**Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey**  
April 2021 Provisional Data

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation exceeded 2.7 million in April**

**During the first four months of 2021, overnight stays decreased by 46.7% as compared to the same period of the previous year.**

Non-hotel establishments were closed to tourist activity in April 2020, meaning that there was no entry of travellers or overnight stays during that month.

It is thus impossible to calculate variation rates for April 2021 in relation to the same month of the previous year for data related to the non-hotel occupancy surveys.

In the case of non-hotel price indexes (IPAP, IPAC and IPTR), rates are published compared to April 2020, since prices remained invariant in that month.

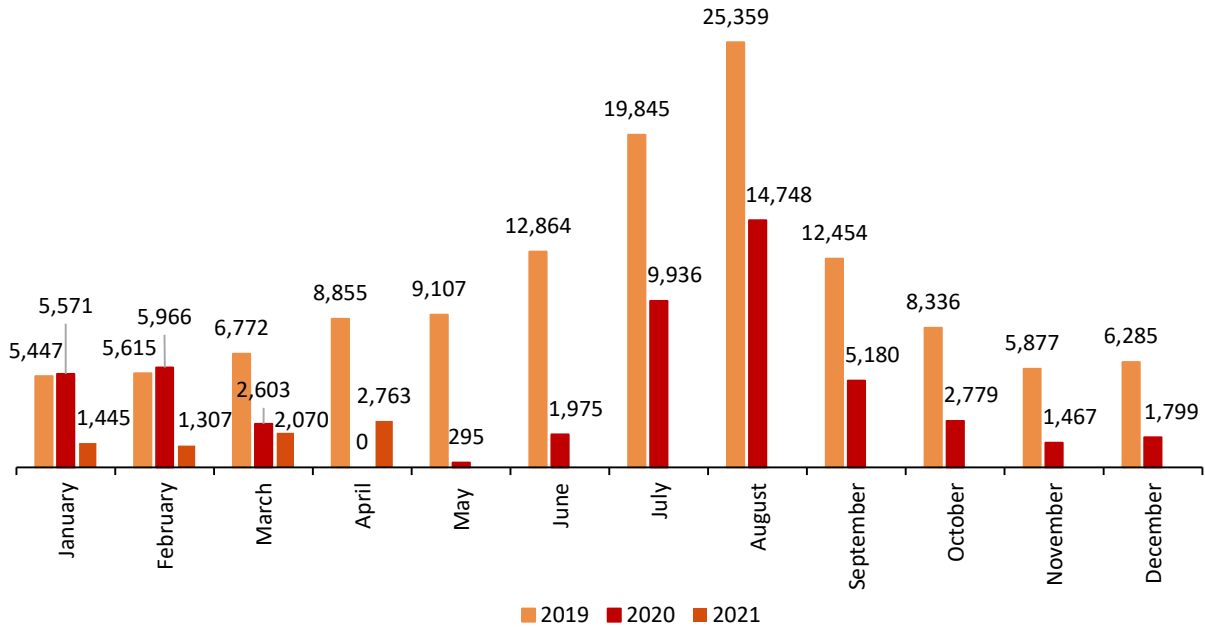
**Overnight stays**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (apartments, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 2.7 million in April.

