Non-hotel tourist accommodation occupancy survey
April 2010. Provisional data

Overnight stays in Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation register a decrease of 9.1%* in April as compared with the same month of 2009

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 5.9 million in April, 9.1% less than in the same month the previous year. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 8.5%, and those made by travellers not resident in Spain decreased 9.5%. **During the first four months of 2010, overnight stays decreased 3.8%** as compared with the same period the previous year.

On analysis of the **March-April** aggregate period, given that this year, Easter Week was celebrated between the months of March and April, and that in 2009, it took place in the middle of April, a 3.3% decrease in overnight stays was recorded, as compared with the same period in 2009. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 0.2%, and those by non-residents decreased 4.9%.

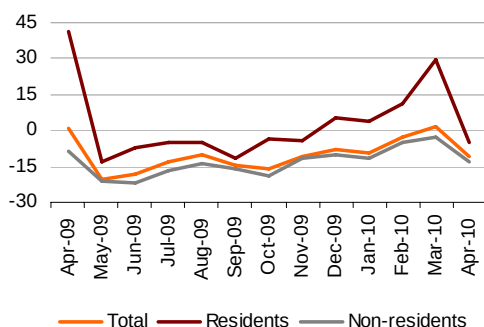

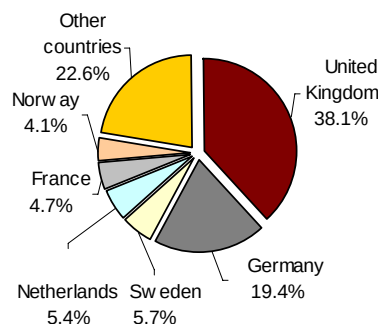
Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.4 million in April, representing an 11.3% decrease as compared with the same month the previous year. Overnight stays of residents experienced a decrease of 5.4%, and those of non-residents, 13.3%. On analysis of the March-April aggregate period, there was a 4.8% decrease in overnight stays, as compared with the same period of 2009; overnight stays by residents increased 6.4%, while those of non-residents decreased 7.5%.

* Due to the update made in the directory of rural tourism accommodation in Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) cannot be directly compared to those published last year. To bridge this gap in the series, linking coefficients have been created to allow users to compare data from different years. The coefficients will be published monthly on the INE website in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

Available holiday dwellings decreased 0.2%, reaching 413,332 bedplaces. This month, 27.9% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 11.0% less than in April 2009. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 32.6%, with a decrease of 6.2%. In turn, 41.7% of the total available holiday dwellings were occupied, for an interannual decrease of 6.6%. In the March-April period, 30.8% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 5.4% less than in the same period of 2009.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 72.1% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 953,000 overnight stays, 6.4% less than in April the previous year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 485,259 overnight stays, 22.6% less.

On analysis of the March-April 2010 aggregate period, those two countries were the main countries of origin, and in the same order, with an interannual rates of -4.2% and -10.5%, respectively.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 1.9 million overnight stays, 12.7% less than in April 2009. The second destination of choice was Andalucía, with 431,543 overnight stays, 5.3% more. In March and April taken as a whole, Canarias was also the Autonomous Community with the highest number of overnight stays, 5.9% less than in the same two-month period of 2009.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the preferred destinations. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía.

Comunidad de Madrid showed the highest occupancy rate in April, with 59.8% of available holiday dwellings. It was followed by País Vasco (54.6%) and Canarias (49.7%).

By tourist area, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with 712,469 overnight stays. The island of Lanzarote reached the greatest occupancy (53.0%).

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

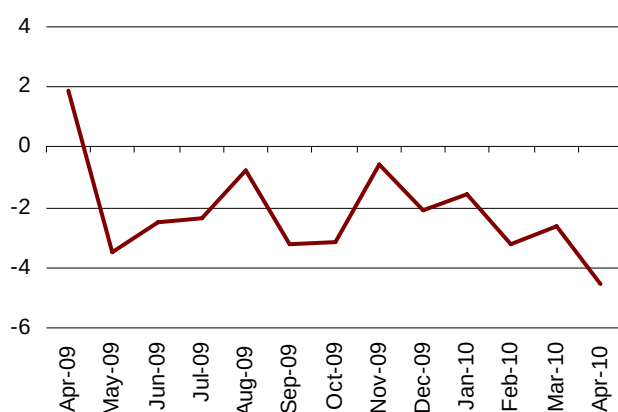
Holiday Dwelling Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 4.6% decrease in April, a rate 1.9 points lower than that recorded the previous month.

