Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey **January 2011. Provisional data**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 3.9%¹ in January, as compared with the same month of 2010

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 4.5 million in January, 3.9% more than in the same month of 2010. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 7.2%, whereas those made by travellers not resident in Spain increased 6.8%.

The average stay increased 1.8%, as compared with January 2010, standing at 7.6 nights per traveller.

Travellers and overnight stays in collective non-hotel tourist accommodation during the month of January were:

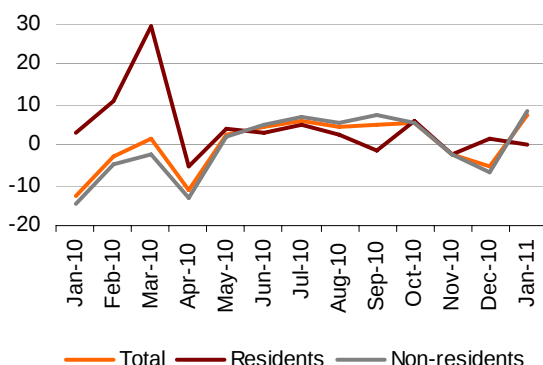

Holiday Dwellings

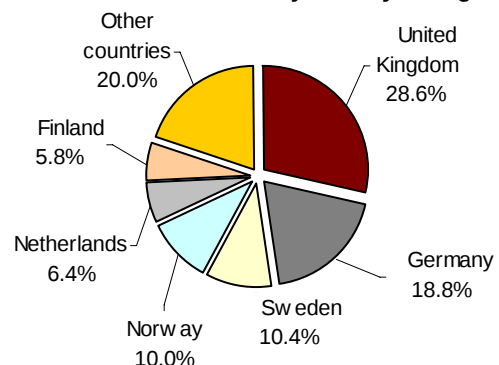
Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.5 million in January, representing an increase of 7.2%¹ over the same month the previous year. This increase in overnight stays occurred because of both resident travellers, whose interannual rate stood at 0.1%, and non-resident travellers, with an interannual variation of 8.4%.

The average stay increased 1.0%, as compared with January 2010, standing at 8.5 nights per traveller.

¹ Due to the update made in the directory of tourist accommodation in Comunidad Foral de Navarra, the data published cannot be directly compared to that published last year. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website, in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

Holiday dwellings offered 343,539 bedplaces, 0.6% more than in January 2010. This month, 33.1% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 6.6% more in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 34.6%, with an increase of 4.7%. In turn, 53.6% of the total available holiday dwellings were occupied, for an interannual increase of 6.5%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 86.6% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 875,562 overnight stays, 14.9% more than in January last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 577,448 overnight stays, 4.1% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.7 million overnight stays, 6.9% more than in January 2010. The second destination of choice was Comunitat Valenciana, with 204,502 overnight stays, 7.2% more.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía were the main destinations of choice. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Comunidad de Madrid.

Canarias showed the highest occupancy rate, with 74.0% of the available holiday dwellings. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (54.7%) and Illes Balears (40.6%).

By tourist area, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with more than 1.1 million overnight stays and an occupancy of 85.3% of the available holiday dwellings.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.

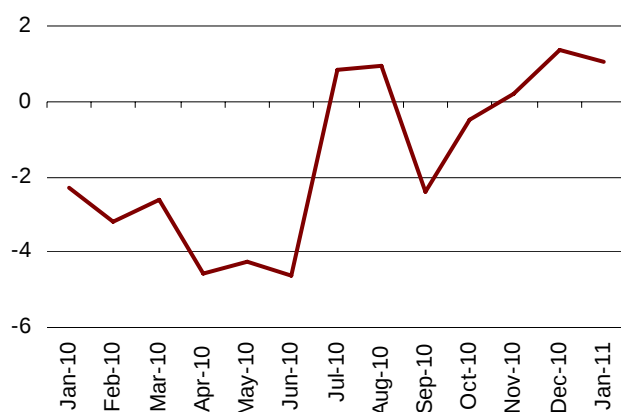
Holiday Dwelling Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an increase of 1.0% in January, a rate 0.4 points lower than that recorded the previous month.

