**Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey**  
May 2023. Provisional Data

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increased by 7.2%, as compared with the same month of 2022, exceeding those of 2019**

**Cumulative overnight stays since January grew by 10.3% compared to the same period of 2019**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodations (holiday dwellings, tourist camp sites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) reached 10.4 million in May, compared to 9.7 million for the same month of 2022, exceeding those of 2019 as well.

In the annual rate, overnight stays grew by 7.2%. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 3.3%, while those by non-residents increased by 14.6%.

The average stay stood at 3.8 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first five months of 2023, overnight stays increased 13.8%, as compared to the same period of the previous year. Moreover, they surpass those of the first five months of 2019.

### **Holiday Dwellings**

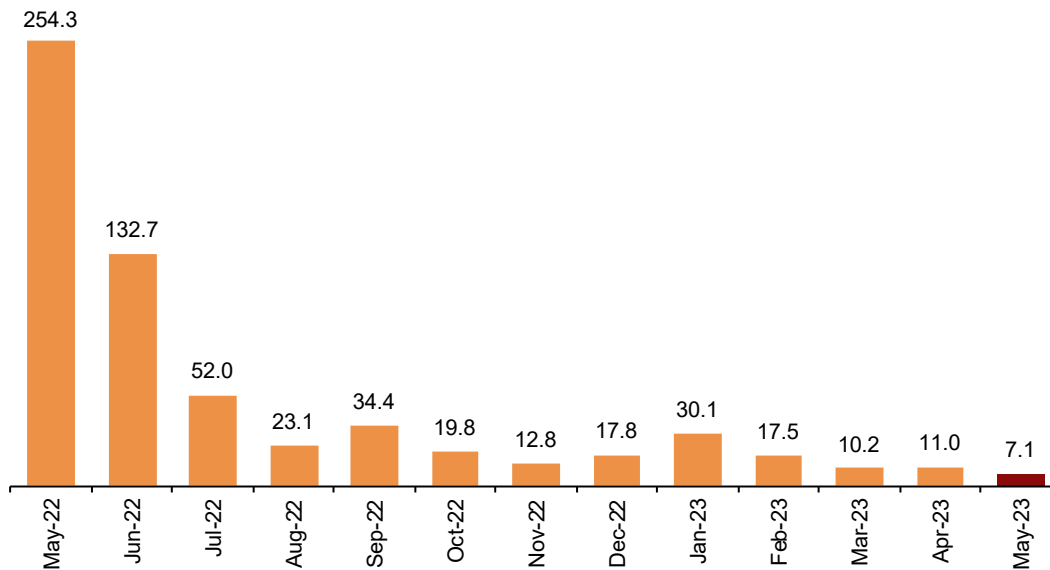
Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased by 7.1% in May, as compared with the same month of 2022. Resident overnight stays increased by 0.8% and non-resident overnight stays by 9.4%.

The average stay increased by 3.1%, standing at 4.8 overnight stays per traveller.

In May, 31.4% of the bed-places available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 3.2% more than in the same month of 2022. The weekend occupancy rate by bed-places stood at 35.6%, with a decrease of 0.2%.

