Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
April 2022. Provisional data

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations reached 9.3 million, compared to 2.7 million in the same month of 2021

So far this year, the number of overnight stays at campgrounds, rural tourism establishments and hostels is above 2019 records

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) exceeded 9.3 million in April, compared to 2.7 million for same month of 2021; this supposed an increase of 238.7%. Overnight stays by residents increased by 132.7%, and those by non-resident by 526.0%.

The average stay stood at 3.6 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first four months of 2022, overnight stays increased 234.4%, as compared to the same period of the previous year.


Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased by 349.1% in April. Resident overnight stays grew by 134.1%, and those of non-residents by 736.9%.

The average stay decreased 4.9% as compared with April 2021, standing at 4.6 overnight stays per traveller.


In April, 32.4% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 208.4% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 35.4%, with an increase of 160.8%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 66.5% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with over a million. The following country of origin was Germany, with 392,889.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 1.9 million overnight stays, 473.6% more than in April 2021. The autonomous community with the highest occupancy was Comunidad de Madrid, with 59.2% of apartments offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Tenerife was the preferred destination, with 613,973 overnight stays. Costa de Barcelona had the highest occupancy rate, with 86.6% of the apartments offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in April were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

Campgrounds


Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 130.4% in April as compared to the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays grew by 95.7% and non-resident overnight stays by 242.3%.

During April, 37.6% of the pitches offered were occupied, 25.5% more than in the same month of 2021. The weekend occupancy rate reached 39.4%, with a 19.3% annual increase.

Non-residents accounted for 35.2% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. Germany was the main country of origin, with 25.8% of overnight stays by non-residents, 242.8% more than in April of 2021.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with more than 1.3 million overnight stays, representing an increase of 162.9% in the annual rate. La Rioja achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 59.3% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, Costa Daurada was the preferred destination for camping, with 594,924 overnight stays. Costa Blanca had the highest occupancy rate, with 70.1% of apartments offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Mont-Roig Del Camp and Tarragona.



Rural tourism accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 225.2% in April. Resident overnight stays grew by 197.3%, and those of non-residents by 392.8%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay³



In rural tourism accommodation, 21.9% of the bedplaces were occupied, 155.4% more than in April 2021. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 34.9%, with an annual increase of 126.4%.

Percentage





By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 185,357 overnight stays, 316.6% more than in April 2021. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 50.8% of the bed-places offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 98,093 overnight stays. In Isla de Menorca, the highest occupancy rate was reached, with 53.3% of the bed-places offered.

Percentage




Hostels

In April, there were 592,617 overnight stays in hostels, which represents an annual increase of 972.5%. Resident overnight stays increased by 587.0% and non-resident overnight stays by 2,293.1%.

Annual variation rate for overnight stay⁴



A total of 30.1% of the bed-places were occupied, 474.2% more than in April 2021. The weekend occupancy rate reached 34.0%, with a 424.8% increase.

Percentage




Comunidad de Madrid was the main destination, with 89,152 overnight stays. This Autonomous Community also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 71.4% of the bed-places offered.

Price indices⁵

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 13.8% in April compared to the same month of 2021 and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) decreased by 8.8%. On the other hand, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) decreased by 0.5%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In April, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels⁶, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 399.5% increase in the annual rate. Resident overnight stays grew by 207.0%, and those of non-residents by 856.8%.

The average stay grew by 17.2%, to 3.1 overnight stays per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 72.8% corresponded to hotels, and 27.2% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all types of regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 24.7% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (18.5%) and France (9.6%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with over 7.3 million overnight stays (648.1% more than in April 2021). It was followed by Cataluña, with over 5.9 million overnight stays (and an increase of 344.6%) and Andalucía, with over 5.6 million, (and an annual increase of 562.0%).

Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for April 2021 of the Occupancy Survey in: Tourist Apartments (HDOS), Campgrounds (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodations (RTAOS), and Hostels (HOS), as well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

Type of sampling: stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

Type of operation: monthly continuous survey.

Population scope: camping establishments.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period of the information: seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

Sample size: approximately 1200 establishments.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

Reference period of the results: the month.

Reference period for the information: The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

Type of sampling: comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

Collection method: questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
