June 2010. Provisional data

**Overnight stays in Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation increase
3.8% in June as compared with the same month of 2009**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 8.6 million in June, 3.8% more than in the same month of 2009. This increase in overnight stays took place for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at 2.8%, and non-residents, with an interannual variation of 4.5%.

The average stay decreased 1.1% as compared with June 2009, standing at 5.1 nights per guest.

During the first semester of the year, overnight stays decreased 1.2% as compared with the same period the previous year.



Holiday Dwellings


Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 5.3 million in June, representing a 4.4% increase as compared with the same month the previous year. This increase in overnight stays took place for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at 2.9%, and non-residents, with an interannual growth of 4.9%.

The average stay decreased 4.9% as compared with June 2009, standing at 6.6 nights per traveller.

Available holiday dwellings increased 1.1%, reaching 521,273 bedplaces. This month, 34.0% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 3.1% more than in June 2009. The weekend

occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 36.9%, with an increase of 4.2%. In turn, 47.9% of the total available holiday dwellings were occupied, for an interannual increase of 4.4%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 72.9% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 1.6 million overnight stays, 2.6% more than in June of last year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 722,074 overnight stays, 1.0% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with 1.8 million overnight stays, 12.0% more than in June 2009. The second destination of choice was Illes Balears, with 1.4 million overnight stays, 3.3% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Cataluña were the main destinations of choice. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Comunitat Valenciana, Canarias and Cataluña.

Illes Balears showed the highest occupancy rate, with 62.0% of the available holiday dwellings. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (61.9%) and País Vasco (54.5%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with 856,876 overnight stays and an occupancy of 67.7% of the available holiday dwellings.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.


Holiday Dwelling Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 4.6% decrease in June, a rate 0.4 points lower than that recorded the previous month.


The rate for *tour-operadores and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (60.4%), decreased 5.2% in the interannual rate.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 63.6%, decreased their prices by 4.2%.

Tourist Campsites



Tourist campsites exceeded 2.7 million overnight stays in the month of June, indicating an interannual increase of 3.4%. Overnight stays of resident travellers increased 3.7%, and those of non-resident travellers increased 2.9%.

Tourist campsites offered 693,399 bedplaces, 0.5% more than in June 2009. 30.0% of the available lots were occupied, 5.4% less. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 34.3%, that is, 3.4% less than in June 2009.

40.7% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 26.1% of the overnight stays by non-residents (10.9% more than in June 2009). The following country of origin was The United Kingdom.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with more than 1.5 million overnight stays, 5.8% more in the interannual rate. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with 380,935 overnight stays, indicating an 11.7% increase.


Among residents, the preferred destinations were Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by non-resident travellers were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía.

La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on campsites in June, with 64.2% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (48.6%) and Comunitat Valenciana (43.0%).

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 696,146 overnight stays. Costa Maresme reached the highest occupancy (49.4%).

The tourist sites with the most overnight stays were Salou, Benidorm and Torroella de Montgrí.

Tourist Campsite Price Index Evolution




The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced interannual growth of 2.6% in June. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (68.7%), presented an increase of 2.1%.

Regarding category, *luxury and first class*, with a weighting of 51.6% this month, registered an interannual increase of 2.8%.


Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 546,003 in June, indicating an interannual increase of 1.0%. Resident overnight stays decreased 0.7%, whereas those by non-residents grew 7.5%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 134,774 bedplaces, 3.3% more than in June 2009. 13.4% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 2.2% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 26.5%, that is, 0.5% more in the interannual rate.



Distribution of overnight stays of travellers resident in Spain in rural tourism accommodation as a %




Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 96,118 overnight stays, 2.8% less than in June 2009. It was followed by Cataluña, with 70,400 overnight stays, 3.3% less.

Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destination. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Cantabria.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 49.7% of the available bedplaces. It was followed by País Vasco (20.1%) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (18.0%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 56,788 overnight stays in June. The islands of Ibiza and Formentera reached the highest occupancy (61.7%).

Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index Evolution



The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual decrease of 2.7% in June.

The *weekend* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (57.7%), fell 2.4%. By rent modality, *complete use*, whose weighting was 53.0%, registered an interannual decrease of 2.5% in June.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation


Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an **interannual increase of 5.0% in June**. Overnight stays by residents increased 4.8%, and non-resident stays increased 5.2%.

The average stay decreased 1.5% in June, standing at 3.7 nights per traveller. Travellers and overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation were:



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in the month of June, 76% were accounted for at hotels, and 24% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were The United Kingdom (with 29.6% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (25.0%) and France (5.9%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 8.8 million overnight stays (4.3% more than in June 2009). It was followed by Cataluña, with more than 7.1 million overnight stays (7.5% more) and Canarias, with more than 5.4 million overnight stays (6.7% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Illes Balears, Cataluña and Canarias. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