**Annual variation rate for overnight stay**

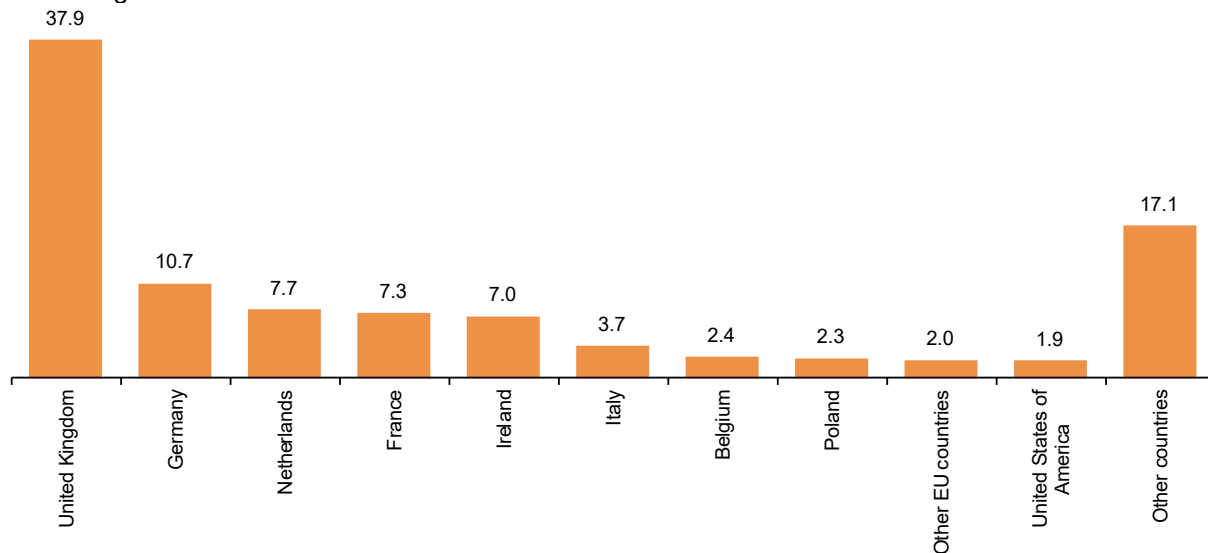

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 74.2% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main market of origin, with 1.5 million overnight stays. The following country of origin was Germany, with 432,123.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 1.6 million overnight stays, and an increase of 1.7% as compared with May 2022. Comunidad de Madrid had the highest occupancy rate, at 73.5% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Blanca was the preferred destination, with 730,859 overnight stays. La Costa de Barcelona had the highest occupancy rate, with 86.1% of the apartments offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays in May were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Arona.

## Campgrounds

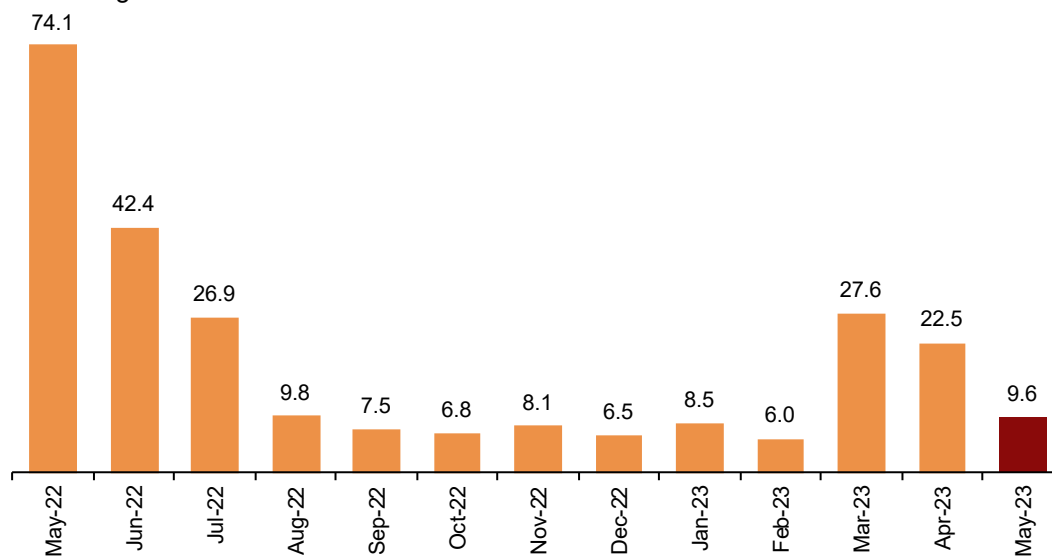
Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an increase of 9.6% in May, as compared with the same month in 2022. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 4.3% while those by non-residents increased by 26.9%.

