**Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey**  
June 2021 Provisional Data

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation exceeded 7.1 million in June, compared to 2.0 million in the same month of 2020**

**During the first six months of 2021, overnight stays increased 11.3%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.**

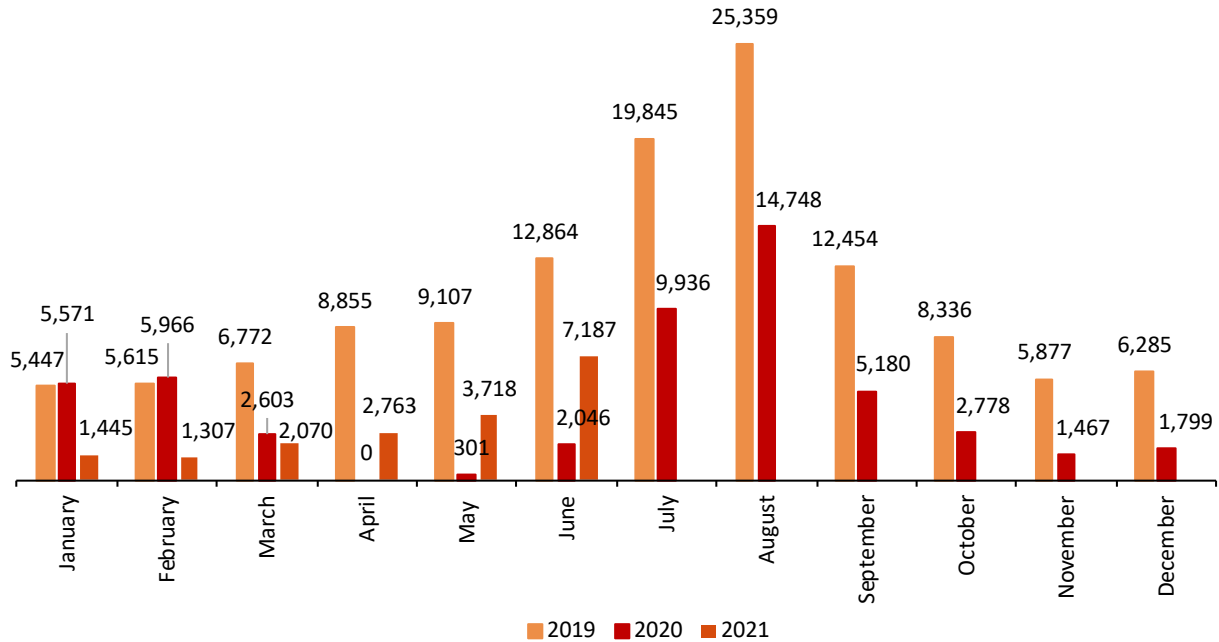
Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist lodgings (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 7.1 million in June, 247.0% more than in the same month of 2020.

Compared to June 2019, overnight stays in non-hotel establishments showed a decrease of 45.8%.

