Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
February 2012. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 2.3% in February, as compared with the same month of 2011

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 4.8 million in February, 2.3% more than in the same month of 2011. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 1.6% and by non-residents increased 3.3%. The average stay increased 6.1%, as compared with February 2011, standing at 7.0 overnights per traveller.

Overnight stays increased 3.5% the last two months, as compared with the same period of the previous year.


Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 2.4% in February. Overnight stays of residents increased 4.6%, whereas those of non-residents increased 2.0%.


The average stay increased 4.6%, standing at 8.1 overnights stays per traveller.

In February, 36.7% of the total available bedplaces for holiday dwellings were occupied, 1.6% less than in February 2011. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 37.8%, with a decrease of 3.1%.

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings of non-resident travellers by country of origin in %




Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 86.6% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 816,405 overnight stays, 3.6% less than in February last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 580,221 overnight stays, 2.5% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with an increase of 2.1% and Andalucía, that registered an increase of 0.2%. Canarias presented the highest occupancy rate with 84.0% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the island of Gran Canarias was the preferred destination in holiday dwellings, with more than one million overnight stays, and an occupancy of 93.4% of the dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.

Tourist Campsites



The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered an interannual increase of 3.9%, in February. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 10.4%, and non-resident travellers increased 8.8%.

35.7% of the offered lots were occupied, 1.5% less. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 37.1%, with an interannual decrease of 2.4%.

78.1% of the overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 34.3% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 5.3% more than in February 2011.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 398,220 overnight stays, 4.2% more. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 60.5% of the lots offered.

By tourist area, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 235,411 overnight stays, with an occupancy of 67.2% of the lots offered.


The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Oliva.

Rural Tourism Accommodation


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an interannual decrease of 2.1%, in February. Resident overnight stays dropped 5.9%, by non-residents grew 15.1%.

8.1% of the bedplaces in rural tourism accommodation were occupied, representing a 7.7% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 17.6%, 12.2% less.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 59,274 overnight stays, 10.3% less than in February 2011. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 31.0% of the offered bedplaces.

By tourist area, Pirineus was the main destination, with 14,543 overnight stays. The island of Lanzarote reached the highest occupancy with 43.0% of the offered bedplaces.


Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an increase of 2.5% in February, 0.8 points more than the rate recorded the previous month. The *Tour-operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (60.0%), registered an increase of 2.7%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index remained unchanged as compared with February 2011. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (48.8%), presented an increase of 0.5%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual decrease of 0.6% in February. The *weekend* rate, which accounted for 73.1% of the total weight, decreased 1.1%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an interannual increase of 0.1%¹ in February.

Overnight stays by residents decreased 2.9%, whereas those non-resident stays increased 2.0%. The average stay increased 1.6%, standing at 3.5 nights per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of February, 75% were accounted for at hotels, and 25% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 24.4% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (21.1%) and Holland (5.6%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 7.5 million overnight stays (0.6% more than in February 2011). It was followed by Andalucía, with more than 2.6 million overnight stays (1.1% more) and Cataluña, with more than 2.1 million overnight stays (2.2% more).

¹ Due to the update made in the tourist accommodation directory in Extremadura, the data published cannot be directly compared to that published last year. In order to avoid this break in the series, linking coefficients have been calculated, allowing for comparing the data from different years. The coefficients are published monthly on the INE website, in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.