During May, 36.6% of the pitches offered were occupied, 4.9% more than in the same month of 2022. The weekend occupancy rate reached 38.2%, with a 5.0% annual decrease.

Non-residents accounted for 51.4% of overnight stays at tourist campsites. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 22.6% of overnight stays by non-residents, 28.1% more than in May 2022.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for tourist campsites, with more than 1.5 million overnight stays, representing an increase of 11.8% in the annual rate. Cantabria achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 67.3% of campsites offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Brava was the preferred destination, with 637,578 overnight stays. Costa Blanca (Alicante) had the highest occupancy rate, with 67.2% of the campsites offered.

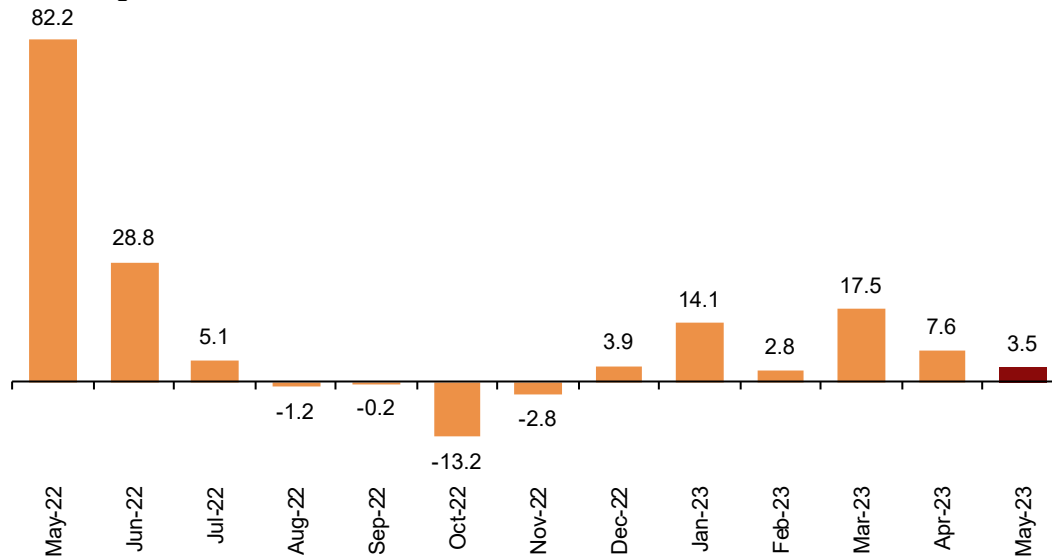
The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Mont-Roig Del Camp and Tarragona.

**Rural tourism accommodation**

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 3.5% in May. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 5.7%, while those by non-residents increased by 21.6%.

