

Encuestas de ocupación en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros
Mayo 2016. *Datos provisionales*

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros aumentan un 9,0% en mayo respecto al mismo mes de 2015

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros (apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) superan los 8,7 millones en mayo, un 9,0% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. Las pernoctaciones de residentes aumentan un 2,9% y las de no residentes un 12,2%.

La estancia media es de 4,5 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Durante los cinco primeros meses de 2016 las pernoctaciones aumentan un 10,5% respecto al mismo periodo del año anterior



Apartamentos turísticos


Las pernoctaciones en apartamentos turísticos aumentan un 13,9% en mayo. Las de residentes suben un 14,6% y las de no residentes un 13,8%.

La estancia media sube un 0,1% respecto a mayo de 2015, situándose en 5,4 pernoctaciones por viajero.

En mayo se ocupan el 34,5% de las plazas ofertadas por los apartamentos turísticos, un 11,3% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. El grado de ocupación por plazas en fin de semana se sitúa en el 39,1%, con un incremento del 10,2%.



Las pernoctaciones de no residentes en apartamentos turísticos representan el 79,0% del total, Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con 1,7 millones de pernoctaciones, un 10,3% más que en mayo de 2015. El siguiente mercado emisor es Alemania, con 764.495 pernoctaciones, un 20,9% más.



Canarias es el destino preferido en apartamentos, con más de 2,1 millones de pernoctaciones, un 16,3% más que en mayo de 2015. Comunidad de Madrid alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 74,7% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Por zonas turísticas, la isla de Tenerife es el destino preferido, con 753.027 pernoctaciones. La isla de Lanzarote alcanza la mayor ocupación, del 76,8% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Los puntos turísticos con mayor número de pernoctaciones en mayo son San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona y Tías.


Campings

Las pernoctaciones en campings registran en mayo un incremento anual del 0,2% respecto al mismo mes del año anterior. Las de residentes descienden un 5,6%, mientras que las de no residentes aumentan un 5,6%.

Durante el mes de mayo se ocupan el 32,4% de las parcelas ofertadas, un 0,1% menos. El grado de ocupación por parcelas en fin de semana alcanza el 35,2%, con un descenso anual del 3,0%.

El 54,0% de las pernoctaciones en campings las realizan viajeros no residentes. Países Bajos es el principal mercado emisor, con el 27,9% de las pernoctaciones de no residentes, un 3,5% más que en mayo de 2015.

Cataluña es el destino preferido en campings, con 1,1 millones de pernoctaciones, un 5,0% menos que en mayo de 2015. La Rioja alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, el 57,2% de las parcelas ofertadas.


Por zonas turísticas, la Costa Daurada es el destino preferido, con 428.016 pernoctaciones. Costa Blanca alcanza la mayor ocupación, del 62,6% de las parcelas ofertadas.

Los puntos turísticos con más pernoctaciones son Benidorm, Mont-Roig Del Camp y Salou.

Alojamientos de turismo rural


Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos de turismo rural presentan un aumento anual del 7,2% en mayo. Las de residentes bajan un 1,1%, mientras que las de no residentes aumentan un 26,4%.

En los alojamientos de turismo rural se ocupan el 14,4% de las plazas, con un crecimiento del 4,6% respecto a mayo de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana se sitúa en el 30,5%, con un incremento del 11,2%.



Por comunidades, Illes Balears es el destino preferido, con 117.029 pernoctaciones, un 24,2% más que en mayo de 2015. Esta comunidad también alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 56,3% de las plazas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, Isla de Mallorca es el principal destino, con 99.612 pernoctaciones y una ocupación del 58,2% de las plazas ofertadas.



Albergues

Las pernoctaciones en albergues registran en mayo un aumento anual del 2,0%. Las de residentes suben un 2,3% y las de no residentes un 1,3%.

Se ocupan el 27,8% de las plazas, un 8,4% más que en mayo de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana alcanza el 35,5%, con un aumento del 13,5%.

Por comunidades, Cataluña es el destino preferido, con 96.441 pernoctaciones, un 6,1% más que en mayo de 2015. Cataluña alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 46,5% de las plazas ofertadas.


Índices de precios

El Índice de Precios de Apartamentos Turísticos (IPAP) aumenta un 5,3% respecto a mayo de 2015. La tarifa *tour-operadores y agencias de viajes*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones este mes (47,9%), sube un 7,4%.

El Índice de Precios de Campings (IPAC) desciende un 0,9% en tasa anual. La tarifa *bungalow*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones en mayo (35,9%), sube un 1,0% respecto al mismo mes de 2015.

El Índice de Precios de Alojamientos de Turismo Rural (IPTR) registra un aumento del 2,3% en mayo. La tarifa *fin de semana*, que supone el 66,3% del peso total, sube un 2,3% en tasa anual.

Evolución de los viajeros y las pernoctaciones en todos los alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles

Las pernoctaciones en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles (hoteles¹, apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) aumentan un 9,7% en mayo en tasa anual. Las de residentes suben un 5,3% y las de no residentes un 11,8%.


La estancia media sube un 4,4%, situándose en 3,4 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Del total de pernoctaciones realizadas en alojamientos turísticos colectivos, un 78% corresponde a hoteles y un 22% a alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros.

Los principales mercados emisores en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos reglados son el británico (con el 29,7% del total de pernoctaciones de no residentes), el alemán (23,6%) y el francés (8,6%).

Illes Balears es el destino preferido, con 8,3 millones de pernoctaciones (un 16,6% más que en mayo de 2015). Le siguen Canarias, con más de 7,4 millones (y un aumento anual del 15,1%) y Cataluña, con 6,9 millones (y un incremento del 4,1%).
