Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
January 2012. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 4.6% in January, as compared with the same month of 2011

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 4.7 million in January, 4.6% more than in the same month of 2011. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 1.3% and by non-residents 5.4%.

The average stay increased 1.9%, as compared with January 2011, standing at 7.8 overnights per traveller.

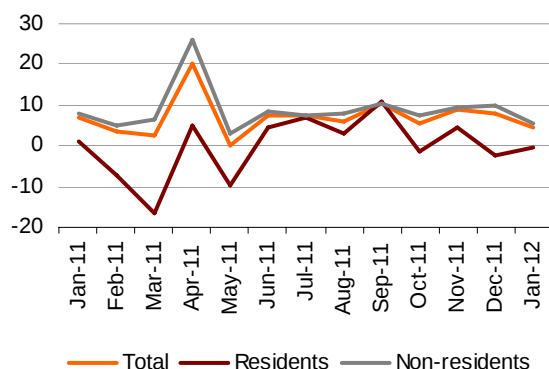
Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 4.7% in January. Overnight stays of residents decreased 0.6%, whereas those of non-residents increased 5.5%.

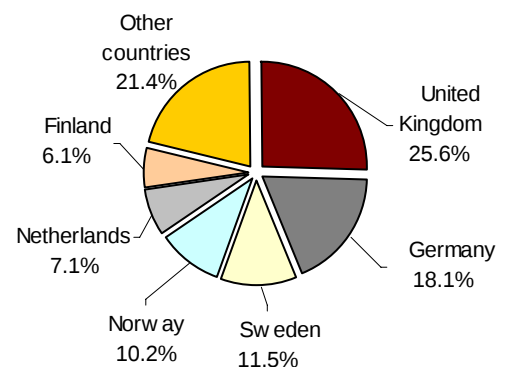
The average stay increased 1.8%, as compared with November 2010, standing at 8.0 overnights stays per traveller.

In January, 35.1% of the total available bedplaces for holiday dwellings were occupied, 5.0% more than in January 2011. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 35.6%, with an increase of 2.0%.

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings of non-resident travellers by country of origin in %



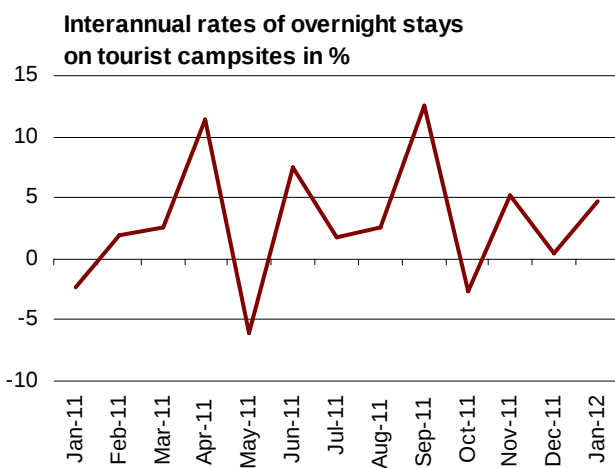
Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 87.1% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 822,655 overnight stays, 6.1% less than in January last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 581,061 overnight stays, 0.8% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with an increase of 5.8% and Comunitat Valenciana, that registered an increase of 5.2%. Canarias presented the highest occupancy rate with 82.9% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the island of Gran Canarias was the preferred destination in holiday dwellings, with more than of 1.1 million overnight stays, and an occupancy of 93.8% of the dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Mogán and Arona.

Tourist Campsites



The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered an interannual increase of 4.7%, in January. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 3.8%, and non-resident travellers 4.9%.

34.6% of the offered lots were occupied, 0.5% more. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 35.4%, with an interannual decrease of 0.4%.

79.3% of the overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 35.7% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 2.3% more than in January 2011.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 403,909 overnight stays, 2.6% more. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 58.2% of the lots offered.

By tourist area, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 247,071 overnight stays, with an occupancy of 66.1% of the lots offered.