**Annual variation rate for overnight stay**

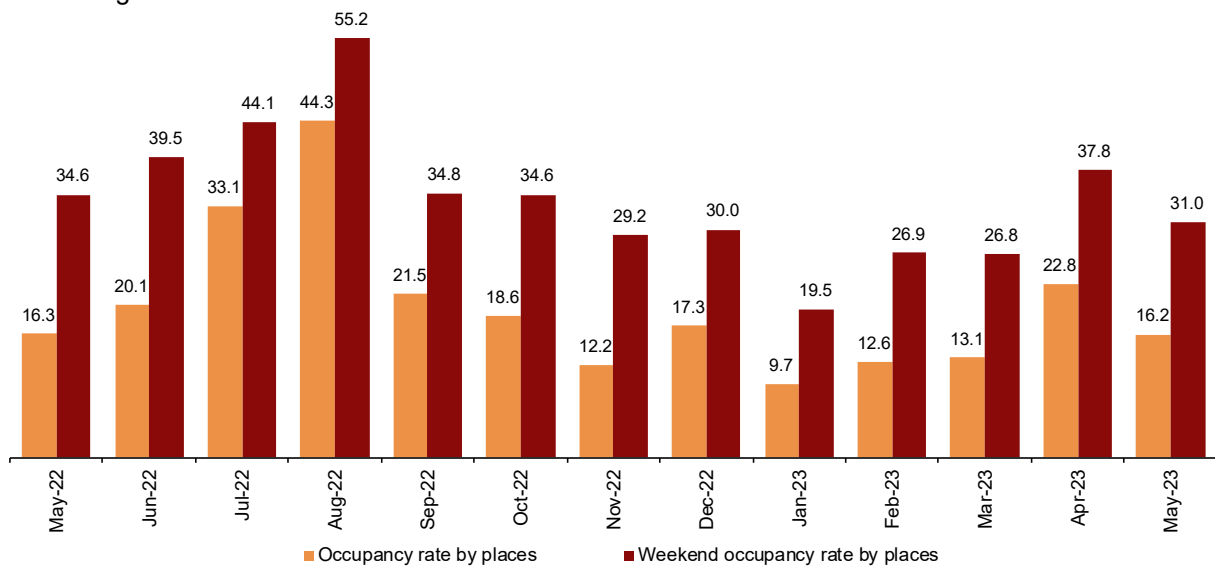

In rural tourism accommodation, 16.3% of the bed-places were occupied, 0.1% less than May 2022. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 31.0%, with an annual decrease of 10.5%.

Percentage

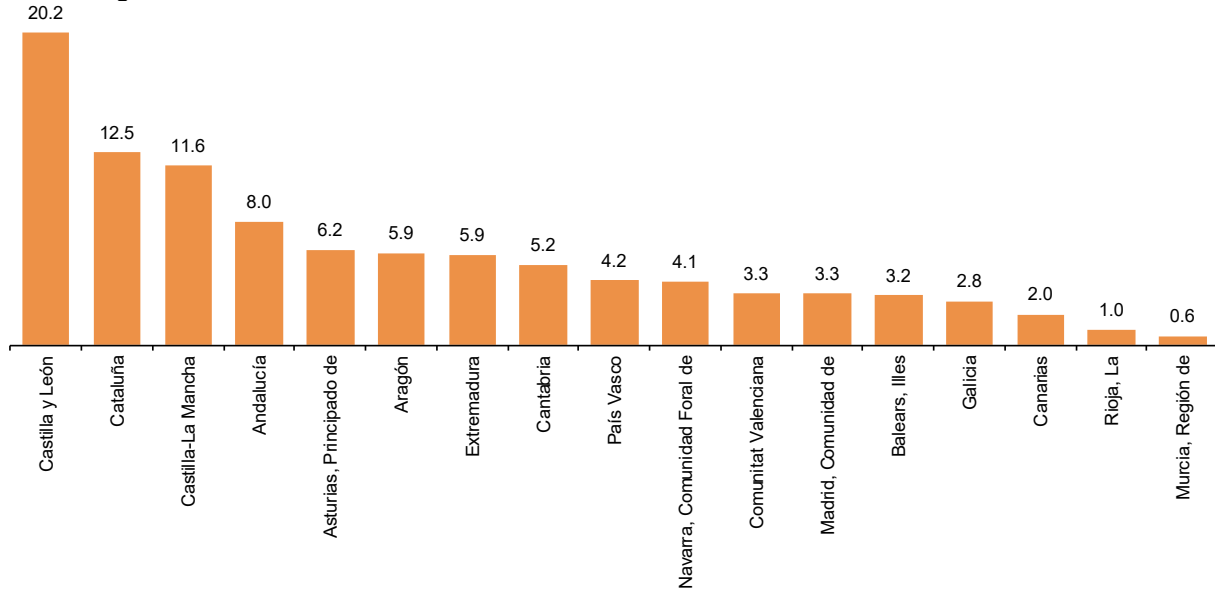


By Autonomous Community, Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 171,992 overnight stays, 11.2% more than in May 2022. It also achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 52.7% of campsites offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 142,977 overnight stays. It also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 52.9% of the bed-places offered.