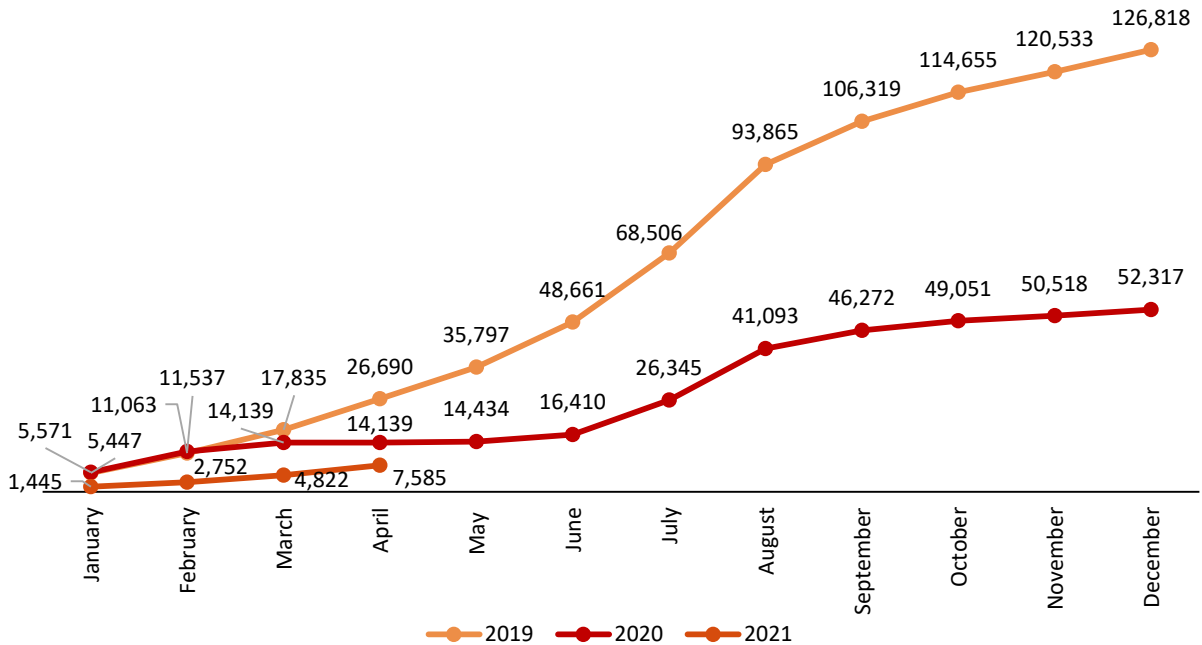
By traveller origin, overnight stays by residents of Spain, which represent 73.1% of the total, rose to 2.0 million. For their part, those of non-residents reached 743.1 thousand and represent 26.9% of the total.

During the first four months of 2021, overnight stays decreased by 46.7% as compared to the same period of the previous year.

## Open establishments

In April, a total of 95,559 non-hotel accommodations were open in Spain, which represented 59.3% of the total directory of establishments in this month.

## Holiday Dwellings

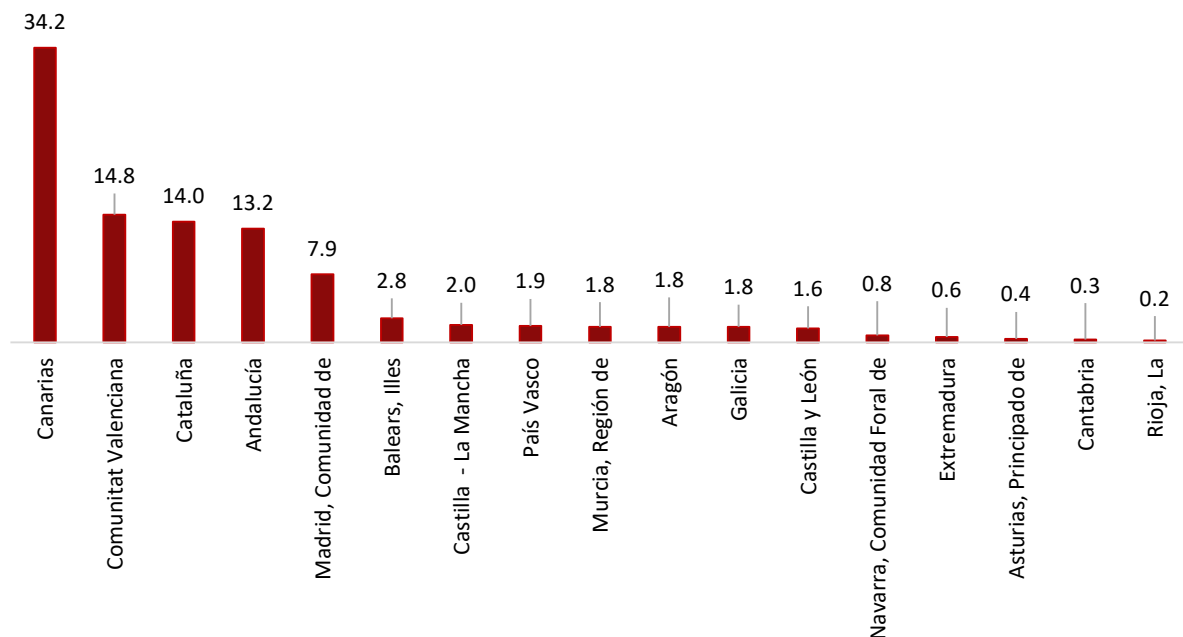
Overnight stays in tourist apartments reached 1.0 million in April. Of the total overnight stays, 64.3% corresponded to residents, and 35.7% to non-residents.

