**Non-hotel tourist accommodation occupancy survey  
March 2010. Provisional data**

**Overnight stays in Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation register an increase of 3.8%\* in March as compared with the same month of 2009**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 5.5 million in March, 3.8% more than in the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 18.6%, while those made by travellers not resident in Spain decreased 0.9%.

The average stay decreased 8.1% as compared with March 2009, standing at 5.8 nights per traveller.

During first quarter of the year, overnight stays decreased 1.6% as compared with the same period in the previous year.




### Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.9 million in March, representing a 1.8% increase as compared with the same month the previous year. Overnight stays of residents experienced an increase of 29.7%, while those of non-residents decreased 2.5%.

\* Due to the update made in the directory of rural tourism accommodation in Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) cannot be directly compared to those published last year. To bridge this gap in the series, link coefficients have been created to allow users to compare data from different years. The coefficients will be published monthly on the INE website in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled link coefficients.

Available holiday dwellings increased 1.5%, reaching 371,272 bedplaces. This month, 34.1% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 0.3% more than in March 2009. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 36.2%, with an increase of 0.2%. In turn, 54.3% of the total available holiday dwellings were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 0.6%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 83.0% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 973,238 overnight stays, 2.0% less than in March of the previous year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 668,455 overnight stays, 1.1% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.8 million overnight stays, 0.5% less than in March 2009. The second destination of choice was Andalucía, with 336,992 million overnight stays, 8.3% more.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the preferred destinations. For their part, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía.

Canarias showed the greatest level of occupation, with 71.5% of available holiday dwellings. It was followed by Illes Balears (60.0%) and Comunidad de Madrid (58.1%).

By tourist areas, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with over 1.1 million overnight stays and an occupancy of 82.2% of available holiday dwellings.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.


## Holiday Dwelling Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 2.6% decrease in March, a rate 0.6 points higher than that recorded the previous month.


The rate for *tour-operadores and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (62.3%), decreased 2.3% in the interannual rate.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 67.9%, decreased their prices 2.5%.

## Holiday Campsites



Tourist campsites exceeded 1.1 million overnight stays in March, representing an interannual increase of 9.4%. Overnight stays of resident travellers increased 12.3% and those of non-resident travellers increased 7.7%.

Tourist campsites offer 348,709 bed places, 3.7% more than in the same month of 2009. 33.8% of the available lots were occupied, 0.9% more. The weekend occupancy level by lots reached 35.1%, that is, 2.1% less than in March 2009.

62.2% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 35.9% of overnight stays by non-residents (6.0% more than in March 2009). The following country of origin was Germany.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 438,598 overnight stays, for a 15.1% increase in the interannual rate. Cataluña was the second choice of destination, with 216,696 overnight stays, indicating an increase of 13.4%.


The preferred destinations for resident travellers were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía, whereas for non-residents these were Comunitat Valenciana, Andalucía and Región de Murcia.

La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate in tourist campsites in March, with 64.3% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (54.2%) and Region de Murcia (48.8%).

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca is the preferred destination for camping, with 245,202 overnight stays and an occupancy of 65.0%.

The tourist destinations with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Oliva.

## Tourist Campsite Price Index Evolution



The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual growth of 0.9% in March. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for March (49.7%), presented a decrease of 0.5%.


Regarding category, *second class*, with a weighting of 53.5% this month, registered an interannual increase of 1.1%.

## Rural Tourism Accommodation


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 489,772 in March, indicating an interannual increase of 7.6%\*. Resident overnight stays increased 9.8%, while non-resident overnight stays decreased 4.1%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 128,258 bedplaces, 4.2% more than in March 2009. 12.3% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 3.2% increase. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 25.1%, that is, 2.1% less in the interannual rate.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 113,277 overnight stays, 13.1% more than in March 2009. It was followed by Cataluña, with 49,272 overnight stays, 6.3% more.


Among non-residents, Canarias was the preferred destination. For their part, the destinations with most overnight stays by resident travellers were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Castilla-La Mancha.

Canarias reached the highest degree of occupation of rural tourism accommodation, with 25.8% of available bedplaces. It was followed by Illes Balears (22.4%) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (20.0%).

By tourist area, Pirineo Catalán was the main destination, with 23,395 overnight stays in March. Teide National Park reached the highest occupancy (31.3%).

## Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index Evolution

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual increase of 0.1% in March.

The *weekend* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (64.4%), fell 0.8%. By rent modality, *complete use*, with a weighting of 63.2%, recorded an interannual decrease of 0.7% in March.

## Annex

### Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation


Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an interannual increase of 6.6%\* in March. Overnight stays by residents increased 10.7%, and non-resident stays increased 3.6%.

The average stay decreased 1.5% in March, standing at 3.4 overnight stays per traveller. Travellers and overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation were:



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in March, 75% were accounted for at hotels and 25% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 27.3% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (22.3%) and the Netherlands (4.9%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourism accommodation, with more than seven million of overnight stays (3.5% more than in March 2009). It was followed by Andalucía, with more than 3.3 million overnight stays (3.1% more) and Cataluña with more than 2.7 million overnight stays (21.3% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Andalucía and Cataluña. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
