Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
March 2012. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation remains unchanged in March, as compared with the same month of 2011

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 5.3 million in March 2012. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 6.5% and by non-residents decreased 1.9%. The average stay decreased 5.2%, as compared with March 2011, standing at 5.9 overnights per traveller.

During first quarter of the year, overnight stays increased 2.2%, as compared with the same period the previous year.

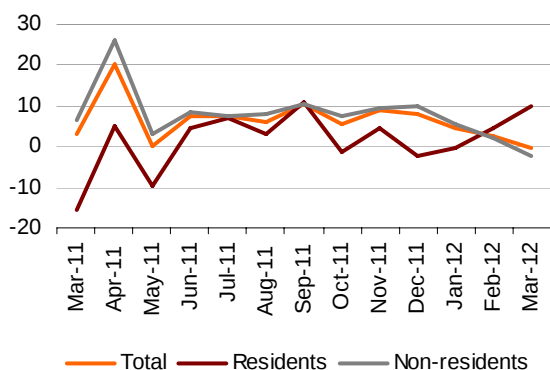
Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased 0.6% in March. Overnight stays of residents increased 10.0%, whereas those of non-residents decreased 2.3%.

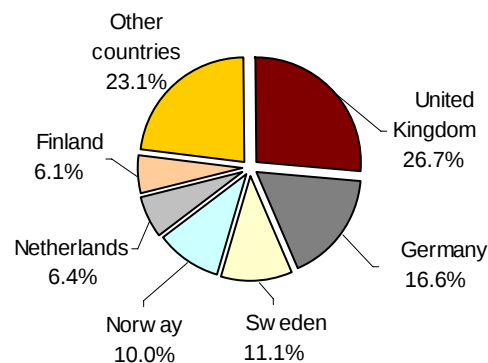
The average stay decreased 4.5%, standing at 7.4 overnights stays per traveller.

In March, 35.7% of the total available bedplaces for holiday dwellings were occupied, 1.7% less than in March 2011. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 37.8%, with a decrease of 2.9%.

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings of non-resident travellers by country of origin in %



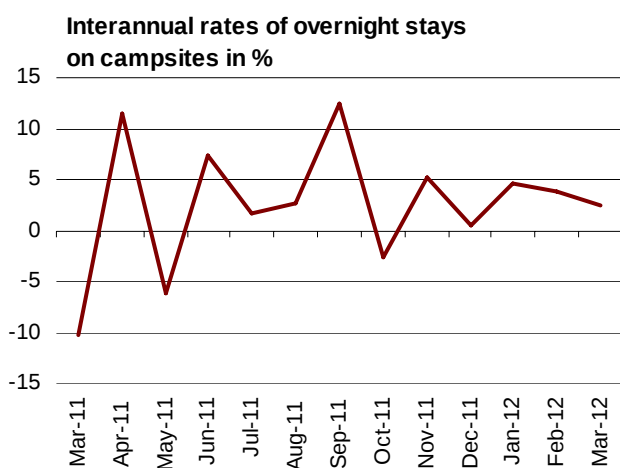
Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 84.6% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 901,572 overnight stays, 8.0% less than in March last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 561,654 overnight stays, 11.0% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with a decrease of 4.0% and Andalucía, that registered an increase of 2.7%. Canarias presented the highest occupancy rate with 81.0% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the island of Gran Canarias was the preferred destination in holiday dwellings, with 1.1 million overnight stays, and an occupancy of 89.7% of the dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.

Tourist Campsites



The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered an interannual increase of 2.5%, in March. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 7.2%, and non-resident travellers remained unchanged.

32.5% of the offered lots were occupied, 2.0% less. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 33.7%, with an interannual decrease of 5.6%.

64.0% of the overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 34.9% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 0.5% less than in March 2011.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for camping, with 416,512 overnight stays, 2.6% more. La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 61.7% of the lots offered.

By tourist area, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 219,196 overnight stays, with an occupancy of 60.8% of the lots offered.

