Non-hotel tourist accommodation occupancy survey February 2010. Provisional data

Overnight stays in Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation register a decrease of 2.1%* in February as compared with the same month of 2009

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 4.6 million in February, 2.1% less than in the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 5.7%, while those made by travellers not resident in Spain decreased 4.0%.

The average stay decreased 2.5% as compared with February 2009, standing at 6.7 nights per traveller.

During both first two months of the year, overnight stays decreased 4.5% as compared with the same period in the previous year.




Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.5 million in February, representing a 3.0% decrease as compared to the same month the previous year. Overnight stays of residents experienced an increase of 10.9%, while those of non-residents decreased 5.0%.

* Due to the update made in the directory of rural tourism accommodation in Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) cannot be directly compared to those published last year. To bridge this gap in the series, link coefficients have been created to allow users to compare data from different years. The coefficients will be published monthly on the INE website in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled link coefficients.

Available holiday dwellings decreased 0.5%, reaching 354,588 bedplaces. This month, 35.2% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 2.4% less than in February 2009. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 36.6%, with an interannual increase of 7.7%. In turn, 55.7% of the total available holiday dwellings were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 2.1%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 85.5% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin with 828,121 overnight stays, 7.3% less than in February of the previous year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 613,647 overnight stays, the same value as one year ago.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.6 million overnight stays, 3.6% less than in February 2009. The second destination of choice was Andalucía, with 251,822 million overnight stays, 0.2% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the preferred destinations. For their part, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía.

Canarias showed the greatest level of occupation in holiday dwellings, with 72.8% of available holiday dwellings. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (57.5%) and País Vasco (53.9%).

By tourist areas, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with over 1.1 million overnight stays and an occupancy of 84.2%.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.


Holiday Dwelling Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 3.2% decrease in February, a rate 1.6 points lower than that recorded the previous month.


The rate for *tour-operadores and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (63.9%), decreased 2.8% in the interannual rate.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 69.3%, decreased their prices 3.2% as compared with February 2009.

Holiday campsites



Tourist campsites reached 837,327 overnight stays in February, representing an interannual decrease of 0.7%. Overnight stays of resident travellers decreased 2.2% in the interannual rate, and those of non-resident travellers increased 1.5%.

Tourist campsites offer 278,414 bed places, 1.1% less than in the same month of 2009. 35.6% of the available lots were occupied, for an 4.0% less in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy level by lots reached 37.6%, that is, 4.6% less than in February 2009.

77.0% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 36.7% of overnight stays by non-residents (2.8% less than in February 2009). The following country of origin was Germany.

By tourist area, Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 387,262 overnight stays, for a 5.7% increase in the interannual rate. Andalucía was the second choice of destination, with over 172,427 overnight stays, indicating a decrease of 6.4%.


The preferred destinations for resident travellers were Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana, whereas for non-residents these were Comunitat Valenciana, Andalucía and Región de Murcia.

La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate in tourist campsites in February, with 62.9% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (57.8%) and Region de Murcia (54.4%).

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca is the preferred destination for camping, with 234,001 overnight stays and an occupancy of 70.9%.

The tourist destinations with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

Tourist Campsite Price Index Evolution




The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual growth of 1.1% in February. The *special rate for stays longer than one month*, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for February (47.7%), presented an increase of 1.2%.

Regarding category, second class, with a weighting of 50.8% this month, registered an interannual increase of 1.1%.


Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 315,887 in February, indicating an interannual increase of 0.4%*. Resident overnight stays increased 2.6%, while non-resident overnight stays decreased 10.3%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 123,570 bedplaces, 4.8% more than in February 2009. 9.1% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 4.1% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 21.5%, that is, 2.1% more in the interannual rate.



Distribution of overnight stays of travellers resident in Spain in rural tourism accommodation as a %




Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 69,039 overnight stays, 3.1% more than in February 2009. It was followed by Cataluña, with 37,850 overnight stays, 7.3% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias was the preferred destination. For their part, the destinations with more overnight stays by resident travellers were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Andalucía.

Canarias reached the highest degree of occupation of rural tourism accommodation, with 21.9% of offered bedplaces. It is followed by Illes Balears (19.1%) and Comunidad de Madrid (14.7%).

By tourist area, Pirineo Catalán was the main destination, with 20,607 overnight stays in February. The island of Lanzarote reached the highest occupancy (39.5%).

Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index Evolution



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 0.6% in February.

The weekend rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (63.2%), fell 0.3%. By rent modality, complete use, with a weighting of 66.9%, recorded an interannual increase of 0.1%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation


Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an interannual increase of 2.6%* in February. Overnight stays by residents increased 4.1%, and non-resident stays increased 1.6%.

The average stay decreased 0.9% in February, standing at 3.3 overnight stays per traveller. Travellers and overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation were:



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in February, 74% were accounted for at hotels and 26% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 25.5% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (21.9%) and the Netherlands (5.5%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourism accommodation, with more than 6.4 million of overnight stays (2.2% more than in February 2009). It was followed by Andalucía, with more than 2.5 million overnight stays (2.6% less) and Cataluña with more than 2 million overnight stays (14.8% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Andalucía and Cataluña. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