During the first three four of 2021, the total of overnight stays fell by 65.2% compared to the same period of the previous year.

By communities, Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the main destinations for travellers, with 341,962, 148,155 and 139,782 overnight stays in April, respectively.

By tourist areas, the island of Tenerife was the preferred tourist apartment destination, with 157,621 overnight stays. Costa de Barcelona was the area with the highest occupancy rate, with 74.4% of the apartments offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in April were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Madrid and Adeje.

## **Tourist Campsites**

Overnight stays at campsites amounted to 1.3 million in April. Of the total overnight stays, 76.4% corresponded to residents, and 23.6% to non-residents.

During the first four months of 2021, the total of overnight stays in this type of accommodation rose by 1.6% compared to the same period of 2020.

In April, 30.7% of available pitches were occupied, and the weekend occupancy rate reached 33.5%.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with 501,618 overnight stays. Comunidad de Madrid achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 55.5% of pitches offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination in April, with 220,296 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 57.2% of the campsites offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Mont-Roig Del Camp and Tarragona.

## **Rural tourism accommodation**

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation came to 329,563 in April. Of the total overnight stays, 85.5% corresponded to residents, and 14.5% to non-residents.

During the first three four of 2021, the number of overnight stays fell by 21.1% compared to the same period of the previous year.

In rural tourism accommodation, 8.6% of the bedplaces were occupied in April. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 15.5%.

By autonomous communities, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 46,648 overnight stays. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 22.5% of the bed-places offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 28,233 overnight stays. In Isla de Menorca, the highest occupancy rate was reached, with 23.6% of the bed-places offered.

## **Hostels**

In April, a total of 55,243 overnight stays in hostels<sup>1</sup> were registered. Of this total, 76.6% corresponded to residents and 23.4% to non-residents.

<sup>1</sup> Since January 2021, tourist hostels have been included in the survey, in addition to those belonging to the Spanish Youth Hostels Network. The data published are not comparable with those of April 2020, so [link coefficients](#) are thus published to allow the annual variation rates to be calculated.

During the first three four of 2021, the total of overnight stays fell by 65.1% compared to the same period of the previous year.

In April, 5.1% of bed-places were occupied. The weekend occupancy rate reached 6.1%.

By communities, Pirineus was the main destination, with 14,622 overnight stays. In April, Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 26.1% of the bed-places offered.

## Price indices

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 5.2% in April compared to the same month of 2020 and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) decreased by 0.4%.

On the other hand, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) decreased by 0.7%.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In March, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodations (hotels<sup>2</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) increased to 6.8 million in April. Resident overnight stays accounted for 70.6% and non-resident overnight stays for 29.4%.

During the first four months of 2021, overnight stays in the totality of Spanish collective tourist accommodations decreased by 64.5% compared to the same period of the previous year.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in April, 59.5% corresponded to hotels, and 40.5% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all regulated tourist accommodations were Germany (with 23.1% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), France (12.4%), and the United Kingdom (10.1%).

Cataluña was the preferred destination, with more than 1.3 million overnight stays This was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (with 980.4 thousand) and Andalucía (with 980.2 thousand).

## Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for April 2020 of the Occupancy Survey in: Holiday Dwellings (HDOS), Campsites (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodation (RTAOS) and Hostels (HOS). As well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

## Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

**Type of sampling:** stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** camping establishments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

**Sample size:** approximately 1200 establishments.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that entrepreneurs of this type of accommodation apply to their clients.

**Population scope:** rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
