Housing Price Index (HPI). Base 2007 Fourth quarter of 2010

Main results

- The **annual variation** rate of the HPI is **-1.9%** in the fourth quarter of 2010, three tenths higher than that registered the previous quarter.
- The interannual variation of **new housing** increases half a point to **–2.1%**.
- Second-hand housing registers an increase of two tenths in the annual rate, which stands at -1.6%.
- The quarterly variation of the general index is -0.1%.


Annual evolution of housing prices

The interannual rate of the Housing Price Index (HPI) in the fourth quarter of 2010 increased three tenths, standing at –1.9%.

By type of housing, the annual variation of new housing rose from -2.6% in the third quarter of 2010 to -2.1% in the fourth quarter.

In turn, the annual rate for second-hand housing stood at -1.6%, two tenths higher than that recorded the previous quarter.

Annual evolution of the HPI General index, new housing and second-hand housing




Results by Autonomous Community. Interannual variation rates

The annual variation of the HPI increased in ten of the Autonomous Communities this quarter and decreased in seven of them.

The greatest increases in this variation took place in Extremadura (2.6 points) and Principado de Asturias (2.4 points), their annual rates standing at -1.7% and -1.0%, respectively, as compared with the previous quarter.

In turn, the greatest decreases in the annual variation took place in La Rioja, which decreased its rate two points to -6.2%, and Murcia whose rates stood almost one-and-a-half points below that registered in the third quarter.