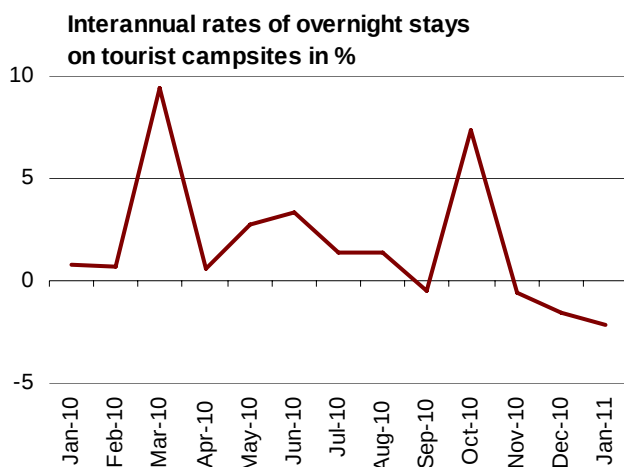
The rate for *Tour-operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (63.7%), registered an increase of 1.3%, as compared with the same month the previous year.

By modality, 2/4-bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 70.3%, increased their prices by 1.0%.

Tourist Campsites



Tourist campsites reached 794,965 overnight stays in the month of January, indicating an interannual decrease of 2.2%. Overnight stays of resident travellers decreased 6.2%, and those of non-resident travellers decreased 1.1%.

Tourist campsites offered 255,938 bedplaces, 3.7% less than in January 2010. 34.6% of the available lots were occupied, 2.0% more. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 35.5%, with an interannual decrease of 0.5%.

79.1% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 37.0% of the overnight stays by non-residents (4.4% less than in January 2010). The following country of origin was Germany.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 391,401 overnight stays, 1.8% more. Andalucía was the second destination of choice, with 153,964 overnight stays, indicating an interannual decrease of 8.3%.

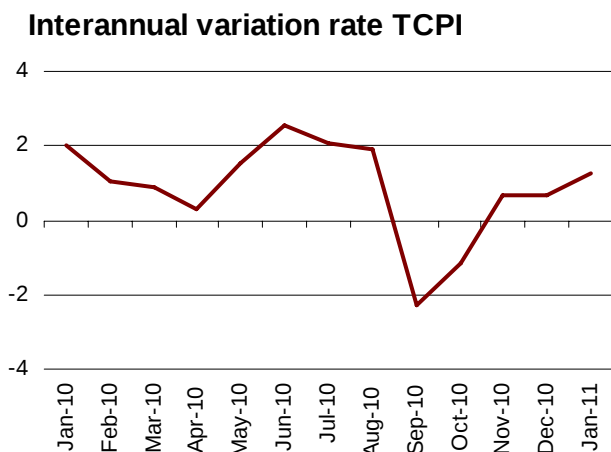
Among residents, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by non-resident travellers were Comunitat Valenciana, Andalucía and Región de Murcia.

La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 63.7% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (51.6%) and Región de Murcia (46.6%).

By tourist area, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 257,414 overnight stays and an occupancy of 66.1% of the available lots.

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays in January were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

Tourist Campsite Price Index Evolution



The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 1.3% in January. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (54.4%), presented an increase of 0.4%.

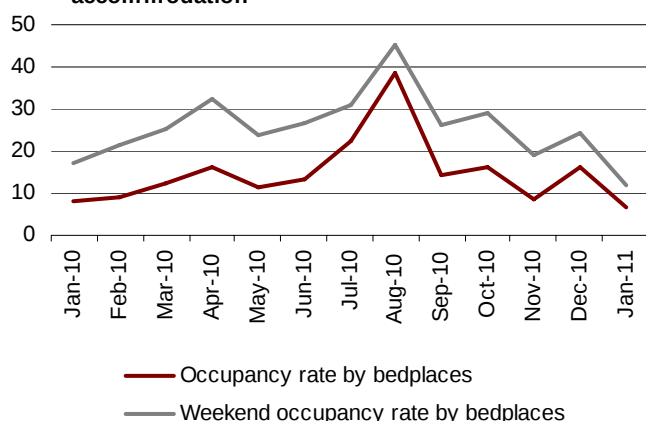
Regarding category, *second class*, with a weighting of 57.7% this month, registered an interannual increase of 0.6%.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

