### Housing Price Index (HPI). Base 2007 Third quarter of 2011

### **General index**

	Quarterly variation	Year-to-date variation	Annual variation

#### Main results

- The **annual variation** rate of the HPI is **-7.4%** in the third quarter of 2011, six tenths lower than that registered the previous quarter.
- The interannual variation of **new housing** increases more than two tenths to 5.0%.
- **Second-hand** housing registers a decrease of one point in the **annual** rate, which stands at **-9.6%**.
- The **quarterly variation** of the general index is **–2.8%**.


#### Annual evolution of housing prices

The interannual rate of the Housing Price Index (HPI) in the third quarter of 2011 decreased six tenths, standing at –7.4%.

By type of housing, the annual variation of new housing stood at -5.0% in the third quarter of 2011, two tenths higher than the previous quarter.

In turn, the annual rate for second-hand housing went from –8.3% in the second quarter to – 9.6% in the third quarter of 2011.

### Annual evolution of the HPI General index, new housing and second-hand housing




#### Results by Autonomous Community. Interannual variation rates

The annual variation of the HPI is negative this quarter in all Autonomous Communities third consecutive quarter. In addition, this rate decreased in the majority of Autonomous Communities as compared with the previous quarter.

The greatest decreases in this variation took place in Cataluña (drop of 2.1 points up to -10.3%), País Vasco with a (decrease of 2.0 points up to -8.7% and Comunidad de Madrid (drop of 1.8 and stood at -8.9%).

In turn, the greatest increases of the annual variation took place in Extremadura (which increased its rate in 3.1 points up to -4.7%) and Principado de Asturias (raise of 2.5 points and stood at -3.7%).