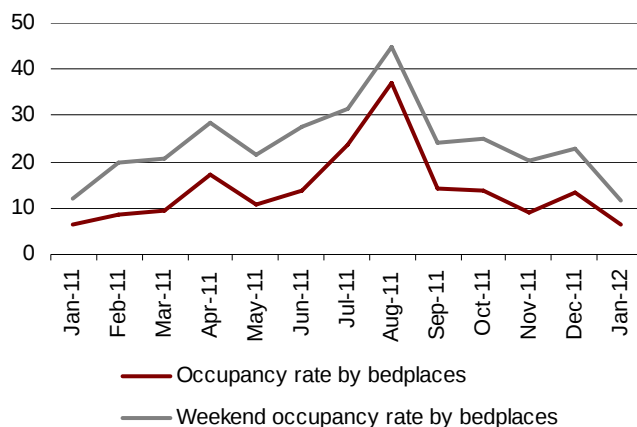
The tourist sites with the most overnight stays in December were Benidorm, Cartagena and Mazarrón.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

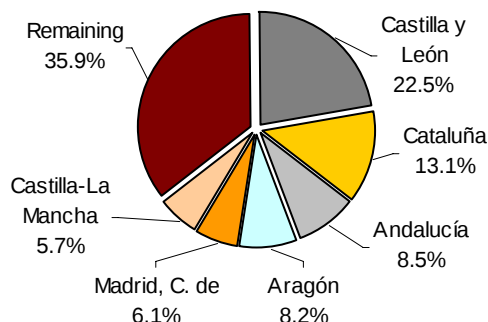
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an interannual increase of 3.6%, in January. Resident overnight stays grew 3.7%, by non-residents 3.4%.

6.6% of the bedplaces in rural tourism accommodation were occupied, representing a 0.4% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 11.8%, 2.4% less.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 49,538 overnight stays, 10.6% more than in January 2011. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 26.0% of the offered bedplaces.

By tourist area, Pirineus was the main destination, with 14,231 overnight stays. The National Park of Teide reached the highest occupancy with 40.1% of the offered bedplaces.

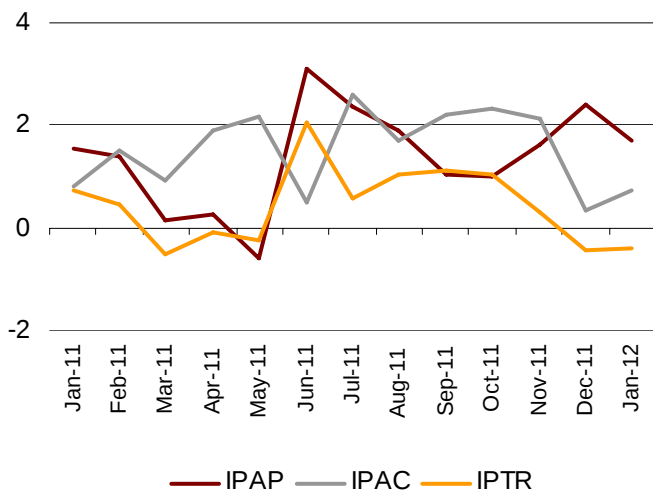
Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an increase of 1.7% in January, 0.7 points less than the rate recorded the previous month. The *Tour-operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (60.8%), registered an increase of 2.9%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 0.7% in January. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (46.3%), presented an increase of 1.1%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual decrease of 0.4% in December. The *weekend* rate, which accounted for 63.9% of the total weight, decreased 0.8%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an interannual increase of 3.8%¹ in January.

Overnight stays by residents remained unchanged, and non-resident stays increased 5.9%. The average stay increased 1.2%, standing at 3.7 nights per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of January, 73% were accounted for at hotels, and 27% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 24.8% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (20.5%) and Holland (5.4%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 7.9 million overnight stays (6.1% more than in January 2011). It was followed by Andalucía, with more than two million overnight stays (3.5% more) and Cataluña, with more than 1.7 million overnight stays (3.8% more).

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¹ Due to the update made in the tourist accommodation directory in Extremadura, the data published cannot be directly compared to that published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website, in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.
