

Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey January 2023. Provisional Data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increased by 23.7%, as compared with the same month of 2022

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 5.9 million in January, compared to 4.7 million for same month of 2022; this supposed an increase of 23.7%. Overnight stays by residents grew by 5.5%, and those of non-residents by 31.9%.

The average stay stood at 5.3 overnight stays per traveller.


Overnight stays in tourist apartments: increased 30.1% in January, as compared with the same month of 2022 Resident overnight stays increased by 8.1% and non-resident overnight stays by 37.9%.

The average stay decreased 3.0%, standing at 6.1 overnight stays per traveller.

In January, 31.9% of the bed-places available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 23.6% more than in the same month of 2022. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 33.8%, with an increase of 19.9%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 78.2% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with 899,702 overnight stays. The following country of origin was Germany, with 434,911.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.2 million overnight stays, and an increase of 29.4% as compared with January 2022. It also had the highest occupancy rate, at 84.6% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the Island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with 758,436 overnight stays. It also had the highest occupancy rate, with 87.5% of the apartments offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in January were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

Campgrounds


Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 8.5% in January as compared with the same month in 2022. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 10.3%, while those by non-residents increased by 14.6%.

During January, 45.4% of the pitches offered were occupied, 6.3% more than in the same month of 2022. The weekend occupancy rate reached 45.4%, with a 4.0% annual increase.

Non-residents accounted for 79.6% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. Germany was the main country of origin, with 38.3% of overnight stays by non-residents, 18.9% more than in January of 2022.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 686,855 overnight stays, representing an annual increase of 10.4%. It also achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 68.2% of campsites offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca (Alicante) was the preferred destination, with 352,315 overnight stays. This area also had the highest occupancy rate, with 84.4% of the campsites offered.


The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Vélez-Málaga.

Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 14.1% in January. Those by residents grew by 8.4% and those by non-residents did so by 38.7%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay



In rural tourism accommodation, 9.7% of the bed-places were occupied, 11.4% more than in January 2022. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 19.5%, with an annual increase of 12.8%.

Percentage




By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 59,983 overnight stays, 12.0% more than in January 2022. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 38.3% of bed-places offered.

By tourist area, Pirineus was the main destination, with 27,094 overnight stays. The Corona Forestal Natural Park reached the highest occupancy rate, with 47.6% of the bedplaces offered.

Percentage




Hostels

In January, there were 254,768 overnight stays in hostels, which represents an annual increase of 43.6%. Resident overnight stays increased by 27.7% and non-resident overnight stays by 58.9%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay



Percentage




Comunidad de Madrid was the main destination, with 71,469 overnight stays. It likewise reached the highest occupancy rate, with 51.2% of the bed-places offered.

Price indices

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 7.2% in January compared to the same month of 2022, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 5.0%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 6.9%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In January, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 39.4% increase in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays increased by 22.4% and non-resident overnight stays by 50.2%.

The average stay declined by 0.1%, to 3.3 overnight stays per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 72.3% corresponded to hotels, and 27.7% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all types of regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 23.3% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (17.2%) and France (5.9%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with over 8.0 million overnight stays (42.1% more than in January 2022). It was followed by Andalucía, with 3.1 million overnight stays (and an increase of 41.2%) and Cataluña, with over 2.5 million, (and an annual increase of 45.2%).

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for January 2022 of the Occupancy Survey in: Tourist Apartments (HDOS), Campgrounds (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodations (RTAOS), and Hostels (HOS), as well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

Type of sampling: stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Population scope: rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
