

## Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey

March 2023. Provisional Data

### Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increased by 15.7%, as compared with the same month of 2022

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 6.9 million in March, compared to 5.9 million for same month of 2022; reaching 2019 levels. In the annual rate, they grew by 15.7%. Overnight stays by residents grew by 20.4%, and those of non-residents by 13.4%.

The average stay stood at 4.3 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first three months of 2023, overnight stays increased 17.3%, as compared to the same period of the previous year.

### Holiday Dwellings


Overnight stays in tourist apartments: increased 10.2% in March, as compared with the same month of 2022 Resident overnight stays increased by 4.9% and non-resident overnight stays by 11.9%.

The average stay decreased 5.9%, standing at 5.4 overnight stays per traveller.

In March, 32.0% of the bed-places available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 6.1% more than in the same month of 2022. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 36.0%, with a growth of 4.0%.

### Annual variation rate for overnight stay



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 77.5% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with 1.0 million overnight stays. The following country of origin was Germany, with 388,838.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.1 million overnight stays, and an increase of 10.2% as compared with March of 2022. It also had the highest occupancy rate, at 81.2% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Tenerife was the preferred destination, with 716,542 overnight stays. Isla de Lanzarote had the highest occupancy rate, with 90.5% of the apartments offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in March were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

## Campgrounds


Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 27.6% in March as compared with the same month in 2022. Those by residents grew by 50.2% and those by non-residents did so by 15.8%.

During March, 39.7% of the pitches offered were occupied, 8.7% more than in the same month of 2022. The weekend occupancy rate reached 42.1%, with a 9.3% annual increase.

Non-residents accounted for 59.6% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. Germany was the main country of origin, with 34.5% of overnight stays by non-residents, 19.9% more than in March of 2022.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with 690,538 overnight stays, representing an annual increase of 17.7%. It also achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 62.1% of campsites offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca (Alicante) was the preferred destination, with 331,210 overnight stays. This area also had the highest occupancy rate, with 77.5% of the campsites offered.


The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Cabanes.

## Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 17.5% in March. Those by residents grew by 14.6% and those by non-residents did so by 27.2%.

### Annual variation rate for overnight stay



In rural tourism accommodation, 13.1% of the bed-places were occupied, 15.7% more than March 2022. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 26.8%, with an annual decrease of 1.3%.

Percentage




By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 103,940 overnight stays, 17.4% more than in March 2022. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 39.6% of the bed-places offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 55,843 overnight stays. The Corona Forestal Natural Park reached the highest occupancy rate, with 42.2% of the bedplaces offered.

Percentage




### Hostels

In March, there were 436,434 overnight stays in hostels, which represents an annual increase of 23.0%. Resident overnight stays increased by 29.4% and non-resident overnight stays by 16.1%.

### Annual variation rate for overnight stay



Percentage




Comunidad de Madrid was the main destination, with 84,145 overnight stays. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 61.8% of the bed-places offered.

## Price indices

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 9.6% in March compared to the same month of 2022, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 5.0%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 4.4%.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In March, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>1</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 16.7% increase in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays increased by 15.1% and non-resident overnight stays by 17.7%.

The average stay declined by 4.6%, to 3.1 overnight stays per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 74.9% corresponded to hotels, and 25.1% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all types of regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 24.8% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (18.1%) and France (6.3%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with over 8.0 million overnight stays (8.8% more than in March 2022). It was followed by Andalucía, with 4.5 million overnight stays (and an increase of 20.1%) and Cataluña, with over 3.7 million, (and an annual increase of 25.0%).

## **Revision and updating of data**

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for March 2022 of the Occupancy Survey in: Tourist Apartments (HDOS), Campgrounds (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodations (RTAOS), and Hostels (HOS), as well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

## **Methodological note**

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

**Type of sampling:** stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** camping establishments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

**Sample size:** approximately 1,200 establishments.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that entrepreneurs of this type of accommodation apply to their clients.

**Population scope:** rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