Percentage

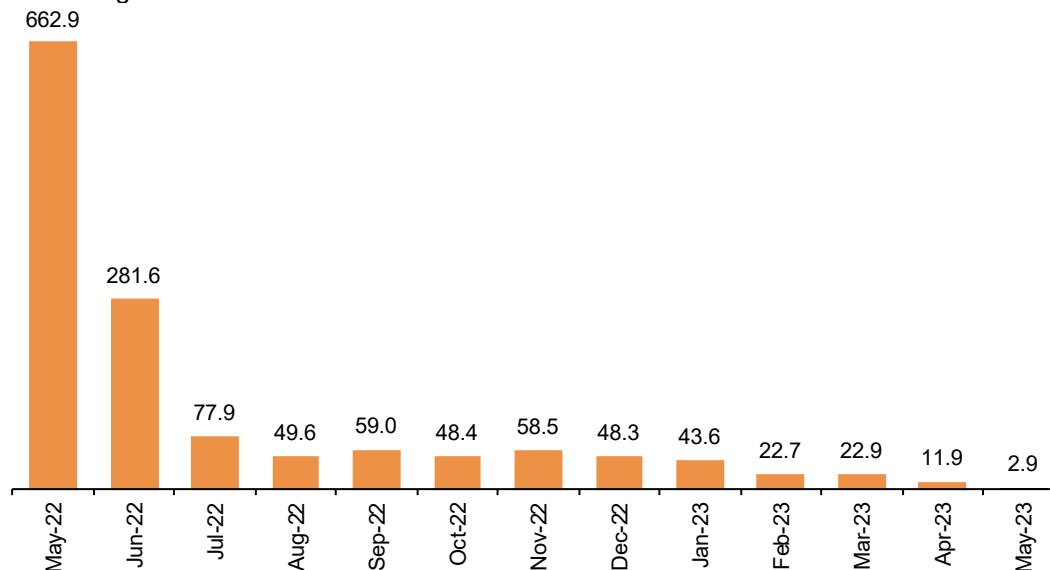


## Hostels

In May, there were 729,775 overnight stays in hostels, which represents an annual increase of 2.9%. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 12.3% while those by non-residents increased by 15.4%.

