**Encuestas de ocupación en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros**  
Marzo 2016. *Datos provisionales*

**Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros<sup>1</sup> aumentan un 33,0% en marzo respecto al mismo mes de 2015**

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros (apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) superan los 7,8 millones en marzo, un 33,0% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. Las pernoctaciones de residentes aumentan un 92,4% y las de no residentes un 12,2%.

La estancia media es de 5,0 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Durante el primer trimestre de 2016, las pernoctaciones aumentan un 18,5% respecto al mismo periodo del año anterior

**Apartamentos turísticos**


Las pernoctaciones en apartamentos turísticos aumentan un 18,3% en marzo. Las de residentes suben un 57,7% y las de no residentes un 11,1%.

La estancia media baja un 8,7% respecto a marzo de 2015, situándose en 6,4 pernoctaciones por viajero.

En marzo se ocupan el 38,5% de las plazas ofertadas por los apartamentos turísticos, un 9,3% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. El grado de ocupación por plazas en fin de semana se sitúa en el 42,7%, con un incremento del 12,3%.



Las pernoctaciones de no residentes en apartamentos turísticos representan el 79,3% del total. Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con más de 1,1 millones pernoctaciones, un 15,9% más que en marzo de 2015. El siguiente mercado emisor es Alemania, con 594.405 pernoctaciones, un 6,0% más.

Canarias es el destino preferido en apartamentos, con más de 2,9 millones de pernoctaciones, un 9,6% más que en marzo de 2015. Esta comunidad también alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 86,0% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Por zonas turísticas, la isla de Gran Canaria es el destino preferido, con más de un millón de pernoctaciones y una ocupación del 90,2% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Los puntos turísticos con mayor número de pernoctaciones en marzo son San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona y Mogán.


## Campings

Las pernoctaciones en campings registran en marzo un incremento anual del 71,0% respecto al mismo mes del año anterior. Las de residentes aumentan un 172,0% y las de no residentes un 15,0%.

Durante el mes de marzo se ocupan el 35,1% de las parcelas ofertadas, un 3,2% más. El grado de ocupación por parcelas en fin de semana alcanza el 38,5%, con un aumento anual del 9,5%.

El 43,2% de las pernoctaciones en campings las realizan viajeros no residentes. Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con el 32,1% de las pernoctaciones de no residentes, un 8,6% más que en marzo de 2015.

Comunitat Valenciana es el destino preferido en campings, con 662.068 pernoctaciones, un 30,6% más que en marzo de 2015. La Rioja alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, el 59,4% de las parcelas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, la Costa Blanca es el destino preferido, con 323.718 pernoctaciones y una ocupación del 78,7% de las parcelas ofertadas.


Los puntos turísticos con más pernoctaciones son Benidorm, Cartagena y Tarragona.

## Alojamientos de turismo rural

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos de turismo rural presentan un aumento anual del 74,4% en marzo. Las de residentes suben un 83,5% y las de no residentes un 40,3%.

En los alojamientos de turismo rural se ocupan el 17,4% de las plazas, con un crecimiento del 65,3% respecto a marzo de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana se sitúa en el 34,9%, con un incremento del 40,5%.


Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



Por comunidades, Castilla y León es el destino preferido, con 145.779 pernoctaciones, un 71,7% más que en marzo de 2015. Illes Balears alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 39,0% de las plazas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, la isla de Mallorca es el principal destino, con 43.700 pernoctaciones. La isla de Tenerife alcanza la mayor ocupación, del 44,2% de las plazas ofertadas.

## Albergues

Las pernoctaciones en albergues registran en marzo un aumento anual del 13,6%. Las de residentes suben un 21,5%, mientras que las de no residentes bajan un 3,3%.

Se ocupan el 26,7% de las plazas, un 14,3% más que en marzo de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana alcanza el 38,0%, con un aumento del 21,1%.

Por comunidades, Cataluña es el destino preferido, con 79.357 pernoctaciones, un 21,4% más que en marzo de 2015. Esta comunidad también alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 38,6% de las plazas ofertadas.


## Índices de precios

El Índice de Precios de Apartamentos Turísticos (IPAP) aumenta un 6,3% respecto a marzo de 2015. La tarifa *tour-operadores y agencias de viajes*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones este mes (57,1%), sube un 6,6%.

El Índice de Precios de Campings (IPAC) se incrementa un 5,4% en tasa anual. La tarifa *normal*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones en marzo (34,8%), sube un 6,3% respecto al mismo mes de 2015.

El Índice de Precios de Alojamientos de Turismo Rural (IPTR) registra un aumento del 2,4% en marzo. La tarifa *fin de semana*, que supone el 65,2% del peso total, sube un 2,5% en tasa anual.

## Evolución de los viajeros y las pernoctaciones en todos los alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles

Las pernoctaciones en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles (hoteles<sup>2</sup>, apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) aumentan un 21,4% en marzo en tasa anual. Las de residentes suben un 33,9% y las de no residentes un 13,8%.


La estancia media sube un 0,4%, situándose en 3,4 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Del total de pernoctaciones realizadas en alojamientos turísticos colectivos, un 74% corresponde a hoteles y un 26% a alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros.

Los principales mercados emisores en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos reglados son el británico (con el 25,9% del total de pernoctaciones de no residentes), el alemán (22,2%) y el francés (5,7%).

Canarias es el destino preferido, con 9,0 millones de pernoctaciones (un 11,4% más que en marzo de 2015). Le siguen Andalucía, con más de 4,7 millones (y un aumento anual del 23,1%) y Cataluña, con 4,4 millones (y un incremento del 33,0%).
