**Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey  
April 2008. Provisional data**

**Overnight stays in collective non-hotel accommodation decrease  
25.1% in April, as compared to the same month in 2007**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) surpassed 5.6 million in April, 25.1% less than in the same month of the previous year. This decrease was more pronounced among residents (48.9%), than among non-residents (6.2%). The Easter effect should be borne in mind, since Easter week was held in March this year, whereas in 2007 it was held in April.

On analysis of the **March-April aggregated period** there was a 6.2% decrease in overnight stays, as compared with the same two-month period for 2007. During the aforementioned period, overnight stays by residents experienced an 11.1% decrease and those of non-residents decreased 3.6%.

During the first quarter of the year, overnight stays decreased 2.7% as compared with the same period of the previous year.

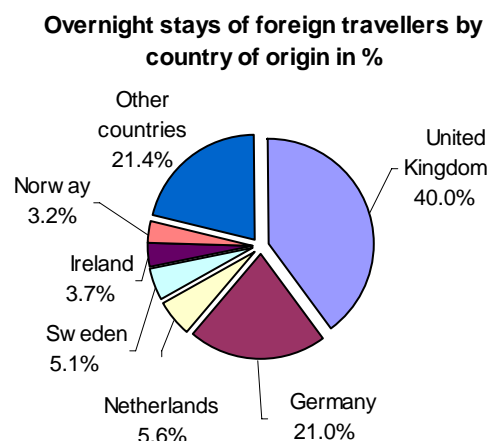
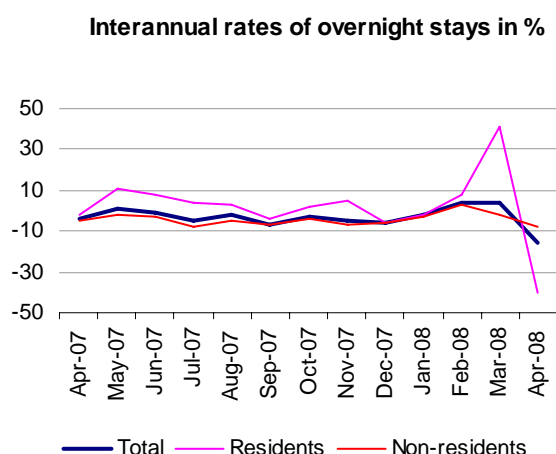

**Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 16.1% in April**

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.8 million in April, representing a 16.1% interannual decrease. Resident overnight stays decreased by 39.9%, while non-resident overnight stays decreased by 7.9%. This was due, at least in part, to the Easter effect. On analysis of the **March-April aggregated period** there was a 6.0% decrease in overnight stays, as compared with the same period in 2007.

Available holiday dwellings decreased 5.9%, reaching 402,772 bedplaces. In April, 31.8% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 10.6% less than in the same month of the previous year. On the other hand, 48.8% out of the total number of available holiday dwellings were occupied for a decrease of 3.8%.



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 81.6% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with over 1.2 million overnight stays, 2.5% less than in April of last year. The next country of origin was Germany, with over 661,600 overnight stays and an interannual rate of -17.7%.

**In the aggregated March to April 2008 period**, these two countries were also the main countries of origin and in the same order, with interannual rates of evolution of -2.1% and -14.2%, respectively.

**Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination**, with more than 2.5 million overnight stays, 11.4% less than in April 2007. Andalucía was the second destination of choice, with 374,891 overnight stays, for a decrease of 15.5%. **In March and April taken as a whole**, Canarias continued to be the Autonomous Community with the highest number of overnight stays, ahead of Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía. The interannual rates for these Communities were: -6.3%, -2.0% and 0.6%, respectively.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the preferred destinations in April. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana.

**Comunidad de Madrid presented the highest occupancy rate in April**, with 73.6% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Canarias (59.0%) and Illes Balears (47.6%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with approximately 860,000 overnight stays in April, whereas the island of Tenerife reached the highest occupancy, with 66.3%.

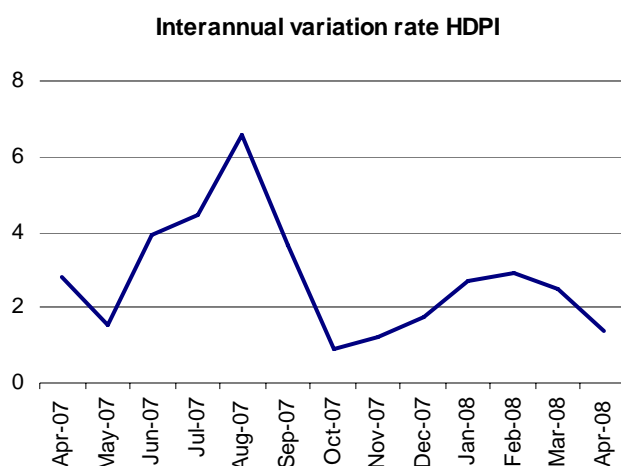
The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Arona.

