Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
February 2011. Provisional data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 2.9%¹ in February, as compared with the same month of 2010

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 4.7 million in February, 2.9% more than in the same month of 2010. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 1.9%, whereas those made by travellers not resident in Spain increased 4.1%.

The average stay increased 0.7%, as compared with February 2010, standing at 6.7 nights per traveller.

Travellers and overnight stays in collective non-hotel tourist accommodation during the month of February were:



Holiday Dwellings


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.5 million in February, representing an increase of 3.4%¹ over the same month the previous year. Overnight stays of residents experienced a decrease of 7.4%, while those of non-residents increased 5.2%.

The average stay decreased 0.6%, as compared with February 2010, standing at 7.8 nights per traveller.

¹ Due to the update made in the directory of tourist accommodation in Comunidad Foral de Navarra, the data published cannot be directly compared to that published last year. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website, in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

Holiday dwellings offered 339,191 bedplaces, 2.7% less than in February 2010. This month, 37.4% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 6.2% more in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 39.2%, with an increase of 7.1%. In turn, 60.5% of the total available holiday dwellings were occupied, for an interannual increase of 8.1%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 87.1% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 848,317 overnight stays, 5.3% more than in February last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 587,677 overnight stays, 2.7% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.7 million overnight stays, 3.5% more than in February 2010. The second destination of choice was Andalucía, with 258,050 overnight stays, 4.7% more.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the main destinations of choice. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Andalucía and Cataluña.

Canarias showed the highest occupancy rate, with 81.9% of the available holiday dwellings. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (59.7%) and Illes Balears (45.3%).

By tourist area, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with more than one million overnight stays and an occupancy of 88.0% of the available holiday dwellings.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.


Holiday Dwelling Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an increase of 1.4% in February, a rate 0.4 points higher than that recorded the previous month.

The rate for *Tour-operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (61.5%), registered an increase of 2.6%, as compared with the same month the previous year.

By modality, 2/4-bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 69.7%, increased their prices by 1.7%.

Tourist Campsites



Tourist campsites reached 838,931 overnight stays in the month of February, indicating an interannual increase of 1.9%. Overnight stays of resident travellers increased 11.1%, and those of non-resident travellers decreased 0.9%.

Tourist campsites offered 277,862 bedplaces, 1.7% less than in February 2010. 36.7% of the available lots were occupied, 3.9% more. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 38.0%, with an interannual increase of 0.8%.

74.8% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 35.5% of the overnight stays by non-residents (5.5% less than in February 2010). The following country of origin was Germany.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 390,916 overnight stays, 4.5% more. Andalucía was the second destination of choice, with 171,444 overnight stays, indicating an interannual increase of 1.1%.


Among residents, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by non-resident travellers were Comunitat Valenciana, Andalucía and Región de Murcia.

La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 60.7% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (56.6%) and Comunidad de Madrid (49.1%).

By tourist area, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 245,645 overnight stays and an occupancy of 73.3% of the available lots.

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays in January were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

Tourist Campsite Price Index Evolution



The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 1.5% in February. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (48.5%), presented an increase of 0.6%.


Regarding category, *second class*, with a weighting of 54.6% this month, registered an interannual increase of 1.9%.

Rural Tourism Accommodation


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 311,689 in February, indicating an interannual decrease of 0.3%¹. Resident overnight stays decreased 0.8%, whereas those by non-residents grew 2.4%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 127,659 bedplaces, 3.5% more than in February 2010. 8.7% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 3.7% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 20.0%, that is, 6.3% less in the interannual rate.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 66,051 overnight stays, 2.8% less than in February 2010. It was followed by Cataluña, with 34,925 overnight stays, 7.5% more.


Among non-residents, Canarias was the preferred destination. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Andalucía.

Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 31.3% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by Illes Balears (17.2%) and Comunidad de Madrid (14.6%).

By tourist area, Pirineus-PrePirineus was the main destination, with 16,446 overnight stays. The Parque Nacional del Teide reached the highest occupancy, 41.3% of the available bedplaces.

Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index Evolution

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 0.5% in February. The weekend rate, which accounted for 72.5% of the total weight, rose 0.4%. By rent modality, *complete use*, whose weighting was 68.2%, registered an increase of 1.2%.

By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León, Cataluña and Canarias, representing 45.8% of the total weight of the index in the month of February, registered positive interannual rates (2.9%, 1.6% and -0.2%, respectively).

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an **interannual increase of 4.8%¹ in February**. Overnight stays by residents decreased 0.4%, while non-resident stays increased 7.8%.


In February, the average stay increased 1.4%, standing at 3.4 nights per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of February, 75% were accounted for at hotels, and 25% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 25.1% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (21.4%) and the Netherlands (5.4%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 7.5 million overnight stays (10.8% more than in February 2010). It was followed by Andalucía, with more than 2.6 million overnight stays (5.0% more) and Cataluña, with more than two million overnight stays (1.5% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Andalucía and Cataluña. In turn, Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