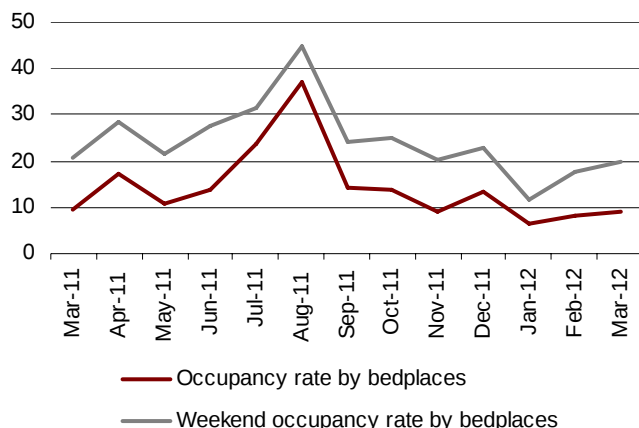
The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

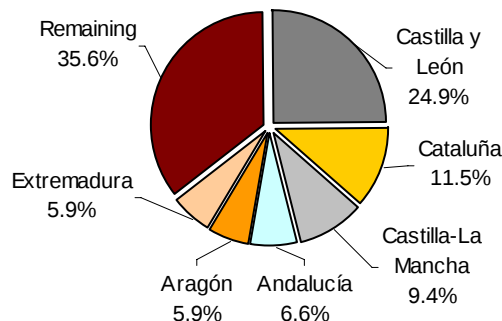
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an interannual decrease of 0.6%, in March. Resident overnight stays dropped 0.6% and by non-residents 0.4%.

9.2% of the bedplaces in rural tourism accommodation were occupied, representing a 4.2% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 19.7%, 5.6% less.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 82,901 overnight stays, 1.2% more than in March 2011. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 29.5% of the offered bedplaces.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 25,338 overnight stays. The island of Lanzarote reached the highest occupancy with 44.8% of the offered bedplaces.

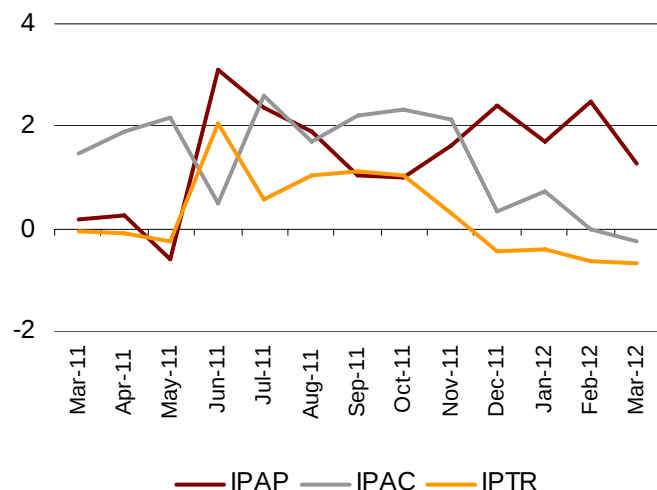
Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered an increase of 1.3% in March, 1.2 points lower than the rate recorded the previous month. The *Tour-operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (59.3%), registered an increase of 0.9%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index registered a decrease of 0.3%, as compared with March 2011. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (47.0%), presented a decrease of 0.1%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual decrease of 0.7% in March. The *weekend* rate, which accounted for 71.3% of the total weight, decreased 1.2%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an interannual decrease of 2.7% in March.

Overnight stays by residents decreased 1.8%, and non-resident stays 3.3%. The average stay decreased 2.9%, standing at 3.4 nights per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of March, 76% were accounted for at hotels, and 24% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 25.1% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (21.3%) and France (5.2%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 7.8 million overnight stays (6.8% less than in March 2011). It was followed by Andalucía, with more than 3.3 million overnight stays (0.8% less) and Cataluña, with more than 2.8 million overnight stays (2.1% more).