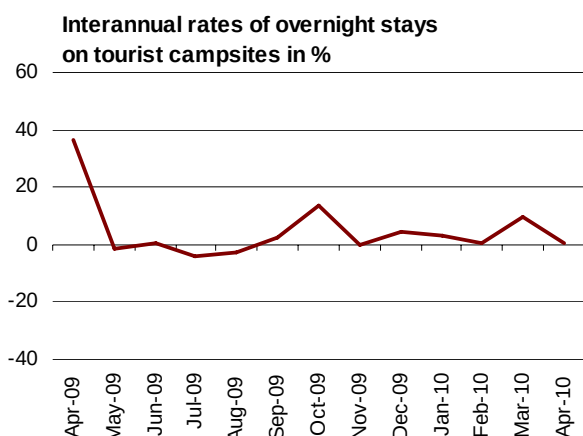
The rate for *tour-operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (60.6%), decreased 6.6% in the interannual rate.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 67.6%, decreased their prices 5.1%.

Holiday Campsites



Tourist campsites exceeded 1.8 million overnight stays in April, representing an interannual increase of 0.6%. Overnight stays of resident travellers decreased 5.0%, while those of non-resident travellers increased 10.8%. In the March-April period, overnight stays increased 3.8%.

Tourist campsites offered 549,573 bedplaces, 0.1% more than in the same month of 2009. 29.6% of the available lots were occupied, 3.0% less. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 32.5%, that is, 0.8% less than in April 2009.

In March and April taken as a whole, 31.2% of the available lots were occupied, 1.4% less than in the same period of 2009.

In April, 39.1% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 33.8% of overnight stays by non-residents (19.4% more). The following country of origin was Germany.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with 671,330 overnight stays, for a 2.3% increase in the interannual rate. Comunitat Valenciana was the second choice of destination, with 453,241 overnight stays, indicating an increase of 14.7%. In the March-April period, Comunitat Valenciana was the most preferred destination, followed by Cataluña.

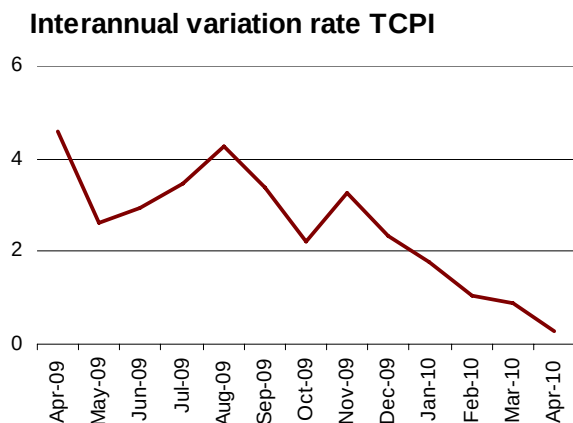
The preferred destinations for resident travellers were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía, whereas for non-residents, these were Comunitat Valenciana, Cataluña and Andalucía.

La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate in tourist campsites in April, with 63.4% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (47.8%) and Comunidad de Madrid (46.8%). In the March-April period, these three Communities also reached the highest occupancy rates, with 63.9%, 50.9% and 45.6%, respectively.

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 234,649 overnight stays. Costa Blanca reached the highest occupancy (53.4%).

The tourist destinations with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Castelló d'Empúries and Blanes.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced interannual growth of 0.3% in April. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for April (60.4%), presented a decrease of 2.5%.

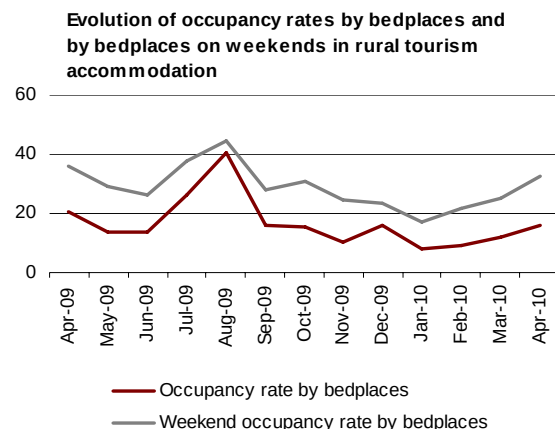
Regarding category, *luxury and first class*, with a weighting of 49.2% this month, registered an interannual decrease of 1.0%.