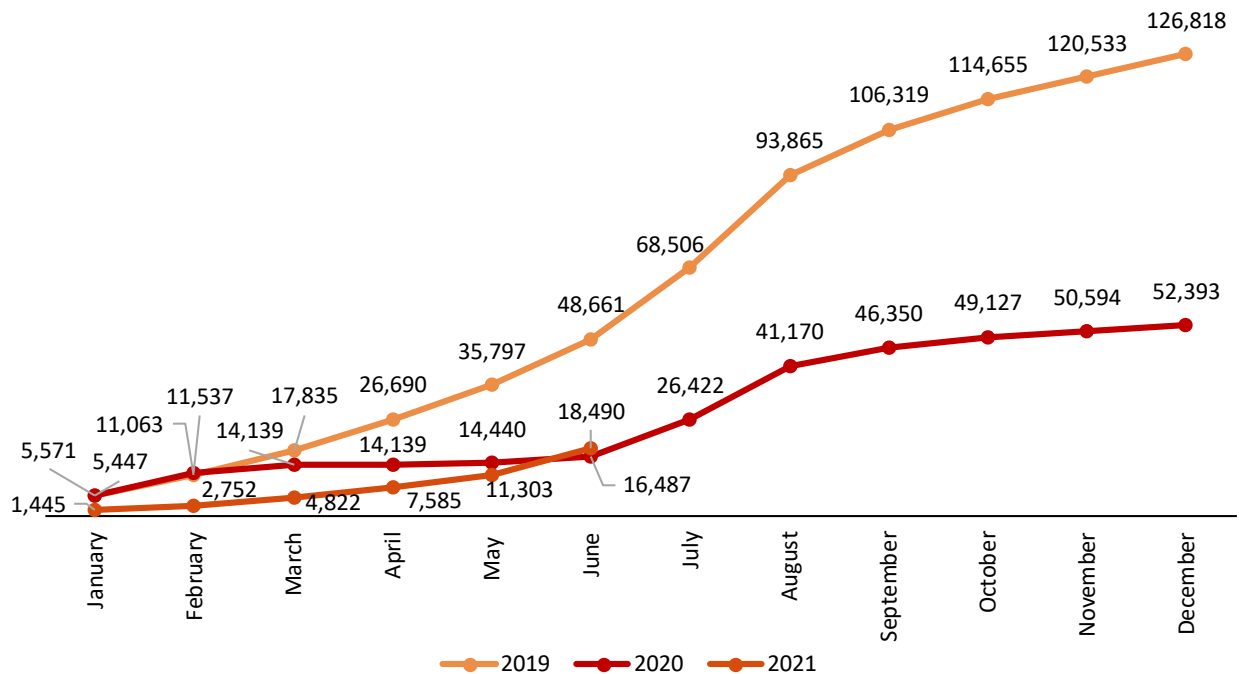
By traveller origin, overnight stays by residents of Spain, which represent 76.1% of the total, rose to 5.4 million. For their part, those of non-residents reached 1.7 million, representing 23.9% of the total.

During the first six months of 2021, overnight stays increased 11.3%, as compared with the same period of the previous year.

## Open establishments

In June, a total of 134,663 non-hotel accommodations were open in Spain, which represented 70.9% of the total directory of establishments in this month.

## Holiday Dwellings

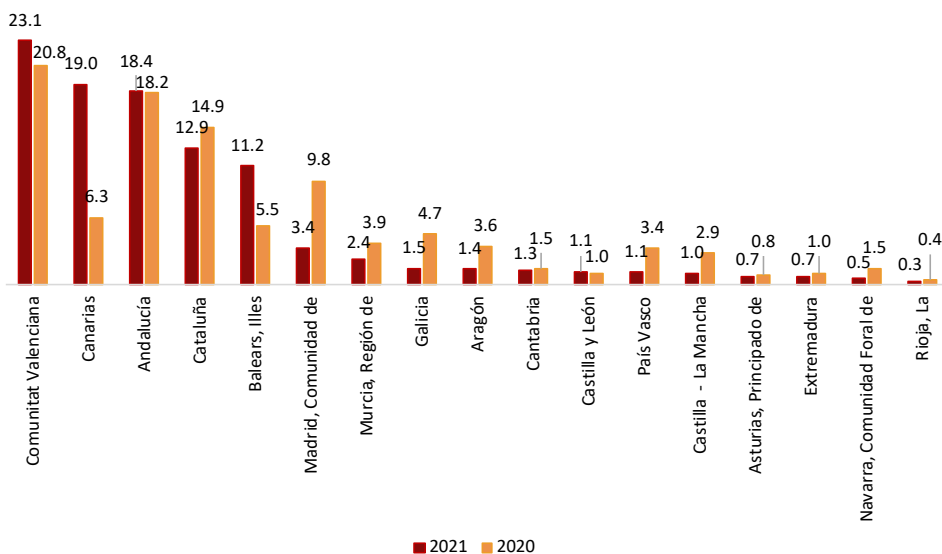
Overnight stays in tourist apartments reached 2.7 million in June. Of this total, 67.6% corresponded to residents and 32.4% to non-residents.

During the first six months of 2021, the total number of overnight stays fell by 26.6% compared to the same period of 2020.

By communities, Comunitat Valenciana, Canarias and Andalucía were the main destinations for travellers in the month of June, with 624,817, 514,956 and 499,339 overnight stays, respectively.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred tourist apartment destination, with 345,079 overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza-Formentera showed the highest occupancy rate, with 40.8% of holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in June were Benidorm, San Bartolomé de Tirajana and Madrid.

## **Tourist Campsites**

Overnight stays at campsites amounted to 3.4 million in June. Of this total, 81.7% corresponded to residents and 18.3% to non-residents.

During the first six months of 2021, the total of overnight stays in this type of accommodation rose by 83.5% compared to the same period of 2020.

