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## Industrial Turnover Indices. Base 2005 Industrial New Orders Received Indices. Base 2005

June 2010. Provisional data

### **Main Results**

- The annual rate of the **Industrial Turnover Index** stands at **9.0%** in the month of June, almost one point lower than registered in May.
- By economic destination of the goods, all the industrial sectors register positive interannual rates.
- The **average rate** of the Industrial Turnover Index registers an increase of **7.6%** in the first six months of the year.
- The annual variation rate of **New Orders Received** is **10.7%**, more one-and-a-half points lower than that observed in May.
- The **average rate** of the General Industrial New Orders Received Index stands at **8.4%** in the January to June period.

#### **Evolution of Industrial Turnover**

The Industrial Turnover Index (ITI) experienced an interannual variation of **9.0%** in June, almost one point lower than that registered in May.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that presented the greatest positive effects on the general index were:

- •Intermediate goods, with an annual variation of 12.3%, and an effect of 4.375 on the general index, caused by the increases observed in most of the activities in this sector. Worth noting among them were *Metallurgy; manufacture of iron, steel and ferro-alloy products* and the *Chemical industry, except cleaning articles, perfumes and cosmetics.* Nevertheless, also worth noting was the negative evolution of turnover of *Manufacture of other non-metallic ore products*.
- Energy, with an annual variation of 30.7% and an effect of 2.131, fundamentally due to the increase in *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products*.

• Capital goods, with an annual rate of 4.7%, and an effect of 1.196 on the general index, mainly caused by the increase in turnover of the *Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers*. However, also worth noting was the negative evolution of the *Manufacture of metal products for construction, containers made of metal, steam generators, weapons and ammunition*.

### **Details of interannual variations**

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the annual rate of the ITI in the month of June.



### Year-to-date average rates


The average rate of the Industrial Turnover Index reached a variation rate of **7.6%** in the January to June period, as compared with the same period the previous year.

By economic destination of the goods, this variation rate was positive in all the sectors: Energy (32.1%), Intermediate goods (9.4%), Capital goods (8.0%), Non-durable consumer goods (0.6%) and Durable consumer goods (0.1%).

#### **Evolution of Industrial New Orders Received**

The Industrial New Orders Received Index (INORI) experienced an interannual variation of **10.7%** in June, more than one-and-a-half points lower that registered in May.

By economic destination of the goods, all of the industrial sectors presented a positive effect on the general index. Worth noting among them were:

- Intermediate goods, with an annual variation of 13.5% and an effect on the overall index of 5.073, fundamentally due to the generalised increases experienced in the new orders received in this sector. Worth noting among them were Metallurgy, manufacture of iron, steel and ferro-alloy products and the Chemical industry, except cleaning articles, perfumes and cosmetics. Nevertheless, the Manufacture of other non-metallic ore products registered a negative evolution in new orders received.
- Capital goods, with an annual rate of 11.7%, and an effect of 2.461 on the general index, fundamentally due to the generalised increase experienced in the new orders received in this sector. Worth noting among them were the *Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers*.
- Energy, with an annual variation of 30.7% and an effect on the overall index of 2.231 due to the increase in the *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products*.




### Year-to-date average rates
