non-durable consumer goods present positive interannual rates.
- The annual variation rate of **New Orders Received** in the month of January is **0.5%**, four points higher than in December.

Evolution of Industrial Turnover

The Industrial Turnover Index (ITI) experienced an interannual variation of the 1.6% in January, five-and-a-half points above the registered in December.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that presented the greatest positive effects on the general index were:


- **Energy**, with an annual variation of 22.5% and an effect of 2.314, mainly due to the increase observed in the *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products*.
- **Non-durable consumer goods**, with an annual rate of 4.1% and an effect of 1.135, mainly caused by the increases observed in the *Food industries (except grain mill products and food for animals)*.

In turn, the industrial sectors that presented the greatest negative effect on the general index were:

- **Intermediate goods**, with an annual rate of -2.8% and an effect of -1.088 , due to the decreases registered in almost all activities comprising this sector. Among them, worth highlighting were *Metallurgy; manufacture of iron, steel and ferro-alloy products* and *Manufacture of other non-metallic products*.
- **Capital goods**, with an annual variation of -3.1% and an effect of -0.651 , mainly due to the decrease observed in the *Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers*.



Evolution of the ITI, adjusted for the calendar effect

After eliminating the calendar effect, that is, the difference between the number of working days in a given month in different years, the interannual variation of the ITI in the month of January was **-1.1%**, more than two points lower than that registered in December.

Evolution of Industrial New Orders Received

The Industrial New Orders Received Index (INORI) experienced an interannual variation of 0.5% in January, four points above that registered in December.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that presented the greatest positive effects on the general index were:


- **Energy**, with an annual variation of 22.0% and an effect of 2.132 on the general index, mainly due to the increase registered in the *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products*.

- **Non-durable consumer goods**, with an annual rate of 4.8% and an effect of 1.298, mainly caused by the increases observed in the *Food industries (except grain mill products and food for animals)* and in the *Graphic arts and reproduction of recorded media*.

In turn, **Capital goods** was the industrial sector that presented a negative effect on the general index, with an annual variation of -11.9% and an effect of -2.678 on the general index, motivated by the decrease observed in the *Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers*.



After eliminating the calendar effect, that is, the difference between the number of working days in a given month in different years, the interannual variation of the INORI in the month of January was -1.8%, more than two-and-a-half points lower than that registered in December.