In June, 34.3% of available pitches were occupied, and the weekend occupancy rate reached 40.8%.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for campsites, with more than 1.6 million overnight stays. La Rioja achieved the highest occupancy rate, with 65.5% of the pitches offered.

By tourist area, the Costa Brava was the preferred destination in June, with 630,021 overnight stays. Costa Blanca had the highest occupancy rate, with 64.0% of the pitches offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Mont-Roig Del Camp and Tarragona.

## **Rural tourism accommodation**

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation came to 785,448 in June. A total of 80.3% corresponded to residents and 19.7% to non-residents.

During the first six months of 2021, the number of overnight stays rose by 54.3% compared to the same period of the previous year.

In rural tourism accommodation, 16.6% of bedplaces were occupied in June. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 33.4%.

By autonomous community, Illes Balears is the preferred destination, with 116,928 overnight stays. It also registered the highest occupancy rate, with 42.8% of available bed-places.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 92,526 overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza-Formentera registered the highest occupancy rate, with 47.0% of bed-places offered.

## Hostels

In June, overnight stays in hostels<sup>1</sup> stood at 217,587. A total of 76.8% corresponded to residents and 23.2% to non-residents.

During the first six four of 2021, the total of overnight stays fell by 8.7% compared to the same period of the previous year.

In June, 13.8% of bed-places were occupied. The weekend occupancy rate reached 18.2%.

By communities, Galicia was the main destination, with 48,534 overnight stays. In June, Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 30.1% of the bed-places offered.

## Price indices

The Tourist Apartment Price Index (TAPI) increased by 3.9% in June compared to the same month of 2020, the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) by 3.3%, and the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) by 1.9%.

## Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In June, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodations (hotels<sup>2</sup>, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) increased to 21.2 million. Resident overnight stays accounted for 67.4% and non-resident overnight stays for 32.6%.

During the first six months of 2021, overnight stays in the totality of Spanish collective tourist accommodations decreased by 14.0% compared to the same period of the previous year.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodations in July, 66.3% corresponded to hotels, and 33.7% to non-hotel tourist accommodations.

The main countries of origin for all regulated tourist accommodations were Germany (with 27.7% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), France (14.8%), and the Netherlands (8.3%).

Cataluña was the preferred destination, with more than 4.2 million overnight stays. These are followed by Andalucía (with more than 3.8 million) and Illes Balears (with more than 2.8 million).

<sup>1</sup> Since January 2021, tourist hostels have been included in the survey, in addition to those belonging to the Spanish Youth Hostels Network. The data published are not comparable with those of June 2020, and [link coefficients](#) are thus published to allow the annual variation rates to be calculated.

## Revision and updating of data

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data for June 2020 of the Occupancy Surveys in: Holiday Dwellings (HDOS), Campsites (COS), Rural Tourism Accommodation (RTAOS) and Hostels (HOS). As well as the Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI), the Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) and the Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI).

## Methodological note

The main objective of the Holiday Dwelling Occupancy Survey (HDOS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that occupies this type of accommodation within the tourist sector, both from the point of view of supply and demand.

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by holiday dwelling establishments to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** holiday apartment establishments and/or companies operating holiday apartments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to a fortnight of the month, chosen randomly, in such way that the complete month is covered among all establishments.

**Type of sampling:** stratified sampling by province and establishment size, and stratified at island-size level for Canarias and Illes Balears.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The main objective of the Campsite Occupancy Survey (COS) is to ascertain the behaviour of a series of variables that make it possible to describe the segment that this type of accommodation occupies within the tourist sector, from the viewpoint of both supply and demand.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices offered by campsites to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** camping establishments.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla, where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period of the information:** seven consecutive days of each month, chosen randomly in such way that, between all the establishments, the entire month is covered.

**Sample size:** approximately 1200 establishments.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) is a statistical measure of the monthly evolution of the prices that entrepreneurs of this type of accommodation apply to their clients.

**Type of operation:** monthly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** rural tourism establishments registered as such in the corresponding register of each Autonomous Community.

**Geographical scope:** the entire national territory, with the exception of Ceuta and Melilla where there are no establishments of this type.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.

**Reference period of the results:** the month.

**Reference period for the information:** The consultation of basic data refers to all the days of the month.

**Type of sampling:** comprehensive survey in all provinces except those where the population size is large enough to take a sample.

**Collection method:** questionnaire filled in directly by the establishment.