## Annual variation rate for overnight stay

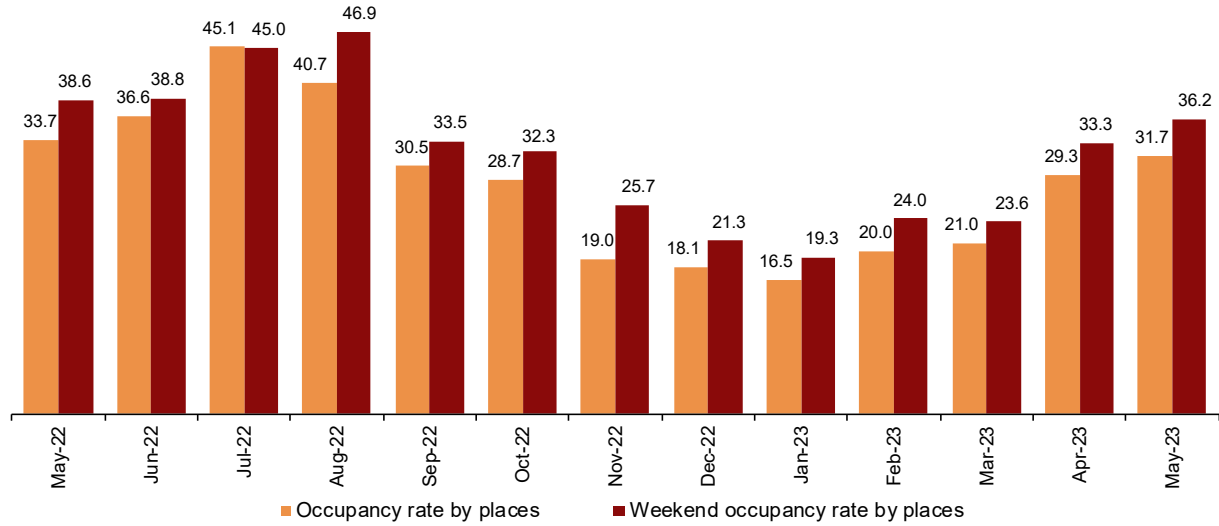

31.7% of the bed-places were occupied, 5.7% less than in May 2022. The weekend occupancy rate reached 36.2%, with a 6.1% decrease.

Percentage



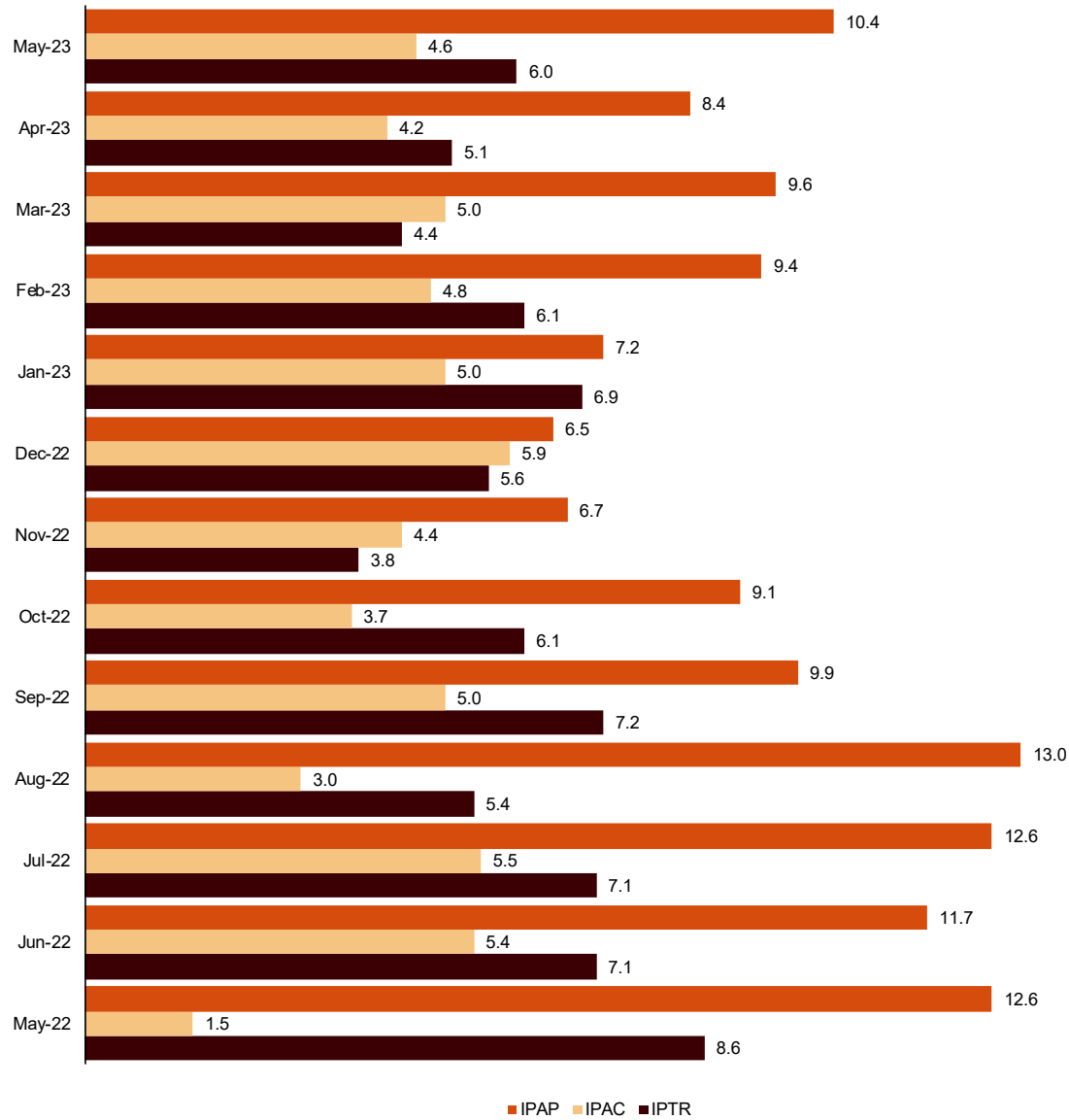
Galicia was the main destination, with 168,315 overnight stays. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 65.7% of the bed-places offered.

