#### Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey February 2023. Provisional Data

# Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increased by 13.5%, as compared with the same month of 2022

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 6.0 million in February, compared to 5.3 million for same month of 2022; this supposed an increase of 13.5%. Overnight stays by residents grew by 2.7%, and those of non-residents by 18.7%.

For the second consecutive month, overnight stays exceed those for the same month of 2019.

The average stay stood at 4.8 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first two months of 2023, overnight stays increased 18.3%, as compared to the same period of the previous year.

#### **Holiday Dwellings**

Overnight stays in tourist apartments: increased 17.5% in February, as compared with the same month of 2022 Resident overnight stays increased by 6.8% and non-resident overnight stays by 21.1%.

The average stay increased 3.3%, standing at 5.6 overnight stays per traveller.

In February, 34.9% of the bed-places available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 11.7% more than in the same month of 2022. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 38.7%, with an increase of 8.0%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 77.1% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with 900,485 overnight stays. The following country of origin was Germany, with 399,901.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.1 million overnight stays, and an increase of 14.8% as compared with February 2022. It also had the highest occupancy rate, at 84.9% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Tenerife was the preferred destination, with 703,317 overnight stays. Isla de Gran Canaria had the highest occupancy rate, with 87.8% of the apartments offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in February were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tias.

#### Campgrounds

Press

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 6.0% in February as compared with the same month in 2022. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 4.3% while those by non-residents increased by 10.2%.

During February, 46.2% of the pitches offered were occupied, 2.6% more than in the same month of 2022. The weekend occupancy rate reached 47.6%, with a 1.3% annual increase.

Non-residents accounted for 73.9% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. Germany was the main country of origin, with 35.6% of overnight stays by non-residents, 13.2% more than in February of 2022.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 670,086 overnight stays, representing an annual increase of 8.4%. It also achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 71.3% of campsites offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca (Alicante) was the preferred destination, with 334,190 overnight stays. This area also had the highest occupancy rate, with 86.3% of the campsites offered.

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Vélez-Málaga.

#### **Rural tourism accommodation**

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 2.8% in February. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 3.2%, while those by non-residents increased by 29.9%.

In rural tourism accommodation, 12.6% of the bed-places were occupied, 2.3% more than February 2022. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 26.9%, with an annual decrease of 2.6%.



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 84,093 overnight stays, 1.9% more than in February 2022. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 41.0% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, Pirineus was the main destination, with 30,236 overnight stays. The Corona Forestal Natural Park reached the highest occupancy rate, with 50.9% of the bedplaces

#### Hostels

In February, there were 290,667 overnight stays in hostels, which represents an annual increase of 22.7%. Resident overnight stays increased by 15.6% and non-resident overnight stays by 30.5%.

A total of 20.0% of the bed-places were occupied, 14.1% more than in February 2022. The weekend occupancy rate reached 24.0%, with a 0.7% increase.



Comunidad de Madrid was the main destination, with 69,964 overnight stays. It likewise reached the highest occupancy rate, with 54.8% of the bed-places offered.

#### **Price indices**

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 9.4% in February compared to the same month of 2022, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 4.8%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 6.1%.

# Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In February, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>1</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) registered a 20.7% increase in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays increased by 6.2% and non-resident overnight stays by 30.8%.

The average stay rose by 5.2%, to 3.2 overnight stays per traveller.

Travellers and overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation were:

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 73.4% corresponded to hotels, and 27.7% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.



#### Annual variation rates for overnight stays in collective tourist accommodations Percentage

The main countries of origin for all types of regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 23.9% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (17.2%) and France (7.5%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with over 7.6 million overnight stays (23.4% more than in February 2022). It was followed by Andalucía, with 3.7 million overnight stays (and an increase of 21.0%) and Cataluña, with over 2.9 million, (and an annual increase of 25.6%).

#### Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for February 2022 of the Occupancy Surveys in: Tourist Apartments (HDOS), Campgrounds (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodations (RTAOS), and Hostels (HOS), as well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

#### Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

**Type of operation**: monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

**Type of sampling:** stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

**Type of operation**: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
