

Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Surveys

January 2010. Provisional data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation decrease 6.9%* in January, as compared with the same month in 2009

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 4.5 million in January, 6.9% less than in the same month the previous year. Overnight stays of residents in Spain increased 3.3%, whereas those of non-residents decreased 9.2%.

The average stay decreased 7.5% as compared with January 2009, standing at 7.6 nights per traveller.




Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 9.6% in January in the interannual rate

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.4 million in January, indicating a decrease of 9.6% as compared with the same month the previous year. Overnight stays of residents increased 4.0%, whereas those of non-residents decreased 11.4%.

* Due to the updating of the rural tourism accommodation directory of Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) is not directly comparable with the data published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published every month on the INE website, in the area dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled "linking coefficients".

Available holiday dwellings decreased 0.4%, reaching 348,921 bedplaces. **This month, 31.5%** of the total available bedplaces **were occupied**, 9.0% less than in January 2009. **The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces was 33.4%**, with an interannual decrease of 7.1%. In turn, of the total available holiday dwellings, 50.9% were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 7.2%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 85.9% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with 791,507 overnight stays, 20.0% less than in January of last year. The following market was Germany, with 626,930 overnight stays and an interannual rate of -2.2%.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.7 million overnight stays, 8.6% less than in January 2009. The second destination was Comunitat Valenciana, with 191,269 overnight stays, 22.4% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía were the main destinations of choice. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía.

Canarias presented the highest occupancy rate, with 68.2% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by País Vasco (48.0%) and Comunidad de Madrid (46.3%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with over 1.1 million overnight stays and an occupancy of 79.2% of the available holiday dwellings.

San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán were the tourist sites registering the highest number of overnight stays.


Prices for holiday dwellings decrease 1.6% in January

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 1.6% decrease in January, a rate 0.5 points higher than that recorded the previous month.


The rate for *tour-operadores and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (64.4%), decreased 1.7% in the interannual rate.

By modality, 2/4-bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 68.6%, decreased their prices 1.7% as compared with January 2009.

Overnight stays on tourist campsites increase 3.0%



Tourist campsites reached 831,039 overnight stays in January, indicating an interannual increase of 3.0%. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 1.4% in the interannual rate, and non-resident overnight stays increased 3.5%.

Tourist campsites offered 263,125 bedplaces, 0.4% less than in the same month of 2009. Of the available lots, 34.2% were occupied, 2.5% less in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate per lot reached 36.0%, that is, 2.2% less than in January 2009.

79.1% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with 38.1% of overnight stays by non-residents (0.3% more than in January 2009). The following country of origin was Germany.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 406,951 overnight stays, 10.2% more in the interannual rate. Andalucía was the second destination of choice, with 167,511 overnight stays, indicating a decrease of 2.5%.


Among resident travellers, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía, whereas the destinations with the most overnight stays by non-resident travellers were Comunitat Valenciana, Andalucía and Región de Murcia.

La Rioja reached the **highest occupancy rate in tourist campsites** in January, with 66.7% the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (55.1%) and Región de Murcia (51.6%).

By **tourist area**, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 259,473 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 67.9%.

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

Prices of tourist campsites increase 1.8% in the interannual rate



The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced interannual growth of 1.8% in January. The *normal rate for stays longer than one month*, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for January (47.1%), presented an increase of 2.4%.



Regarding category, luxury and first class, with a weighting of 49.6% this month, registered an interannual increase of 1.8%.

Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation increase 3.2%* in January as compared with the same month the previous year

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 298,054 in January, representing an interannual decrease of 0.5%. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 3.2%, whilst non-resident overnight stays dropped 22.5%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 119,216 bedplaces, 6.2% more than in January 2009. 8.0% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 6.3% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 17.4%, that is, 10.7% more in the interannual rate.




Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 57,102 overnight stays, 5.4% more than in January 2009. It was followed by Cataluña, with 39,777 overnight stays, 4.1% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias was the preferred destination. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Andalucía.

Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 20.8% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by La Rioja (15.2%) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (10.8%).

By tourist area, the Pirineo Catalán was the main destination, with 19,578 overnight stays in January. The island of Lanzarote reached the highest occupancy rate (43.0%).

Rural tourism accommodation prices decrease 1.0%



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual decrease of 1.0% in January.

The *weekend* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure this month (61.1%), fell 2.0%. By rent modality, complete use, with a weighting of 72.0%, recorded an interannual decrease of 1.3%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation


Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 1.9%* interannual decrease in January. Overnight stays of residents grew 2.6%, whereas those of non-residents decreased 4.5%.

In January, the average stay decreased 3.2%, and stood at 3.6 nights per traveller. Travellers and overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation were:



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of January, 71% corresponded to hotels, and 29% to non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 26.2% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (21.8%) and the Netherlands (4.8%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 6.7 million overnight stays (2.7% less than in January 2009). Next were Andalucía, with more than 1.9 million overnight stays (8.0% less) and Comunitat Valenciana, with more than 1.6 million overnight stays (4.3% less).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña and Canarias were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
