

Encuestas de ocupación en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros
Abril 2016. *Datos provisionales*

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros¹ descienden un 5,3% en abril respecto al mismo mes de 2015

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros (apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) superan los 6,9 millones en abril, un 5,3% menos que en el mismo mes de 2015. Las pernoctaciones de residentes descienden un 26,6%, mientras que las de no residentes aumentan un 9,5%. La estancia media es de 4,5 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Durante el primer cuatrimestre de 2016, las pernoctaciones aumentan un 11,0% respecto al mismo periodo del año anterior.

Dado que en 2016 la Semana Santa se celebró en marzo y en 2015 entre marzo y abril, es conveniente analizar el **periodo agregado marzo-abril**. En él se observa un aumento de las pernoctaciones del 11,8% respecto al mismo bimestre de 2015. Las de residentes suben un 13,6% y las de no residentes un 10,9%.


Apartamentos turísticos

Las pernoctaciones en apartamentos turísticos aumentan un 3,4% en abril. Las de residentes bajan un 15,1%, mientras que las de no residentes se incrementan un 9,2%. En el periodo **marzo-abril** las pernoctaciones suben un 10,8% respecto al mismo periodo de 2015. Las de residentes aumentan un 13,1% y las de no residentes un 10,2%.

En abril se ocupan el 33,2% de las plazas ofertadas por los apartamentos turísticos, un 3,2% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. El grado de ocupación por plazas en fin de semana se sitúa en el 36,4%, con un descenso del 1,2%.



Las pernoctaciones de no residentes en apartamentos turísticos representan el 80,4% del total, Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con más de 1,2 millones de pernoctaciones, un 9,5% más que en abril de 2015. El siguiente mercado emisor es Alemania, con 521.524 pernoctaciones, un 2,4% más.

Canarias es el destino preferido en apartamentos, con más de 2,3 millones de pernoctaciones, un 9,8% más que en abril de 2015. Esta comunidad también alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 72,0% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Por zonas turísticas, la isla de Tenerife es el destino preferido, con 851.063 pernoctaciones. La isla de Lanzarote alcanza la mayor ocupación, del 79,1% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Los puntos turísticos con mayor número de pernoctaciones en abril son San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona y Tías.

Campings


Las pernoctaciones en campings registran en abril un descenso anual del 17,5% respecto al mismo mes del año anterior. Las de residentes bajan un 36,3%, mientras que las de no

residentes suben un 9,9%. En el periodo **marzo-abril** las pernoctaciones se incrementan un 13,9%.

Durante el mes de abril se ocupan el 30,4% de las parcelas ofertadas, un 3,9% menos. El grado de ocupación por parcelas en fin de semana alcanza el 32,2%, con un descenso anual del 6,2%.

El 54,1% de las pernoctaciones en campings las realizan viajeros no residentes. Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con el 27,9% de las pernoctaciones de no residentes, un 14,8% más que en abril de 2015.

Cataluña es el destino preferido en campings, con 715.608 pernoctaciones, un 19,9% menos que en abril de 2015. La Rioja alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, el 59,3% de las parcelas ofertadas.


Por zonas turísticas, la Costa Daurada es el destino preferido, con 251.738 pernoctaciones. La Costa Blanca alcanza la mayor ocupación, del 63,3% de las parcelas ofertadas.

Los puntos turísticos con más pernoctaciones son Benidorm, Cambrils y Mont-Roig Del Camp.

Alojamientos de turismo rural


Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos de turismo rural presentan un descenso anual del 19,8% en abril. Las de residentes bajan un 29,5%, mientras que las de no residentes suben un 17,1%. En el periodo **marzo-abril** las pernoctaciones se incrementan un 15,8%.

En los alojamientos de turismo rural se ocupan el 12,9% de las plazas, con un descenso del 22,0% respecto a abril de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana se sitúa en el 24,9%, con una bajada del 27,7%.



Por comunidades, Castilla y León es el destino preferido, con 108.555 pernoctaciones, un 24,4% menos que en abril de 2015. Illes Balears alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 42,9% de las plazas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, la isla de Mallorca es el principal destino, con 63.750 pernoctaciones y una ocupación del 45,0% de las plazas ofertadas.



Albergues

Las pernoctaciones en albergues registran en abril un descenso anual del 5,2%. Las de residentes bajan un 8,9%, mientras que las de no residentes suben un 2,4%. En el periodo **marzo-abril** las pernoctaciones crecen un 3,5%.

En abril se ocupan el 25,8% de las plazas, un 3,6% menos que en el mismo mes de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana alcanza el 32,3%, con un descenso del 14,2%.

Por comunidades, Cataluña es el destino preferido, con 82.626 pernoctaciones, un 5,4% más que en abril de 2015. Comunidad de Madrid alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 42,7% de las plazas ofertadas.


Índices de precios

El Índice de Precios de Apartamentos Turísticos (IPAP) aumenta un 3,6% respecto a abril de 2015. La tarifa *tour-operadores y agencias de viajes*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones este mes (49,5%), sube un 4,0%.

El Índice de Precios de Campings (IPAC) desciende un 1,8% en tasa anual. La tarifa *Bungalow*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones en abril (38,4%), baja un 2,4% respecto al mismo mes de 2015.

El Índice de Precios de Alojamientos de Turismo Rural (IPTR) registra un aumento del 1,8% en abril. La tarifa *fin de semana*, que supone el 61,4% del peso total, sube un 1,8% en tasa anual.

Evolución de los viajeros y las pernoctaciones en todos los alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles


Las pernoctaciones en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles (hoteles², apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) descienden un 0,3% en abril en tasa anual. Las de residentes bajan un 16,5%, mientras que las de no residentes suben un 11,0%. En el periodo **marzo-abril** las pernoctaciones crecen un 9,4%.

La estancia media sube un 0,6%, situándose en 3,3 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Del total de pernoctaciones realizadas en alojamientos turísticos colectivos, un 77% corresponde a hoteles y un 23% a alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros.



Los principales mercados emisores en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos reglados son el británico (con el 26,1% del total de pernoctaciones de no residentes), el alemán (20,1%) y el francés (11,6%).

Canarias es el destino preferido, con 7,7 millones de pernoctaciones (un 10,6% más que en abril de 2015). Le siguen Andalucía, con más de 5,1 millones (y un aumento anual del 3,3%) y Cataluña, con 5,0 millones (y un descenso del 5,9%).
