

Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey

February 2022. Provisional data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations reached 5.3 million, compared to 1.3 million in the same month of 2021

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 5.3 million in February, compared to 1.3 million for same month of 2021; this supposed an increase of 304.8%. Overnight stays by residents increased by 175.1%, and those by non-resident by 423.2%.

The average stay stood at 4.7 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first two months of 2022, overnight stays increased 266.2%, as compared to the same period of the previous year.

Holiday Dwellings


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased by 391.1% in February. Resident overnight stays grew by 122.7%, and those of non-residents by 724.7%.

The average stay decreased by 16.2% as compared to February 2021, standing at 5.5 overnight stays per traveller.

In February, 31.2% of the bed-places available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 245.5% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 35.8%, with an increase of 259.1%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay¹



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 74.9% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with 718,844 overnight stays. The following country of origin was Germany, with 345,013 overnight stays.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 1.8 million overnight stays, and an increase of 685.2% as compared with February 2021. This Autonomous Community reached the highest occupancy rate, with 73.6% of holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the Island of Tenerife was the preferred destination, with 618,139 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 78.3% of holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in February were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

Campgrounds


Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered in February an increase of 163.9% as compared with the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays grew by 157.3%, and those of non-residents by 166.7%.

During the month of February, 45.0% of the pitches offered were occupied, 40.8% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 47.2%, with an annual increase of 44.1%.

Non-residents accounted for 71.1% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. Germany was the main country of origin, with 34.6% of overnight stays by non-residents, 225.5% more than in February 2021.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 609,951 overnight stays, representing an annual increase of 113.8%. This Autonomous Community also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 65.6% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 307,663 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 82.7% of the campsites offered.

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Vélez-Málaga.



Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 323.8% in February. Resident overnight stays grew by 335.6%, and those of non-residents by 278.2%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay³



In rural tourism accommodation, 12.4% of the bed-places were occupied, 222.4% more than February 2021. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 27.8%, with an annual increase of 363.5%.

Percentage





By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 82,289 overnight stays, 527.1% more than in February 2021. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 35.7% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, Pirineus was the main destination, with 29,733 overnight stays. The Corona Forestal National Park reached the highest occupancy rate, with 44.5% of the bed-places offered.

Percentage




Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 685.1% in February, with 237,616 overnight stays. Resident overnight stays increased by 589.8% and non-resident overnight stays by 825.2%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay⁴



A total of 17.7% of the bed-places were occupied, 286.4% more than in February 2021. The weekend occupancy rate reached 24.9%, with a 407.9% increase.

Comunidad de Madrid was the main destination, with 57,414 overnight stays. This Autonomous Community also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 49.8% of the bed-places offered.



Price indices⁵

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 16.4% in February compared to the same month of 2021, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 3.6%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 7.2%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In February, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels⁶, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) registered a 404.7% increase in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays grew by 222.6%, and those of non-residents by 728.6%.

The average stay increased 10.4%, standing at 3.0 overnight stays per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 71.8% corresponded to hotels, and 28.2% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all regulated tourist accommodations were the United Kingdom (with 24.0% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (16.1%) and France (9.4%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with over 6.2 million overnight stays (884.4% more than in February 2021). It was followed by Andalucía, with 3.0 million overnight stays (and an increase of 458.6%) and Cataluña, with over 2.3 million, (and an annual increase of 384.9%).

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for January 2021 of the Occupancy Survey in: Tourist Apartments (HDOS), Campgrounds (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodations (RTAOS), and Hostels (HOS), as well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

Type of sampling: stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