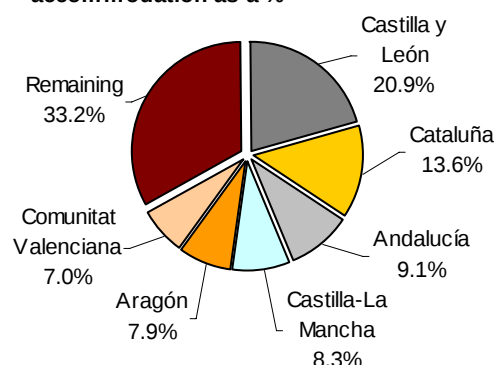
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 248,902 in January, indicating an interannual decrease of 15.8%¹. Resident overnight stays decreased 21.2%, whereas those by non-residents grew 22.6%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 122,276 bedplaces, 2.8% more than in January 2010. 6.6% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing an 18.0% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 12.1%, that is, 30.0% less in the interannual rate.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 45,331 overnight stays, 20.7% less than in January 2010. It was followed by Canarias, with 32,887 overnight stays, 23.4% more.

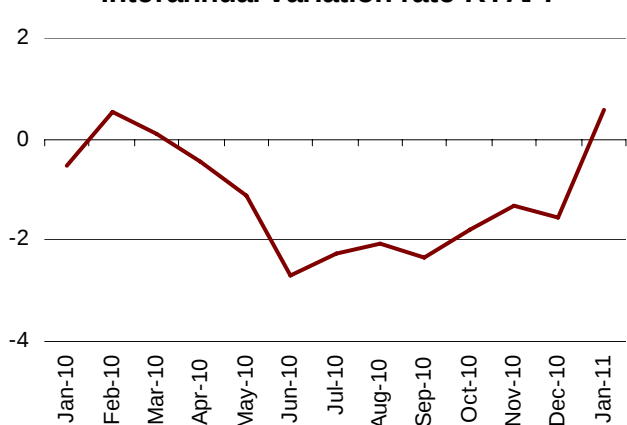
Among non-residents, Canarias was the preferred destination. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Andalucía.

Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 27.0% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by Illes Balears (11.2%) and Comunidad de Madrid (10.3%).

By tourist area, Pirineus-PrePirineus was the main destination, with 17,152 overnight stays. The island of Lanzarote reached the highest occupancy, 33.9% of the available bedplaces.

Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index Evolution

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 0.6% in January. The *weekend* rate, which accounted for 67.3% of the total weight, rose 0.3%. By rent modality, *complete use*, whose weighting was 74.1%, registered an increase of 0.7%.

By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León, Cataluña and Canarias, representing 44.5% of the total weight of the index in the month of January, registered positive interannual rates (2.0%, 0.7% and 0.7%, respectively).

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an **interannual increase of 4.4%¹ in January**. Overnight stays by residents decreased 1.8%, while non-resident stays increased 8.3%.

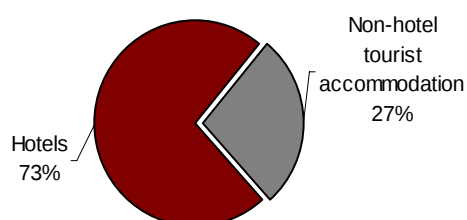
In January, the average stay increased 1.5%, standing at 3.7 nights per traveller.

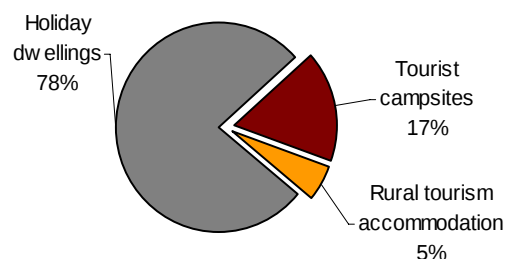

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of January, 73% were accounted for at hotels, and 27% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 25.5% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (22.0%) and Italy (5.0%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 7.5 million overnight stays (9.0% more than in January 2010). It was followed by Andalucía, with more than 1.9 million overnight stays (1.2% more) and Cataluña, with more than 1.6 million overnight stays (0.7% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía. In turn, Andalucía, Comunidad de Madrid and Cataluña were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
