Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
January 2021. Provisional data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations reached 4.7 million, compared to 1.4 million in the same month of 2021

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 4.7 million in January, compared to 1.4 million for same month of 2021; this supposed an increase of 231.0%. Overnight stays by residents increased by 124.6%, and those by non-resident by 316.5%.

The average stay stood at 5.5 overnight stays per traveller.


Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 293.3% in January. Resident overnight stays grew by 101.1%, and those of non-residents by 493.0%.

The average stay decreased by 7.5% as compared with January 2021, standing at 6.3 overnight stays per traveller.


In January, 25.9% of the bed-places available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 187.7% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 28.3%, with an increase of 180.4%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 73.9% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with 553,035 overnight stays. The following country of origin was Germany, with 370,267 overnight stays.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 1.7 million overnight stays, and an increase of 510.6% as compared with January 2021. This Autonomous Community reached the highest occupancy rate, with 66.5% of holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with 618,927 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 68.4% of holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in January were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tias.

Campgrounds


Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered in June an increase of 129.8% as compared with the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays grew by 100.2%, and those of non-residents by 140.8%.

During the month of January, 42.7% of the offered pitches were occupied, 35.2% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 43.7%, with an annual increase of 41.2%.

Non-residents accounted for 76.5% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. Germany was the main country of origin, with 37.1% of overnight stays by non-residents, 247.9% more than in January 2021.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 620,764 overnight stays, representing an annual increase of 89.0%. La Rioja achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 67.5% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 315,182 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 79.9% of the campsites offered.


The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Vélez-Málaga.

Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 218.6% January. Resident overnight stays grew by 211.5%, and those of non-residents by 252.7%.



In rural tourism accommodation, 8.6% of the bed-places were occupied, 149.5% more than January 2021. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 17.1%, with an annual increase of 241.2%.

Percentage




By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 50,333 overnight stays, 294.2% more than in January 2021. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 31.0% of bed-places offered.

By tourist area, Pirineus was the main destination, with 30,582 overnight stays. The Corona Forestal National Park reached the highest occupancy rate, with 39.6% of the bed-places offered.

Percentage




Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 594.4% in January, with 174,132 overnight stays. Resident overnight stays increased by 421.1% and non-resident overnight stays by 897.0%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay⁴



Occupancy rate Percentage




By communities, Comunidad de Madrid was the main destination, with 54,668 overnight stays. It likewise reached the highest occupancy rate, with 42.9% of the bed-places offered.

Price indices⁵

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 6.5% in January compared to the same month of 2021, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 2.8%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 8.9%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In January, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels⁶, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 292.3% increase in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays grew by 155.8%, and those of non-residents by 493.4%.

The average stay increased 12.0%, standing at 3.3 overnight stays per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 68.8% corresponded to hotels, and 31.2% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all regulated tourist accommodations were the United Kingdom (with 19.8% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (18.7%) and the Netherlands (8.3%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with over 5.6 million overnight stays (646.6% more than in January 2021). It was followed by Andalucía, with 2.2 million overnight stays (and an increase of 269.7%) and Cataluña, with over 1.7 million, (and an annual increase of 237.7%).

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for January 2021 of the Occupancy Survey in: Tourist Apartments (HDOS), Campgrounds (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodations (RTAOS), and Hostels (HOS), as well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

Type of sampling: stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