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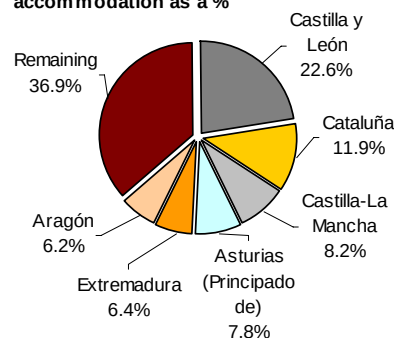
Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 648,886 in April, indicating an interannual decrease of 19.9%*. Resident overnight stays decreased 19.1%, and non-resident overnight stays decreased 25.2%. In the March-April period, overnight stays decreased 10.1% in the interannual rate.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 133,602 bedplaces, 4.2% more than in April 2009. 16.1% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 23.0% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 32.5%, that is, 9.1% less in the interannual rate. During the March-April period, 14.2% of the available bedplaces were occupied, 13.8% less than in 2009.



Distribution of overnight stays of travellers resident in Spain in rural tourism accommodation as a %



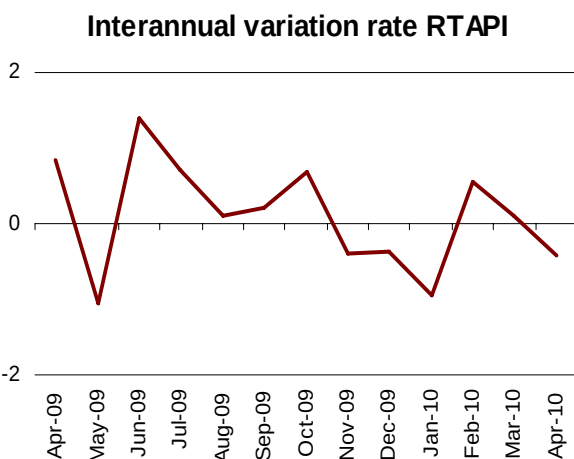
Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 134,255 overnight stays, 20.0% less than in April 2009. It was followed by Cataluña, with 69,283 overnight stays, 25.9% less. In the March-April period, the interannual rates of overnights stays in those Communities were -7.6% and -15.3%, respectively.

Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination in April. In turn, the destinations with most overnight stays by resident travellers were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Castilla-La Mancha.

Comunidad Foral de Navarra reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 28.1% of available bedplaces. It was followed by Illes Balears (26.6%) and País Vasco (23.2%).

By tourist area, Pirineo Catalán was the main destination, with 31,880 overnight stays in April. The Coast of Guipuzcoa reached the highest occupancy (30.7%).

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual decrease of 0.4% in April.

The *weekend* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (62.2%), fell 1.0%. By rent modality, *complete use*, with a weighting of 67.5%, recorded an interannual decrease of 0.3% in April.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

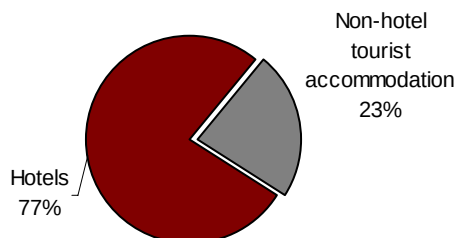
Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an interannual decrease of 1.5%* in April. Overnight stays by residents decreased 0.5%, and non-resident stays decreased 2.4%. In the March-April aggregated period, there was an increase of 2.1%, as compared with the same period of 2009. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 4.2%, and those by non-residents increased 0.4%.

The average stay decreased 3.4% in April, standing at 3.2 nights per traveller. Travellers and overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation were:

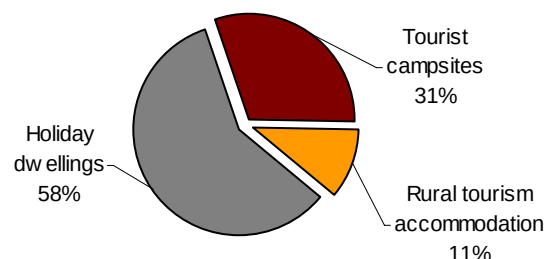

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in April, 77% were accounted for at hotels and 23% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were Germany (with 23.8% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), the United Kingdom (23.8%) and France (9.4%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 5.7 million overnight stays (5.7% less than in April 2009). It was followed by Cataluña, with more than 4.5 million overnight stays (5.2% more), and Andalucía, with more than 4.2 million overnight stays (1.0% less).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