**Price indices**

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 10.4% in May, compared to the same month of 2022, the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 4.6%, and the Rural Tourism Price Index (RTPI) by 6.0%.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In May, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels<sup>1</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and hostels) registered an 8.4% increase in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents decreased by 3.0%, while those by non-residents increased by 14.7%.

The average stay increased by 2.0%, to 3.2 overnight stays per traveller.

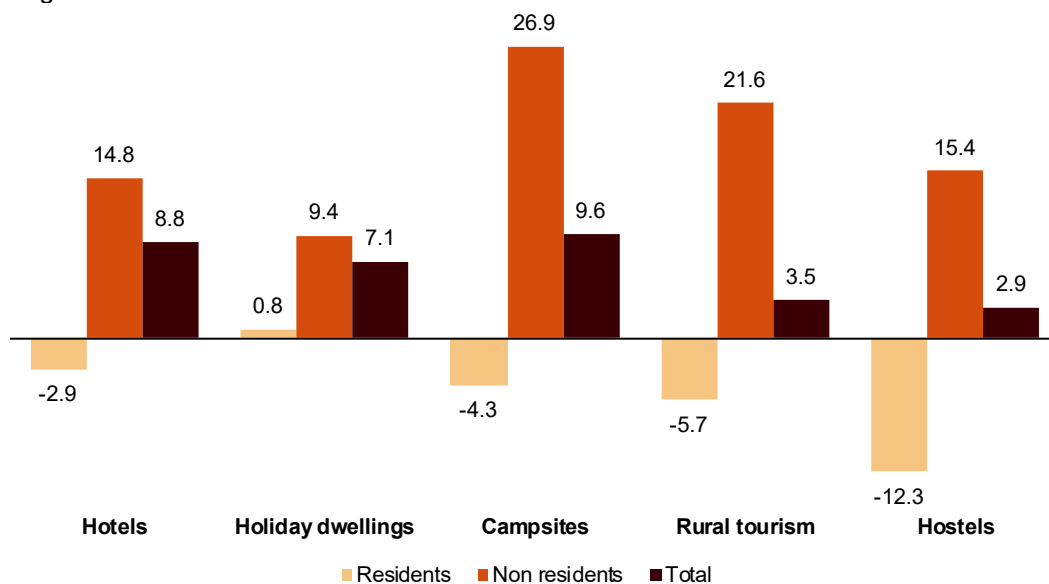

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 75.7% corresponded to hotels, and 24.3% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all types of regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 28.5% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (17.7%) and France (10.0%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with more than 8.5 million overnight stays. It was followed by Cataluña, with more than 7.7 million, and Andalucía, with more than 6.8 million.

## Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for May 2022 of the Occupancy Survey in: Tourist Apartments (HDOS), Campgrounds (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodations (RTAOS), and Hostels (HOS), as well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

## Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

**Type of sampling:** stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** camping establishments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such a way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

**Sample size:** approximately 1,200 establishments.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that entrepreneurs of this type of accommodation apply to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

**Population scope:** tourist hostels registered as such in the corresponding registry of each Autonomous Community and the youth hostels belonging to the Spanish Network of Youth Hostels (REAJ)

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