## Prices for holiday dwellings increase 1.4% in March

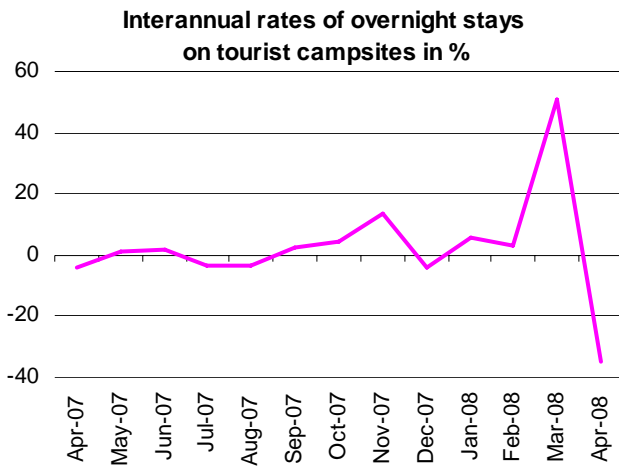
The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 1.4% increase in April, a rate 1.1 points lower than that for the previous month.

The *tour-operator and travel agency rate*, which carried the greatest weighting in the weight structure for this month (56.3%), registered a 0.4% interannual rate increase.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 65.8%, increased their prices 1.4%, registered no change as compared with April 2007.



**Overnight stays on tourist campsites decrease 34.7%**



Overnight stays on tourist campsites exceeded 1.3 million in April, representing an interannual decrease of 34.7%. Overnight stays by resident travellers dropped 52.9%, while those by non-resident travellers rose 3.0%. During the **March-April period**, overnight stays decreased 5.5%.

Tourist campsites offered 529,431 bedplaces, 3.8% less than in the same month of 2007. 30.2% of the available lots were occupied, for a 5.6% decrease in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 31.6%, that is, 11.8% less than in April 2007.

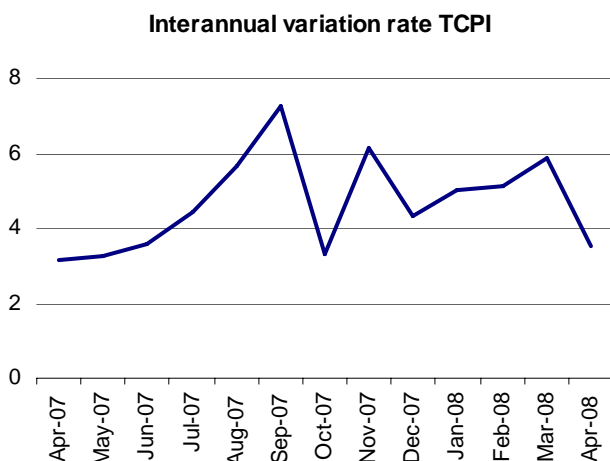
51.4% of overnight stays in tourist campsites were by non-residents. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with 33.8% of overnight stays by non-residents (13.4% more). The following countries of origin were Holland and Germany.

**Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping**, with 515,176 overnight stays, 36% less than in April 2007. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with more than 350,000 overnight stays, indicating a decrease of 17.2%. **During the March-April period**, these two Autonomous Communities maintained the same order of preference, with interannual evolution rates of -9.5% and 4.7%. Among non-residents, the preferred destinations were Comunitat Valenciana, Cataluña and Andalucía. On the other hand, Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía were the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers.

In April, **La Rioja registered the highest occupancy rate on campsites**, with 59.1% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (49.9%) and Comunidad de Madrid (46.9%). **During the March-April period**, these three Autonomous Communities also reached the highest occupancy rates.

By **tourist area**, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping in April, with more than 224,000 overnight stays. Costa Blanca recorded the highest occupancy rate (57.3%). The **tourist sites** with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Blanes and Castelló d'Empúries.

**Prices of tourist campsites increase 3.5%**



The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual growth increase of 3.5% in April. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure this month (65.8%), presented a 3.0% rise.

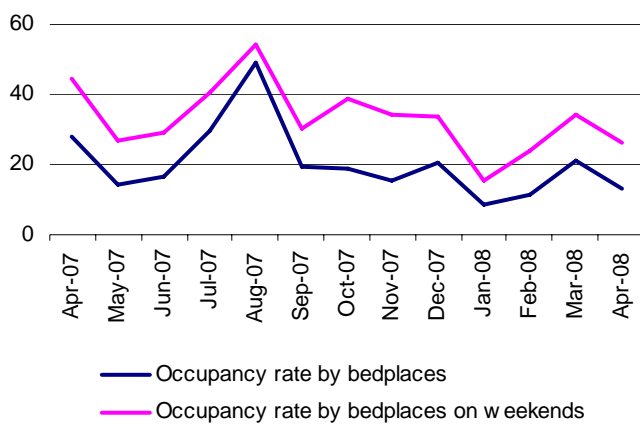
Regarding categories, second class, with a 62.2% weighting in April, registered an interannual increase of 3.8%.

**Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation decrease 55.8% in April as compared with the same month of the previous year**

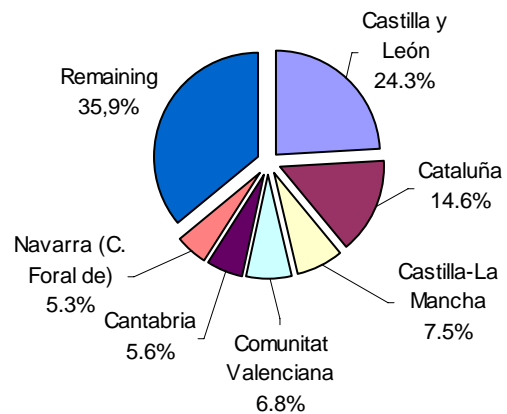
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation surpassed 447,750 in April, with an interannual decrease of 50.2%. Overnight stays by residents decreased 55.8%, and those of non-residents fell 10.0%. **During the March-April period**, overnight stays decreased 9.7%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 115,223 bedplaces, 8.3% more than in April 2007. Of these bedplaces, 12.9% were occupied, representing a 53.8% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 15.6%, that is, 49.2% less. During the March-April period, 17.1% of the bedplaces were occupied, 18.6% less than in 2007. The weekend occupancy rate was 30.3%, that is, 16.7% less than the rate reached the previous year.

**Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation**, with 88,616 overnight stays, 53.4% less than in April 2007. It was followed by Cataluña, with approximately 53,900 overnight stays, 44.6% less. **During the March-April period**, the number of overnight stays in these two Autonomous Communities fell 14.0% and 1.3%, respectively.

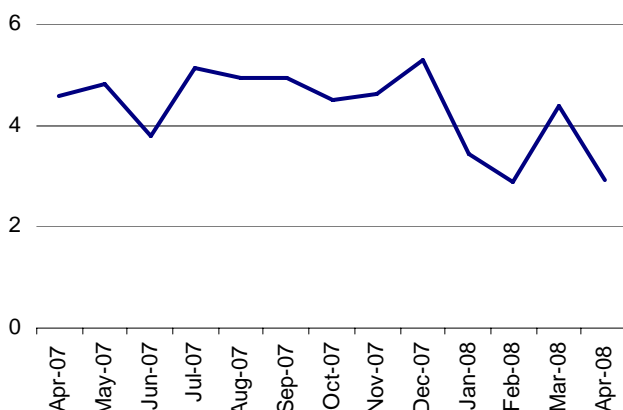
Among non-residents, the preferred destinations were Illes Balears, Canarias and Andalucía. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation in April, with 37.0% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by Canarias (23.0%) and La Rioja (19.7%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with nearly 32,550 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 43.1%.

**Prices in rural tourism accommodation increase 2.9%**

**Interannual variation rate RTAPI**



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index registered interannual growth of 2.9% in April. The normal rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure this month (56.3%), rose 2.8%.

By rent modality, complete use, with a weighting of 68.0%, recorded an interannual increase of 2.2%.

**Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation**

**Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodations** (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) **registered a 15.0% interannual decrease in April**. Resident overnight stays increased 27.61%, and non-resident overnight stays increased 3.3%. **In the March-April period**, the number of overnight stays decreased 3.0%.

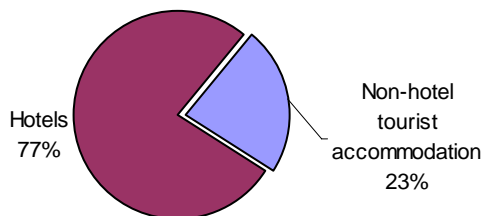
**The average stay decreased 1.6%**, and stood at 3.2 overnight stays per traveller.

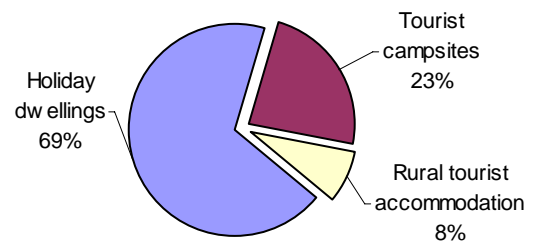

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in April, 77% were accounted for at hotels, and 23% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany with 28.2% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays, United Kingdom with 25.5%, and France with 7.9%.

**Canarias** was **the preferred destination** regarding overall Spanish tourist accommodation, with more than 6.4 million overnight stays, 5.2% less than in April 2007. It was followed by Andalucía, with over 4.1 million overnight stays (15.3% more) and Cataluña, with more than 3.6 million overnight stays (21.1% less).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Andalucía and Cataluña. On the other hand, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
