Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey May 2008. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in collective non-hotel accommodation increase 6.3% in May, as compared to the same month in 2007

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) surpassed 7.3 million in May, 6.3% more than in the same month of the previous year. The increase in overnight stays was recorded both among residents, which grew 17.0%, and among non-residents, with an interannual rate of 1.7%.

The average stay was reduced 2.4%, as compared with May 2007, standing at 5.3 nights per traveller.

During the first five months of the year, overnight stays decreased 0.7% as compared with the same period of the previous year. Those stays by resident travellers decreased 0.9%, while those by non-residents reached a rate of -0.6%.



Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increase 4.3% in May


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 4.9 million in May, indicating an increase of 4.3% as compared with the same month the previous year. The increase in overnight stays was recorded for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at 17.8%, and non-residents, with 1.2%.

Available holiday dwellings increased 0.6%, surpassing 484,700 bedplaces. In May, 32.5% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 3.3% more than in May 2007. On the other hand, 45.8% of the total number of available holiday dwellings were occupied, for an increase of 2.8%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 78.7% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with over 1.6 million overnight stays, 8.5% less than in May of last year.

The following market was Germany, with nearly 792,000 overnight stays and an interannual rate of 4.7%.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling **destination**, with more than 2.1 million overnight stays, 1.5% more than in May 2007. Illes Balears was the second destination of choice, with more than 1.1 million overnight stays, 1.0% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Andalucía were the preferred destinations. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana.

Comunidad de Madrid presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with 72.6% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Andalucía (51.4%) and Canarias (49.6%).

By **tourist area**, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with more than 794,700 overnight stays in May, whereas Costa del Sol reached the highest occupancy, with 65.6%.


The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Arona.

Prices for holiday dwellings increase 2.9% in May


The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 2.9% increase in May, a rate 1.5 points higher than that for the previous month.

The *tour-operator and travel agency rate*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (52.1%), registered a 3.5% interannual rate increase.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 63.3%, increased their prices 2.2% as compared with May 2007.



Overnight stays on tourist campsites increase 5.6%



Overnight stays on tourist campsites exceeded 1.8 million in May, representing an interannual increase of 5.6%. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 8.1%, and those by non-resident travellers increased 3.2%.

Tourist campsites offered more than 596,100 bedplaces, 0.4% more than in the same month of 2007. 30.4% of the available lots were occupied, for a 0.2% increase in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 34.2%, that is, 4.4% more than in May 2007.

50.8% of overnight stays in tourist campsites were by non-residents. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with 30.1% of overnight stays by non-residents (7.4% more). The following country of origin was The Netherlands.


Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with 867,238 overnight stays, 4.5% less than in May 2007. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with more than 351,600 overnight stays, indicating an increase of 20.4%.

Among non-residents, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía, and they were, in the same order, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers.

In May, **La Rioja registered the highest occupancy rate on campsites**, with 58.5% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (49.6%) and Comunitat Valenciana (47.2%).

By **tourist area**, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping in May, with more than 354,000 overnight stays. Costa del Garraf recorded the highest occupancy rate by lot (59.5%). The **tourist sites** with the most overnight stays were Salou, Benidorm and Castelló d'Empúries.

Prices of tourist campsites increase 3.4%



The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced an interannual growth increase of 3.4% in May. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure this month (64.6%), presented a 2.6% rise.


Regarding categories, second class, with a 56.0% weighting in May, registered an interannual increase of 6.0%.

Overnight stays by residents in rural tourism accommodation increase 35.0% in May as compared with the same month of the previous year


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation surpassed 606,500 in May, with an interannual increase of 27.7%. Overnight stays by residents increased 35.0%, and those of non-residents 5.7%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 117,465 bedplaces, 10.9% more than in May 2007. Of these bedplaces, 16.6% were occupied, representing a 14.9% increase. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 33.5%, that is, 24.5% more.

Distribution of overnight stays of Spanish travellers in %



Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with more than 115,200 overnight stays, 26.3% more than in May 2007. It was followed by Cataluña, with nearly 73,800 overnight stays, 39.6% more.


Among non-residents, the preferred destination was Illes Balears. On the other hand, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Principado de Asturias.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 50.2% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by País Vasco (24.9%) and La Rioja (21.8%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with more than 48,800 overnight stays. In addition, this area reached the highest occupancy rate, 52.6%.

Prices in rural tourism accommodation increase 5.0%

Interannual variation rate RTAPI



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index registered interannual growth of 5.0% in May. The normal rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure this month (58.7%), rose 4.8%.

By rent modality, complete use, with a weighting of 58.9%, recorded an interannual increase of 4.3%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) **registered a 6.5% interannual increase in May**. Resident overnight stays increased 9.0%, and non-resident overnight stays increased 5.2%.


The average stay increased 0.1%, and stood at 3.4 overnight stays per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in May, 77% were accounted for at hotels, and 23% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were The United Kingdom with 30.5% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays, Germany with 27.9%, and France with 6.6%.

Illes Balears was **the preferred destination** regarding overall Spanish tourist accommodation, with more than 6.7 million overnight stays, 4.3% more than in May 2007. It was followed by Canarias, with 5.8 million overnight stays (7.8% more) and Cataluña, with 5.5 million overnight stays (2.8% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Illes Balears, Canarias and Cataluña. On the other hand, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
